1 A Song; a Psalm. Of the sons of Korah. Great is Jehovah, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the hill of his holiness. **2** Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth, is mount Zion, on the sides of the north, the city of the great King. **3** God is known in her palaces as a high fortress. **4** For behold, the kings assembled themselves, they passed by together; **5** They saw, --so they marvelled; they were troubled, they fled in consternation: **6** Trembling took hold upon them there; anguish, as of a woman in travail. **7** With an east wind thou hast broken the ships of Tarshish.

8 As we have heard, so have we seen, in the city of Jehovah of hosts, in the city of our God: God doth establish it for ever. Selah. **9** We have thought, O God, of thy loving-kindness, in the midst of thy temple. **10** According to thy name, O God, so is thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness. **11** Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments. **12** Walk about Zion, and go round about her: count the towers thereof; **13** Mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces: that ye may tell it to the generation following. **14** For this God is our God for ever and ever; he will be our guide until death.
