## 1. Samuel 14

1 Now it came to pass upon a day<sup>H3117</sup>, that Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the young man<sup>H5288</sup> that bare<sup>H5375</sup> his armour<sup>H3627</sup>, Come<sup>H3212</sup>, and let us go over<sup>H5674</sup> to the Philistines'<sup>H6430</sup> garrison<sup>H4673</sup>, that is on the other side<sup>H5676 H1975</sup>. But he told<sup>H5046</sup> not his father<sup>H1,1</sup> 2 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> tarried<sup>H3427</sup> in the uttermost<sup>H7097</sup> part of Gibeah<sup>H1390</sup> under a pomegranate tree<sup>H7416</sup> which is in Migron<sup>H4051</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were with him were about six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>; **3** And Ahiah<sup>H281</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahitub<sup>H285</sup>, Ichabod's<sup>H350</sup> brother<sup>H251</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Phinehas<sup>H6372</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Eli<sup>H5941</sup>, the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup> in Shiloh<sup>H7887</sup>, wearing<sup>H5375</sup> an ephod<sup>H646</sup>. And the people<sup>H5971</sup> knew<sup>H3045</sup> not that Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> was gone<sup>H1980.2</sup> 4 And between the passages<sup>H4569</sup>, by which Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> sought<sup>H1245</sup> to go over<sup>H5674</sup> unto the Philistines'<sup>H6430</sup> garrison<sup>H4673</sup>, there was a sharp<sup>H8127</sup> rock<sup>H5553</sup> on the one side<sup>H5676</sup>, and a sharp<sup>H8127</sup> rock<sup>H5553</sup> on the other side<sup>H5676</sup>: and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the one<sup>H259</sup> was Bozez<sup>H949</sup>, and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the other<sup>H259</sup> Seneh<sup>H5573</sup>. **5** The forefront<sup>H8127</sup> of the one<sup>H259</sup> was situate<sup>H4690</sup> northward<sup>H6828</sup> over against<sup>H4136</sup> Michmash<sup>H4363</sup>, and the other<sup>H259</sup> southward<sup>H5045</sup> over against<sup>H4136</sup> Gibeah<sup>H1387,3</sup> 6 And Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to the young man<sup>H5288</sup> that bare<sup>H5375</sup> his armour<sup>H3627</sup>, Come<sup>H3212</sup>, and let us go over<sup>H5674</sup> unto the garrison<sup>H4673</sup> of these uncircumcised<sup>H6189</sup>: it may be that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will work<sup>H6213</sup> for us: for there is no restraint<sup>H4622</sup> to the  $LORD^{H3068}$  to save H3467 by many H7227 or by few H4592. 7 And his armourbearer H5375 H3627 said H559 unto him,  $Do^{H6213}$  all that is in thine heart<sup>H3824</sup>: turn<sup>H5186</sup> thee; behold, I am with thee according to thy heart<sup>H3824</sup>. 8 Then said<sup>H559</sup> Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup>, Behold, we will pass over<sup>H5674</sup> unto these men<sup>H582</sup>, and we will discover<sup>H1540</sup> ourselves unto them. **9** If they say<sup>H559</sup> thus unto us, Tarry<sup>H1826</sup> until we come<sup>H5060</sup> to you; then we will stand still<sup>H5975</sup> in our place, and will not go up<sup>H5927</sup> unto them.<sup>4</sup> **10** But if they say<sup>H559</sup> thus, Come up<sup>H5927</sup> unto us; then we will go up<sup>H5927</sup>: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath delivered<sup>H5414</sup> them into our hand<sup>H3027</sup>: and this shall be a sign<sup>H226</sup> unto us. **11** And both<sup>H8147</sup> of them discovered<sup>H1540</sup> themselves unto the garrison<sup>H4673</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>: and the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, the Hebrews<sup>H5680</sup> come forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the holes<sup>H2356</sup> where they had hid<sup>H2244</sup> themselves. **12** And the men<sup>H582</sup> of the garrison<sup>H4675</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> and his armourbearer<sup>H5375 H3627</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Come up<sup>H5927</sup> to us, and we will shew<sup>H3045</sup> you a thing<sup>H1697</sup>. And Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto his armourbearer<sup>H5375 H3627</sup>, Come up<sup>H5927</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> me: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath delivered<sup>H5414</sup> them into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **13** And Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> climbed up<sup>H5927</sup> upon his hands<sup>H3027</sup> and upon his feet<sup>H7272</sup>, and his armourbearer<sup>H5375 H3627</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> him: and they fell<sup>H5307</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>; and his armourbearer<sup>H5375 H3627</sup> slew<sup>H4191</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> him. **14** And that first<sup>H7223</sup> slaughter<sup>H4347</sup>. which Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> and his armourbearer<sup>H5375 H3627</sup> made<sup>H5221</sup>, was about twenty<sup>H6242</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>, within as it were an half<sup>H2677</sup> acre<sup>H4618</sup> of land<sup>H7704</sup>, which a yoke<sup>H6776</sup> of oxen might plow.<sup>5</sup> 15 And there was trembling<sup>H2731</sup> in the host<sup>H4264</sup>, in the field<sup>H7704</sup>, and among all the people<sup>H5971</sup>: the garrison<sup>H4673</sup>, and the spoilers<sup>H7843</sup>, they also trembled<sup>H2729</sup>, and the earth<sup>H776</sup> quaked<sup>H7264</sup>: so it was a very great<sup>H430</sup> trembling<sup>H2731</sup>.<sup>6</sup>

