

## 2. Kings 25

Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs



1 And it came to pass in the ninth<sup>H8671</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of his reign<sup>H4427</sup>, in the tenth<sup>H6224</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>, in the tenth<sup>H6218</sup> day of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, that Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> came<sup>H935</sup>, he, and all his host<sup>H2428</sup>, against Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and pitched<sup>H2583</sup> against it; and they built<sup>H1129</sup> forts<sup>H1785</sup> against it round about<sup>H5439</sup>. 2 And the city<sup>H5892</sup> was besieged<sup>H935 H4692</sup> unto the eleventh<sup>H6249 H6240</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of king<sup>H4428</sup> Zedekiah<sup>H6667</sup>. 3 And on the ninth<sup>H8672</sup> day of the fourth month<sup>H2320</sup> the famine<sup>H7458</sup> prevailed<sup>H2388</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and there was no bread<sup>H5892</sup> for the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>. 4 And the city<sup>H5892</sup> was broken up<sup>H1234</sup>, and all the men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> fled by night<sup>H3915</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the gate<sup>H8179</sup> between two walls<sup>H2346</sup>, which is by the king's<sup>H4428</sup> garden<sup>H1588</sup>: (now the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup> were against the city<sup>H5892</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>;) and the king went<sup>H3212</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> toward the plain<sup>H6160</sup>. 5 And the army<sup>H2428</sup> of the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup> pursued<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and overtook<sup>H5381</sup> him in the plains<sup>H6160</sup> of Jericho<sup>H3405</sup>: and all his army<sup>H2428</sup> were scattered<sup>H6327</sup> from him. 6 So they took<sup>H8610</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and brought him up<sup>H5927</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> to Riblah<sup>H7247</sup>; and they gave<sup>H1696</sup> judgment<sup>H4941</sup> upon him. 7 And they slew<sup>H7819</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Zedekiah<sup>H6667</sup> before his eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, and put out<sup>H5786</sup> the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of Zedekiah<sup>H6667</sup>, and bound<sup>H631</sup> him with fetters<sup>H5178</sup> of brass<sup>H5178</sup>, and carried<sup>H935</sup> him to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>. 2

8 And in the fifth<sup>H2549</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>, on the seventh<sup>H7651</sup> day of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, which is the nineteenth<sup>H8672 H6240 H8141</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of king<sup>H4428</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, came<sup>H935</sup> Nebuzaradan<sup>H5018</sup>, captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup>, a servant<sup>H5650</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, unto Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 9 And he burnt<sup>H8313</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and all the houses<sup>H1004</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and every great<sup>H1419</sup> man's house<sup>H1004</sup> burnt<sup>H8313</sup> he with fire<sup>H784</sup>. 10 And all the army<sup>H2428</sup> of the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup>, that were with the captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup>, brake down<sup>H5422</sup> the walls<sup>H2346</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>. 11 Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were left<sup>H7604</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and the fugitives<sup>H5307</sup> that fell away<sup>H5307</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, with the remnant<sup>H3499</sup> of the multitude<sup>H1995</sup>, did Nebuzaradan<sup>H5018</sup> the captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup> carry away<sup>H1540</sup>. 12 But the captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup> left<sup>H7604</sup> of the poor<sup>H1803</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> to be vinedressers<sup>H3755</sup> and husbandmen<sup>H3009 H1461</sup>. 13 And the pillars<sup>H5982</sup> of brass<sup>H5178</sup> that were in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the bases<sup>H4350</sup>, and the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> sea<sup>H3220</sup> that was in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, did the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup> break in pieces<sup>H7665</sup>, and carried<sup>H5375</sup> the brass<sup>H5178</sup> of them to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>. 14 And the pots<sup>H5518</sup>, and the shovels<sup>H3257</sup>, and the snuffers<sup>H4212</sup>, and the spoons<sup>H3709</sup>, and all the vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of brass<sup>H5178</sup> wherewith they ministered<sup>H8334</sup>, took they away<sup>H3947</sup>. 15 And the firepans<sup>H4289</sup>, and the bowls<sup>H4219</sup>, and such things as were of gold<sup>H2091</sup>, in gold<sup>H2091</sup>, and of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, in silver<sup>H3701</sup>, the captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup> took away<sup>H3947</sup>. 16 The two<sup>H8147</sup> pillars<sup>H5982</sup>, one<sup>H259</sup> sea<sup>H3220</sup>, and the bases<sup>H4350</sup> which Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> had made<sup>H6213</sup> for the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the brass<sup>H5178</sup> of all these vessels<sup>H3627</sup> was without<sup>H3808</sup> weight<sup>H4948</sup>. 17 The height<sup>H6967</sup> of the one<sup>H259</sup> pillar<sup>H5982</sup> was eighteen<sup>H8083 H6240</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, and the chapter<sup>H3805</sup> upon it was brass<sup>H5178</sup>: and the height<sup>H6967</sup> of the chapter<sup>H3805</sup> three<sup>H7969</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, and the wreathen work<sup>H7639</sup>, and pomegranates<sup>H7416</sup> upon the chapter<sup>H3805</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>, all of brass<sup>H5178</sup>: and like unto these had the second<sup>H8145</sup> pillar<sup>H5982</sup> with wreathen work<sup>H7639</sup>. 18 And the captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> Seraiah<sup>H8304</sup> the chief<sup>H7218</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and Zephaniah<sup>H6846</sup> the second<sup>H4932</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and the three<sup>H7969</sup> keepers<sup>H8104</sup> of the door<sup>H5592</sup>. 19 And out of the city<sup>H5892</sup> he took<sup>H3947</sup> an<sup>H259</sup> officer<sup>H5631</sup> that was set<sup>H6496</sup> over the men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup>, and five<sup>H2568</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> of them that were<sup>H7200</sup> in the king's<sup>H4428</sup> presence<sup>H6440</sup>, which were found<sup>H4672</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and the principal<sup>H8269</sup> scribe<sup>H5608</sup> of the host<sup>H6635</sup>, which mustered<sup>H6633</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, and threescore<sup>H8346</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> that were found<sup>H4672</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup>. 20 And Nebuzaradan<sup>H5018</sup> captain<sup>H7227</sup> of the guard<sup>H2876</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> these, and brought<sup>H3212</sup> them to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> to Riblah<sup>H7247</sup>: 21 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> them, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> them at Riblah<sup>H7247</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Hamath<sup>H2574</sup>. So Judah<sup>H3063</sup> was carried away<sup>H1540</sup> out of their land<sup>H127</sup>.

