1 And Job answered and said, 2 How hast thou helped the powerless; how saved the arm that is without strength! 3 How hast thou counselled him that hath no wisdom, and abundantly declared the thing as it is! 4 For whom hast thou uttered words? and whose spirit came from thee?

5 The shades tremble beneath the waters and the inhabitants thereof; **6** Sheol is naked before him, and destruction hath no covering. **7** He stretcheth out the north over empty space, he hangeth the earth upon nothing; **8** He bindeth up the waters in his thick clouds, and the cloud is not rent under them. **9** He covereth the face of his throne, he spreadeth his cloud upon it. **10** He hath traced a fixed circle over the waters, unto the confines of light and darkness. **11** The pillars of the heavens tremble and are astonished at his rebuke. **12** He stirreth up the sea by his power, and by his understanding he smitteh through Rahab. **13** By his Spirit the heavens are adorned; his hand hath formed the fleeing serpent. **14** Lo, these are the borders of his ways; but what a whisper of a word do we hear of him! And the thunder of his power, who can understand?
