

## 2. Kings 7

1 Then Elisha<sup>H477</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Hear<sup>H8085</sup> ye the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, To morrow<sup>H4279</sup> about this time<sup>H6256</sup> shall a measure<sup>H5429</sup> of fine flour<sup>H5560</sup> be sold for a shekel<sup>H8255</sup>, and two measures<sup>H5429</sup> of barley<sup>H8184</sup> for a shekel<sup>H8255</sup>, in the gate<sup>H8179</sup> of Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>. 2 Then a lord<sup>H7991</sup> on whose hand<sup>H3027</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> leaned<sup>H8172</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> the man<sup>H376</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, if the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> would make<sup>H6213</sup> windows<sup>H699</sup> in heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, might this thing<sup>H1697</sup> be? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, thou shalt see<sup>H7200</sup> it with thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, but shalt not eat<sup>H398</sup> thereof.<sup>1</sup>

3 And there were four<sup>H702</sup> leprous<sup>H6879</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> at the entering in<sup>H6607</sup> of the gate<sup>H8179</sup>: and they said<sup>H559</sup> one<sup>H376</sup> to another<sup>H7453</sup>, Why sit<sup>H3427</sup> we here until we die<sup>H4191</sup>? 4 If we say<sup>H559</sup>, We will enter<sup>H935</sup> into the city<sup>H5892</sup>, then the famine<sup>H7458</sup> is in the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and we shall die<sup>H4191</sup> there: and if we sit still<sup>H3427</sup> here, we die<sup>H4191</sup> also. Now therefore come<sup>H3212</sup>, and let us fall<sup>H5307</sup> unto the host<sup>H4264</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup>: if they save us alive<sup>H2421</sup>, we shall live<sup>H2421</sup>; and if they kill<sup>H4191</sup> us, we shall but die<sup>H4191</sup>. 5 And they rose up<sup>H6965</sup> in the twilight<sup>H5399</sup>, to go<sup>H935</sup> unto the camp<sup>H4264</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup>: and when they were come<sup>H935</sup> to the uttermost part<sup>H7097</sup> of the camp<sup>H4264</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, behold, there was no man<sup>H376</sup> there. 6 For the Lord<sup>H136</sup> had made the host<sup>H4264</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> to hear<sup>H8085</sup> a noise<sup>H6963</sup> of chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and a noise<sup>H6963</sup> of horses<sup>H5483</sup>, even the noise<sup>H6963</sup> of a great<sup>H1419</sup> host<sup>H2428</sup>: and they said<sup>H559</sup> one<sup>H376</sup> to another<sup>H251</sup>, Lo, the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> hath hired<sup>H7936</sup> against us the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the Hittites<sup>H2850</sup>, and the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the Egyptians<sup>H4714</sup>, to come<sup>H935</sup> upon us. 7 Wherefore they arose<sup>H6965</sup> and fled<sup>H5127</sup> in the twilight<sup>H5399</sup>, and left<sup>H5800</sup> their tents<sup>H168</sup>, and their horses<sup>H5483</sup>, and their asses<sup>H2543</sup>, even the camp<sup>H4264</sup> as it was, and fled<sup>H5127</sup> for their life<sup>H5315</sup>. 8 And when these lepers<sup>H6879</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to the uttermost part<sup>H7097</sup> of the camp<sup>H4264</sup>, they went<sup>H935</sup> into one<sup>H259</sup> tent<sup>H168</sup>, and did eat<sup>H398</sup> and drink<sup>H8354</sup>, and carried<sup>H5375</sup> thence silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and gold<sup>H2091</sup>, and raiment<sup>H899</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> and hid<sup>H2934</sup> it; and came again<sup>H7725</sup>, and entered<sup>H935</sup> into another<sup>H312</sup> tent<sup>H168</sup>, and carried<sup>H5375</sup> thence also, and went<sup>H3212</sup> and hid<sup>H2934</sup> it. 9 Then they said<sup>H559</sup> one<sup>H376</sup> to another<sup>H7453</sup>, We do<sup>H6213</sup> not well: this day<sup>H3117</sup> is a day<sup>H3117</sup> of good tidings<sup>H1309</sup>, and we hold our peace<sup>H2814</sup>: if we tarry<sup>H2442</sup> till the morning<sup>H1242</sup> light<sup>H216</sup>, some mischief<sup>H5771</sup> will come<sup>H4672</sup> upon us: now therefore come<sup>H3212</sup>, that we may go<sup>H935</sup> and tell<sup>H5046</sup> the king's<sup>H4428</sup> household<sup>H1004</sup>. 10 So they came<sup>H935</sup> and called<sup>H7121</sup> unto the porter<sup>H7778</sup> of the city<sup>H5892</sup>: and they told<sup>H5046</sup> them, saying<sup>H559</sup>, We came<sup>H935</sup> to the camp<sup>H4264</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup>, and, behold, there was no man<sup>H376</sup> there, neither voice<sup>H6963</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, but horses<sup>H5483</sup> tied<sup>H631</sup>, and asses<sup>H2543</sup> tied<sup>H631</sup>, and the tents<sup>H168</sup> as they were. 11 And he called<sup>H7121</sup> the porters<sup>H7778</sup>, and they told<sup>H5046</sup> it to the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup> within<sup>H6441</sup>.

