## 1. Chronicles 18

**1** Now after this<sup>H310</sup> it came to pass, that David<sup>H1732</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and subdued<sup>H3665</sup> them, and took<sup>H3947</sup> Gath<sup>H1661</sup> and her towns<sup>H1323</sup> out of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. **2** And he smote<sup>H5221</sup> Moab<sup>H4124</sup>; and the Moabites<sup>H4124</sup> became David's<sup>H1732</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup>, and brought<sup>H5375</sup> gifts<sup>H4503</sup>. **3** And David<sup>H1732</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> Hadarezer<sup>H1928</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Zobah<sup>H6678</sup> unto Hamath<sup>H2574</sup>, as he went<sup>H3212</sup> to stablish<sup>H5324</sup> his dominion<sup>H3027</sup> by the river<sup>H5104</sup> Euphrates<sup>H6578.1</sup> **4** And David<sup>H1732</sup> took<sup>H3920</sup> from him a thousand<sup>H505</sup> chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and seven<sup>H7651</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>, and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> footmen<sup>H376 H7273</sup>: David<sup>H1732</sup> also houghed<sup>H6131</sup> all the chariot<sup>H7393</sup> horses, but reserved<sup>H3498</sup> of them an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> chariots<sup>H7393.2</sup> **5** And when the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> of Damascus<sup>H1834</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to help<sup>H5826</sup> Hadarezer<sup>H1928</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Zobah<sup>H6678</sup>, David<sup>H1732</sup> slew<sup>H5221</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> and the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> became David's<sup>H1732</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup>, and brought<sup>H5375</sup> gifts<sup>H4503</sup>. Thus the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> preserved<sup>H3467</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> whithersoever he went<sup>H1980</sup>. **7** And David<sup>H1732</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> the shields<sup>H7982</sup> of gold<sup>H2091</sup> that were on the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Hadarezer<sup>H1928</sup>, brought<sup>H3947</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> very<sup>H3966</sup> much<sup>H7227</sup> brass<sup>H5178</sup>, wherewith Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> sea<sup>H3220</sup>, and the pillars<sup>H5982</sup>, and the vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of brass<sup>H5178.4</sup>

**9** Now when Tou<sup>H8583</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Hamath<sup>H2574</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> how David<sup>H1732</sup> had smitten<sup>H521</sup> all the host<sup>H2428</sup> of Hadarezer<sup>H1928</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Zobah<sup>H6678,5</sup> **10** He sent<sup>H7971</sup> Hadoram<sup>H1913</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> to king<sup>H4428</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, to enquire<sup>H7592</sup> of his welfare<sup>H7965</sup>, and to congratulate<sup>H1288</sup> him, because he had fought<sup>H3898</sup> against Hadarezer<sup>H1928</sup>, and smitten<sup>H5221</sup> him; (for Hadarezer<sup>H1928</sup> had war<sup>H376</sup> H4421</sup> with Tou<sup>H8583</sup>;) and with him all manner of vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of gold<sup>H2091</sup> and silver<sup>H3701</sup> and brass<sup>H5178</sup>.<sup>6789</sup> **11** Them also king<sup>H4428</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> dedicated<sup>H6942</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, with the silver<sup>H3701</sup> and the gold<sup>H2091</sup> that he brought<sup>H5375</sup> from all these nations<sup>H1471</sup>; from Edom<sup>H123</sup>, and from Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, and from the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup>, and from the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and from Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>. **12** Moreover Abishai<sup>H52</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zeruiah<sup>H6870</sup> slew<sup>H5221</sup> of the Edomites<sup>H123</sup> in the valley<sup>H1516</sup> of salt<sup>H4417</sup> eighteen<sup>H8003</sup> H6240 thousand<sup>H555.10</sup> **13** And he put<sup>H7760</sup> garrisons<sup>H3437</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> whithersoever he went<sup>H1980</sup>. **14** So David<sup>H1732</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> over all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and executed<sup>H6213</sup> judgment<sup>H4941</sup> and justice<sup>H6666</sup> among all his people<sup>H5971</sup>. **15** And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zeruiah<sup>H6870</sup> was over the host<sup>H6635</sup>; and Jehoshaphat<sup>H3092</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahilud<sup>H286</sup>, recorder<sup>H2142.11</sup> **16** And Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahilub<sup>H285</sup>, and Abimelech<sup>H4041</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Abilathar<sup>H54</sup>, were the priests<sup>H3548</sup>; and Shavsha<sup>H7798</sup> was scribe<sup>H5608,121</sup> **17** And Benaiah<sup>H1732</sup> were chief<sup>H7223</sup> about<sup>H3027</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>.<sup>14</sup>
