

# 1. Samuel 30

1 And it came to pass, when David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> were come<sup>H935</sup> to Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup> on the third<sup>H7992</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>, that the Amalekites<sup>H6003</sup> had invaded<sup>H6584</sup> the south<sup>H5045</sup>, and Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup>, and smitten<sup>H5221</sup> Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup>, and burned<sup>H8313</sup> it with fire<sup>H784</sup>; 2 And had taken the women<sup>H802</sup> captives<sup>H7617</sup>, that were therein: they slew<sup>H4191</sup> not any<sup>H376</sup>, either great<sup>H1419</sup> or small<sup>H6996</sup>, but carried them away<sup>H5090</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> on their way<sup>H1870</sup>. 3 So David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and, behold, it was burned<sup>H8313</sup> with fire<sup>H784</sup>; and their wives<sup>H802</sup>, and their sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and their daughters<sup>H1323</sup>, were taken captives<sup>H7617</sup>. 4 Then David<sup>H1732</sup> and the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were with him lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> their voice<sup>H6963</sup> and wept<sup>H1058</sup>, until they had no more power<sup>H3581</sup> to weep<sup>H1058</sup>. 5 And David's<sup>H1732</sup> two<sup>H8147</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup> were taken captives<sup>H7617</sup>, Ahinoam<sup>H293</sup> the Jezreelitess<sup>H3159</sup>, and Abigail<sup>H26</sup> the wife<sup>H802</sup> of Nabal<sup>H5037</sup> the Carmelite<sup>H3761</sup>. 6 And David<sup>H1732</sup> was greatly<sup>H3966</sup> distressed<sup>H3334</sup>; for the people<sup>H5971</sup> spake<sup>H559</sup> of stoning<sup>H5619</sup> him, because the soul<sup>H5315</sup> of all the people<sup>H5971</sup> was grieved<sup>H4843</sup>, every man<sup>H376</sup> for his sons<sup>H1121</sup> and for his daughters<sup>H1323</sup>: but David<sup>H1732</sup> encouraged<sup>H2388</sup> himself in the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>. 1

7 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, Ahimelech's<sup>H288</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup>, I pray thee, bring me hither<sup>H5066</sup> the ephod<sup>H646</sup>. And Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> brought<sup>H5066</sup> thither the ephod<sup>H646</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>. 8 And David<sup>H1732</sup> enquired<sup>H7592</sup> at the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Shall I pursue<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> this troop<sup>H1416</sup>? shall I overtake<sup>H5381</sup> them? And he answered<sup>H559</sup> him, Pursue<sup>H7291</sup>: for thou shalt surely<sup>H5381</sup> overtake<sup>H5381</sup> them, and without fail<sup>H5337</sup> recover<sup>H5337</sup> all. 9 So David<sup>H1732</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup>, he and the six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> that were with him, and came<sup>H935</sup> to the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Besor<sup>H1308</sup>, where those that were left behind<sup>H3498</sup> stayed<sup>H5975</sup>. 10 But David<sup>H1732</sup> pursued<sup>H7291</sup>, he and four<sup>H702</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>: for two hundred<sup>H3967</sup> abode behind<sup>H5975</sup>, which were so faint<sup>H6296</sup> that they could not go over<sup>H5674</sup> the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Besor<sup>H1308</sup>. 11 And they found<sup>H4672</sup> an Egyptian<sup>H376</sup> in the field<sup>H7704</sup>, and brought<sup>H3947</sup> him to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and gave<sup>H5414</sup> him bread<sup>H3899</sup>, and he did eat<sup>H398</sup>, and they made him drink<sup>H8248</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup>; 12 And they gave<sup>H5414</sup> him a piece<sup>H6400</sup> of a cake<sup>H1690</sup> of figs, and two<sup>H8147</sup> clusters of raisins<sup>H6778</sup>: and when he had eaten<sup>H398</sup>, his spirit<sup>H7307</sup> came again<sup>H7725</sup> to him: for he had eaten<sup>H398</sup> no bread<sup>H3899</sup>, nor drunk<sup>H8354</sup> any water<sup>H4325</sup>, three<sup>H7969</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> and three<sup>H7969</sup> nights<sup>H3915</sup>. 13 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, To whom belondest thou? and whence art thou? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, I am a young man<sup>H5288</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4713</sup>, servant<sup>H5650</sup> to an Amalekite<sup>H376</sup>; and my master<sup>H113</sup> left<sup>H5800</sup> me, because three<sup>H7969</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> ago I fell sick<sup>H2470</sup>. 14 We made an invasion<sup>H6584</sup> upon the south<sup>H5045</sup> of the Cherethites<sup>H3774</sup>, and upon the coast which belongeth to Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and upon the south<sup>H5045</sup> of Caleb<sup>H3612</sup>; and we burned<sup>H8313</sup> Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup> with fire<sup>H784</sup>. 15 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to him, Canst thou bring me down<sup>H3381</sup> to this company<sup>H1416</sup>? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Swear<sup>H7650</sup> unto me by God<sup>H430</sup>, that thou wilt neither kill<sup>H4191</sup> me, nor<sup>H518</sup> deliver<sup>H5462</sup> me into the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of my master<sup>H113</sup>, and I will bring thee down<sup>H3381</sup> to this company<sup>H1416</sup>. 16 And when he had brought him down<sup>H3381</sup>, behold, they were spread abroad<sup>H5203</sup> upon all<sup>H6440</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup>, eating<sup>H398</sup> and drinking<sup>H8354</sup>, and dancing<sup>H2287</sup>, because of all the great<sup>H1419</sup> spoil<sup>H7998</sup> that they had taken<sup>H3947</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 17 And David<sup>H1732</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> them from the twilight<sup>H5399</sup> even unto the evening<sup>H6153</sup> of the next day<sup>H4283</sup>: and there escaped<sup>H4422</sup> not a man<sup>H376</sup> of them, save four<sup>H702</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> young<sup>H5288</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>, which rode<sup>H7392</sup> upon camels<sup>H1581</sup>, and fled<sup>H5127</sup>. 18 And David<sup>H1732</sup> recovered<sup>H5337</sup> all that the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup> had carried away<sup>H3947</sup>: and David<sup>H1732</sup> rescued<sup>H5337</sup> his two<sup>H8147</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup>. 19 And there was nothing lacking<sup>H5737</sup> to them, neither<sup>H4480</sup> small<sup>H6996</sup> nor great<sup>H1419</sup>, neither sons<sup>H1121</sup> nor daughters<sup>H1323</sup>, neither spoil<sup>H7998</sup>, nor any thing that they had taken<sup>H3947</sup> to them: David<sup>H1732</sup> recovered<sup>H7725</sup> all. 20 And David<sup>H1732</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> all the flocks<sup>H6629</sup> and the herds<sup>H1241</sup>, which they drove<sup>H5090</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> those<sup>H1931</sup> other cattle<sup>H4735</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, This is David's<sup>H1732</sup> spoil<sup>H7998</sup>.

