## 1. Samuel 24

1 And it came to pass, when Saul<sup>H7586</sup> was returned<sup>H7725</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, that it was told<sup>H5046</sup> him, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, David<sup>H1732</sup> is in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Engedi<sup>H5872.1</sup> 2 Then Saul<sup>H7586</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> three<sup>H7969</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> chosen<sup>H977</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> out of all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> to seek<sup>H1245</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> upon<sup>H6440</sup> the rocks<sup>H6697</sup> of the wild goats<sup>H3277</sup>. **3** And he came<sup>H935</sup> to the sheepcotes<sup>H1448 H6629</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup>, where was a cave<sup>H4631</sup>; and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> went in<sup>H935</sup> to cover<sup>H5526</sup> his feet<sup>H7272</sup>: and David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> remained<sup>H3427</sup> in the sides<sup>H3411</sup> of the cave<sup>H4631</sup>. 4 And the men<sup>H582</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Behold the day<sup>H3117</sup> of which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto thee, Behold, I will deliver<sup>H5414</sup> thine enemy<sup>H341</sup> into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, that thou mayest do<sup>H6213</sup> to him as it shall seem good<sup>H3190</sup> unto thee<sup>H5869</sup>. Then David<sup>H1732</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the skirt<sup>H3671</sup> of Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> robe<sup>H4598</sup> privily<sup>H3909</sup>.<sup>2</sup> **5** And it came to pass afterward<sup>H310</sup>, that David's<sup>H1732</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> him, because he had cut off<sup>H3772</sup> Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> skirt<sup>H3671</sup>. 6 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto his men<sup>H582</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> forbid<sup>H2486</sup> that I should do<sup>H6213</sup> this thing<sup>H1697</sup> unto my master<sup>H113</sup>, the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> anointed<sup>H4899</sup>, to stretch forth<sup>H7971</sup> mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> against him, seeing he is the anointed<sup>H4899</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 7 So David<sup>H1732</sup> stayed<sup>H8156</sup> his servants<sup>H582</sup> with these words<sup>H1697</sup>, and suffered<sup>H5414</sup> them not to rise<sup>H6965</sup> against Saul<sup>H7586</sup>. But Saul<sup>H7586</sup> rose up<sup>H6965</sup> out of the cave<sup>H4631</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> on his way<sup>H1870.3</sup> 8 David<sup>H1732</sup> also arose<sup>H6965</sup> afterward, and went out<sup>H3318</sup> of the cave<sup>H4631</sup>, and cried<sup>H7121</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, My lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>. And when Saul<sup>H7586</sup> looked<sup>H5027</sup> behind<sup>H310</sup> him, David<sup>H1732</sup> stooped<sup>H6915</sup> with his face<sup>H639</sup> to the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and bowed<sup>H7812</sup> himself.

**9** And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, Wherefore hearest<sup>H8085</sup> thou men's<sup>H120</sup> words<sup>H1697</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, David<sup>H1732</sup> seeketh<sup>H1245</sup> thy hurt<sup>H7451</sup>? **10** Behold, this day<sup>H3117</sup> thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> have seen<sup>H7200</sup> how that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had delivered<sup>H5414</sup> thee to day<sup>H3117</sup> into mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> in the cave<sup>H4631</sup>: and some bade<sup>H559</sup> me kill<sup>H2026</sup> thee: but mine eye spared<sup>H2347</sup> thee; and I said<sup>H559</sup>, I will not put forth<sup>H7971</sup> mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> against my lord<sup>H113</sup>; for he is the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> anointed<sup>H4899</sup>. **11** Moreover, my father<sup>H1</sup>, see<sup>H7200</sup>, yea, see<sup>H7200</sup> the skirt<sup>H3671</sup> of thy robe<sup>H4598</sup> in my hand<sup>H3027</sup>: for in that I cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the skirt<sup>H3671</sup> of thy robe<sup>H4598</sup>, and killed<sup>H2026</sup> thee not, know<sup>H3045</sup> thou and see<sup>H7200</sup> that there is neither evil<sup>H7451</sup> nor transgression<sup>H6588</sup> in mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and I have not sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against thee; yet thou huntest<sup>H6658</sup> my soul<sup>H5315</sup> to take<sup>H3947</sup> it. **12** The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> judge<sup>H8199</sup> between me and thee, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> avenge<sup>H5358</sup> me of thee: but mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> shall not be upon thee. **13** As saith<sup>H559</sup> the proverb<sup>H4912</sup> of the ancients<sup>H6931</sup>, Wickedness<sup>H7562</sup> proceedeth<sup>H318</sup> from the wicked<sup>H7563</sup>: but mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> shall not be upon thee. **14** After<sup>H310</sup> whom is the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> come out<sup>H3318</sup>? after<sup>H310</sup> whom dost thou pursue<sup>H7291</sup>? after<sup>H310</sup> a dead<sup>H4191</sup> dog<sup>H3611</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> a<sup>H259</sup> flea<sup>H6550</sup>. **15** The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> therefore be judge<sup>H1781</sup>, and judge<sup>H8199</sup> between me and thee, and see<sup>H7200</sup>? <sup>4</sup>

**16** And it came to pass, when David<sup>H1732</sup> had made an end<sup>H3615</sup> of speaking<sup>H1696</sup> these words<sup>H1697</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, that Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Is this thy voice<sup>H6963</sup>, my son<sup>H1121</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>? And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> his voice<sup>H6963</sup>, and wept<sup>H1058</sup>. **17** And he said<sup>H559</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, Thou art more righteous<sup>H6662</sup> than I: for thou hast rewarded<sup>H1580</sup> me good<sup>H2896</sup>, whereas I have rewarded<sup>H1580</sup> thee evil<sup>H7451</sup>. **18** And thou hast shewed<sup>H5046</sup> this day<sup>H3117</sup> how that thou hast dealt<sup>H6213</sup> well<sup>H2896</sup> with me: forasmuch as when the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had delivered<sup>H5462</sup> me into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, thou killedst<sup>H2026</sup> me not.<sup>5</sup> **19** For if a man<sup>H376</sup> find<sup>H4672</sup> his enemy<sup>H341</sup>, will he let him go<sup>H7971</sup> well<sup>H2896</sup> away<sup>H1870</sup>? wherefore the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> reward<sup>H7999</sup> thee good<sup>H2896</sup> for that thou hast done<sup>H6213</sup> unto me this day<sup>H3117</sup>. **20** And now, behold, I know well<sup>H3045</sup> that thou shalt surely<sup>H4427</sup> be king<sup>H4427</sup>, and that the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> shall be established<sup>H6955</sup> in thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **21** Swear<sup>H7650</sup> now therefore unto me by the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that thou wilt not<sup>H518</sup> cut off<sup>H3772</sup> my seed<sup>H2233</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> me, and that thou wilt not destroy<sup>H8045</sup> my name<sup>H8034</sup> out of my father's<sup>H1</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>. **22** And David<sup>H1732</sup> sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>. And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> home<sup>H1004</sup>; but David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> gat them

up<sup>H5927</sup> unto the hold<sup>H4686</sup>.
