

## 2. Chronicles 36

1 Then the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Josiah<sup>H2977</sup>, and made him king<sup>H4427</sup> in his father's<sup>H1</sup> stead in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 2 Jehoahaz<sup>H3099</sup> was twenty<sup>H6242</sup> and three<sup>H7969</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> three<sup>H7969</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 3 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> put him down<sup>H5493</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and condemned<sup>H6064</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup> in an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> talents<sup>H3603</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup> and a talent<sup>H3603</sup> of gold<sup>H2091</sup>. 4 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> made Eliakim<sup>H471</sup> his brother<sup>H251</sup> king<sup>H4427</sup> over Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and turned<sup>H5437</sup> his name<sup>H8034</sup> to Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup>. And Necho<sup>H5224</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> Jehoahaz<sup>H3099</sup> his brother<sup>H251</sup>, and carried<sup>H935</sup> him to Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 5 Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> was twenty<sup>H6242</sup> and five<sup>H2568</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> eleven<sup>H259</sup> years<sup>H6240</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>: and he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>. 6 Against him came up<sup>H5927</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, and bound<sup>H631</sup> him in fetters<sup>H5178</sup>, to carry<sup>H3212</sup> him to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>. 7 Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> also carried<sup>H935</sup> of the vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, and put<sup>H5414</sup> them in his temple<sup>H1964</sup> at Babylon<sup>H894</sup>. 8 Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup>, and his abominations<sup>H8441</sup> which he did<sup>H6213</sup>, and that which was found<sup>H4672</sup> in him, behold, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>: and Jehoiachin<sup>H3078</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.<sup>3</sup> 9 Jehoiachin<sup>H3078</sup> was eight<sup>H8083</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> three<sup>H7969</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup> and ten<sup>H6235</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>: and he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 10 And when the year<sup>H8141</sup> was expired<sup>H8666</sup>, king<sup>H4428</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup>, and brought<sup>H935</sup> him to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, with the goodly<sup>H2532</sup> vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and made Zedekiah<sup>H6667</sup> his brother<sup>H251</sup> king<sup>H4427</sup> over Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 456

11 Zedekiah<sup>H6667</sup> was one<sup>H259</sup> and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> eleven<sup>H259</sup> years<sup>H6240</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 12 And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>, and humbled<sup>H3665</sup> not himself before<sup>H6440</sup> Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> speaking from the mouth<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 13 And he also rebelled<sup>H4775</sup> against king<sup>H4428</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup>, who had made him swear<sup>H7650</sup> by God<sup>H430</sup>: but he stiffened<sup>H7185</sup> his neck<sup>H6203</sup>, and hardened<sup>H553</sup> his heart<sup>H3824</sup> from turning<sup>H7725</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 14 Moreover all the chief<sup>H8269</sup> of the priests<sup>H3548</sup>, and the people<sup>H5971</sup>, transgressed<sup>H4603</sup> very<sup>H4604</sup> much<sup>H7235</sup> after all the abominations<sup>H8441</sup> of the heathen<sup>H1471</sup>; and polluted<sup>H2930</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> which he had hallowed<sup>H6942</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 15 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of their fathers<sup>H1</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> to them by<sup>H3027</sup> his messengers<sup>H4397</sup>, rising up betimes<sup>H7925</sup>, and sending<sup>H7971</sup>; because he had compassion<sup>H2550</sup> on his people<sup>H5971</sup>, and on his dwelling place<sup>H4583</sup>. 16 But they mocked<sup>H3931</sup> the messengers<sup>H4397</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, and despised<sup>H959</sup> his words<sup>H1697</sup>, and misused<sup>H8591</sup> his prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, until the wrath<sup>H2534</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> arose<sup>H5927</sup> against his people<sup>H5971</sup>, till there was no remedy<sup>H4832</sup>. 17 Therefore he brought<sup>H5927</sup> upon them the king<sup>H4428</sup> of the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup>, who slew<sup>H2026</sup> their young men<sup>H970</sup> with the sword<sup>H2719</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of their sanctuary<sup>H4720</sup>, and had no compassion<sup>H2550</sup> upon young man<sup>H970</sup> or maiden<sup>H1330</sup>, old man<sup>H2205</sup>, or him that stooped for age<sup>H3486</sup>: he gave<sup>H5414</sup> them all into his hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 18 And all the vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, great<sup>H1419</sup> and small<sup>H6996</sup>, and the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and of his princes<sup>H8269</sup>; all these he brought<sup>H935</sup> to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>. 19 And they burnt<sup>H8313</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, and brake down<sup>H5422</sup> the wall<sup>H2346</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and burnt<sup>H8313</sup> all the palaces<sup>H759</sup> thereof with fire<sup>H784</sup>, and destroyed<sup>H7843</sup> all the goodly<sup>H4261</sup> vessels<sup>H3627</sup> thereof. 20 And them that had escaped<sup>H7611</sup> from the sword<sup>H2719</sup> carried he away<sup>H1540</sup> to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>; where they were servants<sup>H5650</sup> to him and his sons<sup>H1121</sup> until the reign<sup>H4427</sup> of the kingdom<sup>H4438</sup> of Persia<sup>H6539</sup>. 21 To fulfil<sup>H4390</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> by the mouth<sup>H6310</sup> of Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup>, until the land<sup>H776</sup> had enjoyed<sup>H7521</sup> her sabbaths<sup>H7676</sup>: for as long as<sup>H3117</sup> she lay desolate<sup>H8074</sup> she kept sabbath<sup>H7673</sup>, to fulfil<sup>H4390</sup> threescore

and ten<sup>H7657</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>.

22 Now in the first<sup>H259</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Cyrus<sup>H3566</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Persia<sup>H6539</sup>, that the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spoken by the mouth<sup>H6310</sup> of Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> might be accomplished<sup>H3615</sup>, the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> stirred up<sup>H5782</sup> the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of Cyrus<sup>H3566</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Persia<sup>H6539</sup>, that he made a proclamation<sup>H5674 H6963</sup> throughout all his kingdom<sup>H4438</sup>, and put it also in writing<sup>H4385</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, **23** Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> Cyrus<sup>H3566</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Persia<sup>H6539</sup>, All the kingdoms<sup>H4467</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> hath the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup> given<sup>H5414</sup> me; and he hath charged<sup>H6485</sup> me to build<sup>H1129</sup> him an house<sup>H1004</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, which is in Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. Who is there among you of all his people<sup>H5971</sup>? The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup> be with him, and let him go up<sup>H5927</sup>.