**16** And the watchmen<sup>H6822</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup> in Gibeah<sup>H1390</sup> of Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup> looked<sup>H7200</sup>; and, behold, the multitude<sup>H1995</sup> melted away<sup>H4127</sup>, and they went<sup>H3212</sup> on beating down<sup>H1986</sup> one another. **17** Then said<sup>H559</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were with him, Number<sup>H6485</sup> now, and see<sup>H7200</sup> who is gone<sup>H1980</sup> from us. And when they had numbered<sup>H6485</sup>, behold, Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> and his armourbearer<sup>H5375</sup> H3627</sup> were not there. **18** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Ahiah<sup>H281</sup>, Bring hither<sup>H5066</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>. For the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> was at that time<sup>H3117</sup> with the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **19** And it came to pass, while Saul<sup>H7586</sup> talked<sup>H1696</sup> unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, that the noise<sup>H1995</sup> that was in the host<sup>H4264</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> on<sup>H1980</sup> and increased<sup>H7227</sup>: and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, Withdraw<sup>H622</sup> thine hand<sup>H3027.7</sup> **20** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were with him assembled<sup>H2199</sup> themselves, and they came<sup>H395</sup> to the battle<sup>H4421</sup>: and, behold, every man's<sup>H376</sup> sword<sup>H2719</sup> was against his fellow<sup>H7453</sup>, and there was a very<sup>H3966</sup> great<sup>H1419</sup> discomfiture<sup>H4103.8</sup> **21** Moreover the Hebrews<sup>H5680</sup> that were with the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> before<sup>H865</sup> that time<sup>H8032</sup>, which went up<sup>H5927</sup> with them into the camp<sup>H4264</sup> from the country round about<sup>H5439</sup>, even they also turned to be with the

Israelites<sup>H3478</sup> that were with Saul<sup>H7586</sup> and Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>. **22** Likewise all the men<sup>H376</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> which had hid<sup>H2244</sup> themselves in mount<sup>H2022</sup> Ephraim<sup>H669</sup>, when they heard<sup>H8085</sup> that the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> fled<sup>H5127</sup>, even they also followed hard<sup>H1692</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> them in the battle<sup>H4421</sup>. **23** So the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saved<sup>H3467</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup>: and the battle<sup>H4421</sup> passed over<sup>H5674</sup> unto Bethaven<sup>H1007</sup>.

