

## 2. Chronicles 12

1 And it came to pass, when Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> had established<sup>H3559</sup> the kingdom<sup>H4438</sup>, and had strengthened<sup>H2393</sup> himself, he forsook<sup>H5800</sup> the law<sup>H8451</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> with him. 2 And it came to pass, that in the fifth<sup>H2549</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of king<sup>H4428</sup> Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> Shishak<sup>H7895</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> came up<sup>H5927</sup> against Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, because they had transgressed<sup>H4603</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, 3 With twelve hundred<sup>H3967</sup> <sup>H505</sup> chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and threescore<sup>H8346</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> were without number<sup>H4557</sup> that came<sup>H935</sup> with him out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>; the Lubims<sup>H3864</sup>, the Sukkiims<sup>H5525</sup>, and the Ethiopians<sup>H3569</sup>. 4 And he took<sup>H3920</sup> the fenced<sup>H4694</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup> which pertained to Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 5 Then came<sup>H935</sup> Shemaiah<sup>H8098</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> to Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup>, and to the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, that were gathered together<sup>H622</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of Shishak<sup>H7895</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Ye have forsaken<sup>H5800</sup> me, and therefore have I also<sup>H637</sup> left<sup>H5800</sup> you in the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Shishak<sup>H7895</sup>. 6 Whereupon the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and the king<sup>H4428</sup> humbled<sup>H3665</sup> themselves; and they said<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is righteous<sup>H6662</sup>. 7 And when the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that they humbled<sup>H3665</sup> themselves, the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came to Shemaiah<sup>H8098</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, They have humbled<sup>H3665</sup> themselves; therefore I will not destroy<sup>H7843</sup> them, but I will grant<sup>H5414</sup> them some<sup>H4592</sup> deliverance<sup>H6413</sup>; and my wrath<sup>H2534</sup> shall not be poured out<sup>H5413</sup> upon Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Shishak<sup>H7895</sup>. 8 Nevertheless they shall be his servants<sup>H5650</sup>, that they may know<sup>H3045</sup> my service<sup>H5656</sup>, and the service<sup>H5656</sup> of the kingdoms<sup>H4467</sup> of the countries<sup>H776</sup>. 9 So Shishak<sup>H7895</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> came up<sup>H5927</sup> against Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and took away<sup>H3947</sup> the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>; he took<sup>H3947</sup> all: he carried away<sup>H3947</sup> also the shields<sup>H4043</sup> of gold<sup>H2091</sup> which Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> had made<sup>H6213</sup>. 10 Instead of which king<sup>H4428</sup> Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> shields<sup>H4043</sup> of brass<sup>H5178</sup>, and committed<sup>H6485</sup> them to the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of the chief<sup>H8269</sup> of the guard<sup>H7323</sup>, that kept<sup>H8104</sup> the entrance<sup>H6607</sup> of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>. 11 And when<sup>H1767</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> entered<sup>H935</sup> into the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the guard<sup>H7323</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> and fetched<sup>H5375</sup> them, and brought them again<sup>H7725</sup> into the guard<sup>H7323</sup> chamber<sup>H8372</sup>. 12 And when he humbled<sup>H3665</sup> himself, the wrath<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> turned<sup>H7725</sup> from him, that he would not destroy<sup>H7843</sup> him altogether<sup>H3617</sup>: and also in Judah<sup>H3063</sup> things<sup>H1697</sup> went well<sup>H2896</sup>.

13 So king<sup>H4428</sup> Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> himself in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup>: for Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> was one<sup>H259</sup> and forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> seventeen<sup>H7651</sup> <sup>H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, the city<sup>H5892</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had chosen<sup>H977</sup> out of all the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, to put<sup>H7760</sup> his name<sup>H8034</sup> there. And his mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> was Naamah<sup>H5279</sup> an Ammonitess<sup>H5985</sup>. 14 And he did<sup>H7451</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>, because he prepared<sup>H3559</sup> not his heart<sup>H3820</sup> to seek<sup>H1875</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 15 Now the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup>, first<sup>H7223</sup> and last<sup>H314</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H1697</sup> of Shemaiah<sup>H8098</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, and of Iddo<sup>H5714</sup> the seer<sup>H2374</sup> concerning genealogies<sup>H3187</sup>? And there were wars<sup>H4421</sup> between Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> and Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> continually<sup>H3117</sup>. 16 And Rehoboam<sup>H7346</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>: and Abijah<sup>H29</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.
