

## 2. Chronicles 27

1 Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> was twenty<sup>H6242</sup> and five<sup>H2568</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> sixteen<sup>H8337 H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. His mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> also was Jerushah<sup>H3388</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Zadok<sup>H6659</sup>. 2 And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, according to all that his father<sup>H1</sup> Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup>: howbeit he entered<sup>H935</sup> not into the temple<sup>H1964</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. And the people<sup>H5971</sup> did yet corruptly<sup>H7843</sup>. 3 He built<sup>H1129</sup> the high<sup>H5945</sup> gate<sup>H8179</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and on the wall<sup>H2346</sup> of Ophel<sup>H6077</sup> he built<sup>H1129</sup> much<sup>H7230</sup>. 4 Moreover he built<sup>H1129</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup> in the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and in the forests<sup>H2793</sup> he built<sup>H1129</sup> castles<sup>H1003</sup> and towers<sup>H4026</sup>. 5 He fought<sup>H3898</sup> also with the king<sup>H4428</sup> of the Ammonites<sup>H5984</sup>, and prevailed<sup>H2388</sup> against them. And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> him the same year<sup>H8141</sup> an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> talents<sup>H3603</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and ten<sup>H6235</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> measures<sup>H3734</sup> of wheat<sup>H2406</sup>, and ten<sup>H6235</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> of barley<sup>H8184</sup>. So much did the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup> pay<sup>H7725</sup> unto<sup>H2063</sup> him, both the second<sup>H8145</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup>, and the third<sup>H7992</sup>. 6 So Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> became mighty<sup>H2388</sup>, because he prepared<sup>H3559</sup> his ways<sup>H1870</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>. 7 Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Jotham<sup>H3147</sup>, and all his wars<sup>H4421</sup>, and his ways<sup>H1870</sup>, lo, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 8 He was five<sup>H2568</sup> and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> sixteen<sup>H8337 H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 9 And Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>: and Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.