24 And the men<sup>H376</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> were distressed<sup>H5065</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup>: for Saul<sup>H7586</sup> had adjured<sup>H422</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be the man<sup>H376</sup> that eateth<sup>H398</sup> any food<sup>H3899</sup> until evening<sup>H6153</sup>, that I may be avenged<sup>H5358</sup> on mine enemies<sup>H341</sup>. So none of the people<sup>H5971</sup> tasted<sup>H2938</sup> any food<sup>H3899</sup>. **25** And all they of the land<sup>H776</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to a wood<sup>H3293</sup>; and there was honey<sup>H1706</sup> upon<sup>H6440</sup> the ground<sup>H7704</sup>. **26** And when the people<sup>H5971</sup> were come<sup>H935</sup> into the wood<sup>H3293</sup>, behold, the honey<sup>H1706</sup> dropped<sup>H1982</sup>; but no man put<sup>H5381</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> to his mouth<sup>H6310</sup>: for the people<sup>H5971</sup> feared<sup>H3372</sup> the oath<sup>H7621</sup>. 27 But Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> not when his father<sup>H1</sup> charged<sup>H7650</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> with the oath<sup>H7650</sup>: wherefore he put forth<sup>H7971</sup> the end<sup>H7097</sup> of the rod<sup>H4294</sup> that was in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and dipped<sup>H2881</sup> it in an honeycomb<sup>H3295 H1706</sup>, and put<sup>H7725</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> to his mouth<sup>H6310</sup>; and his eyes<sup>H5869</sup> were enlightened<sup>H215</sup>. **28** Then answered<sup>H6030</sup> one<sup>H376</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Thy father<sup>H1</sup> straitly<sup>H7650</sup> charged<sup>H7650</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> with an oath<sup>H7650</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be the man<sup>H376</sup> that eateth<sup>H398</sup> any food<sup>H3899</sup> this day<sup>H3117</sup>. And the people<sup>H5971</sup> were faint<sup>H5774</sup>.<sup>9</sup> 29 Then said<sup>H559</sup> Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>, My father<sup>H1</sup> hath troubled<sup>H5916</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>: see<sup>H7200</sup>, I pray you, how mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> have been enlightened<sup>H215</sup>, because I tasted<sup>H2938</sup> a little<sup>H4592</sup> of this honey<sup>H1706</sup>. **30** How much more<sup>H637</sup>, if haply<sup>H3863</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> had eaten<sup>H398</sup> freely<sup>H398</sup> to day<sup>H3117</sup> of the spoil<sup>H7998</sup> of their enemies<sup>H341</sup> which they found<sup>H4672</sup>? for had there not been now a much greater<sup>H7235</sup> slaughter<sup>H4347</sup> among the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>? **31** And they smote<sup>H5221</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup> from Michmash<sup>H4363</sup> to Aijalon<sup>H357</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> were very<sup>H3966</sup> faint<sup>H5774</sup>. **32** And the people<sup>H5971</sup> flew<sup>H5860 H6213</sup> upon the spoil<sup>H7998</sup>, and took<sup>H3947</sup> sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, and oxen<sup>H1241</sup>, and calves<sup>H1121</sup>, and slew<sup>H7819</sup> them on the ground<sup>H776</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> did eat<sup>H398</sup> them with the blood<sup>H1818</sup>. **33** Then they told<sup>H5046</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, the people<sup>H5971</sup> sin<sup>H2398</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, in that they eat<sup>H398</sup> with the blood<sup>H1818</sup>. And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Ye have transgressed<sup>H898</sup>: roll<sup>H1556</sup> a great<sup>H1419</sup> stone<sup>H68</sup> unto me this day<sup>H3117,10</sup> 34 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Disperse<sup>H6327</sup> yourselves among the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Bring me hither<sup>H5066</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> his ox<sup>H7794</sup>, and every man<sup>H376</sup> his sheep<sup>H7716</sup>, and slay<sup>H7819</sup> them here, and eat<sup>H398</sup>; and sin<sup>H2398</sup> not against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in eating<sup>H398</sup> with the blood<sup>H1818</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> brought<sup>H5066</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> his ox<sup>H7794</sup> with him<sup>H3027</sup> that night<sup>H3915</sup>, and slew<sup>H7819</sup> them there.<sup>11</sup> **35** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: the same was the first<sup>H2490</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup> that he built<sup>H1129</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.<sup>12</sup>