22 And as for the people<sup>H5971</sup> that remained<sup>H7604</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, whom Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> had left<sup>H7604</sup>, even over them he made Gedaliah<sup>H1436</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahikam<sup>H296</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Shaphan<sup>H8227</sup>, ruler<sup>H6485</sup>. 23 And when all the captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the armies<sup>H2428</sup>, they and their men<sup>H582</sup>, heard<sup>H8085</sup> that the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> had made Gedaliah<sup>H1436</sup> governor<sup>H6485</sup>, there came<sup>H935</sup> to Gedaliah<sup>H1436</sup> to Mizpah<sup>H4709</sup>, even Ishmael<sup>H3458</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nethaniah<sup>H5418</sup>, and Johanan<sup>H3110</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Careah<sup>H7143</sup>, and Seraiah<sup>H8304</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Tanhumeth<sup>H8576</sup> the Netophathite<sup>H5200</sup>, and Jaazaniah<sup>H2970</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of a Maachathite<sup>H4602</sup>, they and their men<sup>H582</sup>. 24 And Gedaliah<sup>H1436</sup> swore<sup>H7650</sup> to them, and to their men<sup>H582</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Fear<sup>H3372</sup> not to be the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup>: dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup>, and serve<sup>H5647</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>; and it shall be well<sup>H3190</sup> with you. 25 But it came to pass in the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>, that Ishmael<sup>H3458</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nethaniah<sup>H5418</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Elishama<sup>H476</sup>, of the seed<sup>H2233</sup> royal<sup>H4410</sup>, came<sup>H935</sup>, and ten<sup>H6235</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> with him, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> Gedaliah<sup>H1436</sup>, that he died<sup>H4191</sup>, and the Jews<sup>H3064</sup> and the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup> that were with him at Mizpah<sup>H4709</sup>. 10 26 And all the people<sup>H5971</sup>, both small<sup>H6996</sup> and great<sup>H1419</sup>, and the captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the armies<sup>H2428</sup>, arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>: for they were afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of<sup>H6440</sup> the Chaldees<sup>H3778</sup>. 27 And it came to pass in the seven<sup>H7651</sup> and thirtieth<sup>H7970</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of the captivity<sup>H1546</sup> of Jehoiachin<sup>H3078</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, in the twelfth<sup>H8147</sup> month<sup>H6240</sup>, on the seven<sup>H7651</sup> and twentieth<sup>H6242</sup> day of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, that Evilmerodach<sup>H192</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> in the year<sup>H8141</sup> that he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> did lift up<sup>H5375</sup> the head<sup>H7218</sup> of Jehoiachin<sup>H3078</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> out of prison<sup>H1004</sup>; 28 And he spake<sup>H1696</sup> kindly<sup>H2896</sup> to him, and set<sup>H5414</sup> his throne<sup>H3678</sup> above the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> that were with him in Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, 11 29 And changed<sup>H8132</sup> his prison<sup>H3608</sup> garments<sup>H899</sup>: and he did eat<sup>H398</sup> bread<sup>H3899</sup> continually<sup>H8548</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> him all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of his life<sup>H2416</sup>. 30 And his allowance<sup>H737</sup> was a continual<sup>H8548</sup> allowance<sup>H737</sup> given<sup>H5414</sup> him of the king<sup>H4428</sup>, a daily<sup>H3117</sup> rate<sup>H1697</sup> for every day<sup>H3117</sup>, all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of his life<sup>H2416</sup>.