21 And David<sup>H1732</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to the two hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H582</sup>, which were so faint<sup>H6296</sup> that they could not follow<sup>H3212</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, whom they had made also to abide<sup>H3427</sup> at the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Besor<sup>H1308</sup>: and they went forth<sup>H3318</sup> to

meet<sup>H7125</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, and to meet<sup>H7125</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were with him: and when David<sup>H1732</sup> came near<sup>H5066</sup> to the  
 people<sup>H5971</sup>, he saluted<sup>H7592 H7965</sup> them.<sup>3</sup> **22** Then answered<sup>H6030</sup> all the wicked<sup>H7451</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> and men of Belial<sup>H1100</sup>, of  
 those<sup>H582</sup> that went<sup>H1980</sup> with David<sup>H1732</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Because they went<sup>H1980</sup> not with us, we will not give<sup>H5414</sup> them  
 ought of the spoil<sup>H7998</sup> that we have recovered<sup>H5337</sup>, save to every man<sup>H376</sup> his wife<sup>H802</sup> and his children<sup>H1121</sup>, that they  
 may lead them away<sup>H5090</sup>, and depart<sup>H3212 4</sup>. **23** Then said<sup>H559</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, Ye shall not do so<sup>H6213</sup>, my brethren<sup>H251</sup>, with  
 that which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath given<sup>H5414</sup> us, who hath preserved<sup>H8104</sup> us, and delivered<sup>H5414</sup> the company<sup>H1416</sup> that  
 came<sup>H935</sup> against us into our hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **24** For who will hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto you in this matter<sup>H1697</sup>? but as his part<sup>H2506</sup> is  
 that goeth down<sup>H3381 H3381</sup> to the battle<sup>H4421</sup>, so shall his part<sup>H2506</sup> be that tarrieth<sup>H3427</sup> by the stuff<sup>H3627</sup>: they shall  
 part<sup>H2505</sup> alike<sup>H3162</sup>. **25** And it was so from that day<sup>H3117</sup> forward<sup>H4605</sup>, that he made<sup>H7760</sup> it a statute<sup>H2706</sup> and an  
 ordinance<sup>H4941</sup> for Israel<sup>H3478</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117 5</sup>. **26** And when David<sup>H1732</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup>, he sent<sup>H7971</sup> of the  
 spoil<sup>H7998</sup> unto the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, even to his friends<sup>H7453</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold a present<sup>H1293</sup> for you of the  
 spoil<sup>H7998</sup> of the enemies<sup>H341</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068,6</sup>, **27** To them<sup>H834</sup> which were in Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>, and to them which were in  
 south<sup>H5045</sup> Ramoth<sup>H7418</sup>, and to them which were in Jattir<sup>H3492</sup>, **28** And to them which were in Aroer<sup>H6177</sup>, and to them  
 which were in Siphmoth<sup>H8224</sup>, and to them which were in Eshtemoa<sup>H851</sup>, **29** And to them which were in Rachal<sup>H7403</sup>, and to  
 them which were in the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of the Jerahmeelites<sup>H3397</sup>, and to them which were in the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of the Kenites<sup>H7017</sup>,  
**30** And to them which were in Hormah<sup>H2767</sup>, and to them which were in Chorashan<sup>H3565</sup>, and to them which were in  
 Athach<sup>H6269</sup>, **31** And to them which were in Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>, and to all the places<sup>H4725</sup> where David<sup>H1732</sup> himself and his  
 men<sup>H582</sup> were wont to haunt<sup>H1980</sup>.