36 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Let us go down<sup>H3381</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> by night<sup>H3915</sup>, and spoil<sup>H962</sup> them until the morning<sup>H1242</sup> light<sup>H216</sup>, and let us not leave<sup>H7604</sup> a man<sup>H376</sup> of them. And they said<sup>H559</sup>, Do<sup>H6213</sup> whatsoever seemeth<sup>H5869</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup> unto thee. Then said<sup>H559</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, Let us draw near<sup>H7126</sup> hither<sup>H1988</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup>. **37** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> asked<sup>H7592</sup> counsel of God<sup>H430</sup>, Shall I go down<sup>H3381</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>? wilt thou deliver<sup>H5414</sup> them into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? But he answered<sup>H6030</sup> him not that day<sup>H3117</sup>. 38 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Draw ye near<sup>H5066</sup> hither<sup>H1988</sup>, all the chief<sup>H6438</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>: and know<sup>H3045</sup> and see<sup>H7200</sup> wherein<sup>H4100</sup> this sin<sup>H2403</sup> hath been this day<sup>H3117</sup>.<sup>13</sup> **39** For, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>, which saveth<sup>H3467</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, though it be<sup>H3426</sup> in Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> my son<sup>H1121</sup>, he shall surely<sup>H4191</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>. But there was not a man among all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that answered<sup>H6030</sup> him. **40** Then said<sup>H559</sup> he unto all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Be ye on one<sup>H259</sup> side<sup>H5676</sup>, and I and Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> my son<sup>H1121</sup> will be on the other<sup>H259</sup> side<sup>H5676</sup>. And the people<sup>H5971</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, Do<sup>H6213</sup> what seemeth<sup>H5869</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup> unto thee. 41 Therefore Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Give<sup>H3051</sup> a perfect<sup>H8549</sup> lot. And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> and Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> were taken<sup>H3920</sup>: but the people<sup>H5971</sup> escaped<sup>H3318</sup>.<sup>1415</sup> 42 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Cast<sup>H5307</sup> lots between me and Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> my son<sup>H1121</sup>. And Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> was taken<sup>H3920</sup>. **43** Then Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>, Tell<sup>H5046</sup> me what thou hast done<sup>H6213</sup>. And Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> told<sup>H5046</sup> him, and said<sup>H559</sup>, I did but<sup>H2938</sup> taste<sup>H2938</sup> a little<sup>H4592</sup> honey<sup>H1706</sup> with the end<sup>H7097</sup> of the rod<sup>H4294</sup> that was in mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and, lo<sup>H2009</sup>, I must die<sup>H4191</sup>. 44 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> answered<sup>H559</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> do so<sup>H6213</sup> and more also<sup>H3254</sup>: for thou shalt surely<sup>H4191</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>, Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>. **45** And the people<sup>H5971</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, Shall Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>, who hath wrought<sup>H6213</sup> this great<sup>H1419</sup> salvation<sup>H3444</sup> in Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? God forbid<sup>H2486</sup>: as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>, there shall not one hair<sup>H8185</sup> of his head<sup>H7218</sup> fall<sup>H5307</sup> to the ground<sup>H776</sup>; for he hath wrought<sup>H6213</sup> with God<sup>H430</sup> this day<sup>H3117</sup>. So the people<sup>H5971</sup> rescued<sup>H6299</sup>

Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>, that he died<sup>H4191</sup> not. **46** Then Saul<sup>H7586</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>: and the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> went<sup>H1980</sup> to their own place<sup>H4725</sup>.

**47** So Saul<sup>H7586</sup> took<sup>H3920</sup> the kingdom<sup>H4410</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and fought<sup>H3898</sup> against all his enemies<sup>H341</sup> on every side<sup>H5439</sup>, against Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, and against the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup>, and against Edom<sup>H123</sup>, and against the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Zobah<sup>H6678</sup>, and against the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>: and whithersoever he turned<sup>H6437</sup> himself, he vexed<sup>H7561</sup> them. **48** And he gathered<sup>H6213</sup> an host<sup>H2428</sup>, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup>, and delivered<sup>H5337</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> out of the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of them that spoiled<sup>H8154</sup> them.<sup>16</sup> **49** Now the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup> were Jonathan<sup>H3129</sup>, and Ishui<sup>H3440</sup>, and Melchishua<sup>H4444</sup>: and the names<sup>H8034</sup> of his two<sup>H8147</sup> daughters<sup>H1323</sup> were these; the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the firstborn<sup>H1067</sup> Merab<sup>H4764</sup>, and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the younger<sup>H6996</sup> Michal<sup>H4324</sup>: **50** And the name<sup>H8034</sup> of Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> wife<sup>H802</sup> was Ahinoam<sup>H293</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Ahimaaz<sup>H290</sup>: and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the captain<sup>H8269</sup> of his host<sup>H6635</sup> was Abner<sup>H74</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ner<sup>H5369</sup>, Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> uncle<sup>H1730</sup>.<sup>17</sup> **51** And Kish<sup>H7027</sup> was the father<sup>H1</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>; and Ner<sup>H5369</sup> the father<sup>H1</sup> of Abner<sup>H74</sup> was the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Abiel<sup>H22</sup>. **52** And there was sore<sup>H2389</sup> war<sup>H4421</sup> against the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>: and when Saul<sup>H7586</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> any strong<sup>H1368</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>, or any valiant<sup>H2428</sup> man<sup>H1121</sup>, he took<sup>H622</sup> him unto him.
