Herein thou hast done foolishly<sup>H5528</sup>: therefore from henceforth<sup>H6258</sup> thou shalt have<sup>H3426</sup> wars H4421.4 10 Then Asa was wroth was wroth with the seer and put him in a prison house house house for he was in a rage H2197 with him because of this thing.