12 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup> in the night<sup>H3915</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto his servants<sup>H5650</sup>, I will now shew<sup>H5046</sup> you what the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> have done<sup>H6213</sup> to us. They know<sup>H3045</sup> that we be hungry<sup>H7457</sup>; therefore are they gone out<sup>H3318</sup> of the camp<sup>H4264</sup> to hide<sup>H2247</sup> themselves in the field<sup>H7704</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, When they come out<sup>H3318</sup> of the city<sup>H5892</sup>, we shall catch<sup>H8610</sup> them alive<sup>H2416</sup>, and get<sup>H935</sup> into the city<sup>H5892</sup>. 13 And one<sup>H259</sup> of his servants<sup>H5650</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> and said<sup>H559</sup>, Let some take<sup>H3947</sup>, I pray thee, five<sup>H2568</sup> of the horses<sup>H5483</sup> that remain<sup>H7604</sup>, which are left<sup>H7604</sup> in the city, (behold, they are as all the multitude<sup>H1995</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> that are left<sup>H7604</sup> in it: behold, I say, they are even as all the multitude<sup>H1995</sup> of the Israelites<sup>H3478</sup> that are consumed<sup>H8552</sup>;) and let us send<sup>H7971</sup> and see<sup>H7200</sup>. 14 They took<sup>H3947</sup> therefore two<sup>H8147</sup> chariot<sup>H7393</sup> horses<sup>H5483</sup>, and the king<sup>H4428</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the host<sup>H4264</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> and see<sup>H7200</sup>. 15 And they went<sup>H3212</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> them unto Jordan<sup>H3383</sup>: and, lo, all the way<sup>H1870</sup> was full<sup>H4392</sup> of garments<sup>H899</sup> and vessels<sup>H3627</sup>, which the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> had cast away<sup>H7993</sup> in their haste<sup>H2648</sup>. And the messengers<sup>H4397</sup> returned<sup>H7725</sup>, and told<sup>H5046</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>. 16 And the people<sup>H5971</sup> went out<sup>H3318</sup>, and spoiled<sup>H962</sup> the tents<sup>H4264</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup>. So a measure<sup>H5429</sup> of fine flour<sup>H5560</sup> was sold for a shekel<sup>H8255</sup>, and two measures<sup>H5429</sup> of barley<sup>H8184</sup> for a shekel<sup>H8255</sup>, according to the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 17 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> appointed<sup>H6485</sup> the

lord<sup>H7991</sup> on whose hand<sup>H3027</sup> he leaned<sup>H8172</sup> to have the charge of the gate<sup>H8179</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> trode<sup>H7429</sup> upon him in the gate<sup>H8179</sup>, and he died<sup>H4191</sup>, as the man<sup>H376</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> had said<sup>H1696</sup>, who spake<sup>H1696</sup> when the king<sup>H4428</sup> came down<sup>H3381</sup> to him. **18** And it came to pass as the man<sup>H376</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> had spoken<sup>H1696</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Two measures<sup>H5429</sup> of barley<sup>H8184</sup> for a shekel<sup>H8255</sup>, and a measure<sup>H5429</sup> of fine flour<sup>H5560</sup> for a shekel<sup>H8255</sup>, shall be to morrow<sup>H4279</sup> about this time<sup>H6256</sup> in the gate<sup>H8179</sup> of Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>: **19** And that lord<sup>H7991</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> the man<sup>H376</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Now, behold, if the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> should make<sup>H6213</sup> windows<sup>H699</sup> in heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, might such a thing<sup>H1697</sup> be? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, thou shalt see<sup>H7200</sup> it with thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, but shalt not eat<sup>H398</sup> thereof. **20** And so it fell out unto him: for the people<sup>H5971</sup> trode<sup>H7429</sup> upon him in the gate<sup>H8179</sup>, and he died<sup>H4191</sup>.
