## 2. Chronicles 1

1 And Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> was strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> in his kingdom<sup>H4438</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup> was with him, and magnified<sup>H1431</sup> him exceedingly<sup>H4605</sup>. 2 Then Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> spake<sup>H559</sup> unto all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, to the captains H8269 of thousands H505 and of hundreds and to the judges H8199, and to every governor in all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, the chief<sup>H7218</sup> of the fathers<sup>H1</sup>. **3** So Solomon<sup>H8010</sup>, and all the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> with him, went<sup>H3212</sup> to the high place H1116 that was at Gibeon H1391; for there was the tabernacle of the congregation of God H430, which Moses<sup>H4872</sup> the servant<sup>H5650</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had made<sup>H6213</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>. **4** But<sup>H61</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> had David H1732 brought up H5927 from Kirjathjearim to the place which David had prepared for it: for he had pitched<sup>H5186</sup> a tent<sup>H168</sup> for it at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 5 Moreover the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup>, that Bezaleel<sup>H1212</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Uri<sup>H221</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Hur<sup>H2354</sup>, had made<sup>H6213</sup>, he put<sup>H7760</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> and the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> sought<sup>H1875</sup> unto it.<sup>1</sup> 6 And Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> thither to the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, which was at the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the congregation<sup>H4150</sup>, and and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Ask<sup>H7592</sup> what I shall give<sup>H5414</sup> thee. 8 And Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup>, Thou hast shewed H6213 great mercy mercy unto David my father and hast made me to reign h4427 in his stead. 9 Now, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, let thy promise<sup>H1697</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup> my father<sup>H1</sup> be established<sup>H539</sup>: for thou hast made me king H4427 over a people H5971 like the dust H6083 of the earth in multitude H7227.2 10 Give H5414 me now wisdom and knowledge<sup>H4093</sup>, that I may go out<sup>H3318</sup> and come in<sup>H935</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> this people<sup>H5971</sup>: for who can judge<sup>H8199</sup> this thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, that is so great<sup>H1419</sup>? **11** And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Solomon<sup>H8010</sup>. Because this was in thine heart<sup>H3824</sup>, and thou hast not asked H5592 riches H6239, wealth H5233, or honour H3519, nor the life H5315 of thine enemies H8130, neither yet hast asked H7592 long H7227 life H3117; but hast asked H7592 wisdom and knowledge H4093 for thyself, that thou mayest judge H8199 my people H5971, over whom I have made thee king H4427: 12 Wisdom and knowledge H4093 is granted H5414 unto thee; and I will give H5414 thee riches H6239, and wealth H5233, and honour H3519, such as none of the kings H4428 have had that have been before H6440 thee, neither shall there any after H310 thee have the like.

13 Then Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> from his journey to the high place<sup>H1116</sup> that was at Gibeon<sup>H1391</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, from before<sup>H6440</sup> the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the congregation<sup>H4150</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 14 And Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> gathered<sup>H622</sup> chariots<sup>H7393</sup> and horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>: and he had a thousand<sup>H505</sup> and four<sup>H702</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and twelve<sup>H8147</sup> H6240 thousand<sup>H505</sup> horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>, which he placed<sup>H3240</sup> in the chariot<sup>H7393</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup>, and with the king<sup>H4428</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 15 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> made<sup>H5414</sup> silver<sup>H3701</sup> and gold<sup>H2091</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> as plenteous as stones<sup>H68</sup>, and cedar trees<sup>H730</sup> made<sup>H5414</sup> he as the sycomore trees<sup>H8256</sup> that are in the vale<sup>H8219</sup> for abundance<sup>H7230</sup>.<sup>3</sup> 16 And Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> had horses<sup>H5483</sup> brought<sup>H4161</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, and linen yarn<sup>H4723</sup>: the king's<sup>H4428</sup> merchants<sup>H5503</sup> received<sup>H3947</sup> the linen yarn<sup>H4723</sup> at a price<sup>H4242</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 17 And they fetched up<sup>H5927</sup>, and brought forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> a chariot<sup>H4818</sup> for six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> shekels of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and an horse<sup>H5483</sup> for an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> and fifty<sup>H2572</sup>: and so brought they out<sup>H3318</sup> horses for all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the Hittites<sup>H2850</sup>, and for the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, by their means<sup>H3027</sup>.<sup>5</sup>
