

## 2. Samuel 2

1 And it came to pass after this<sup>H310</sup>, that David<sup>H1732</sup> enquired<sup>H7592</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Shall I go up<sup>H5927</sup> into any<sup>H259</sup> of the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Go up<sup>H5927</sup>. And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Whither shall I go up<sup>H5927</sup>? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Unto Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>. 2 So David<sup>H1732</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> thither, and his two<sup>H8147</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup> also, Ahinoam<sup>H293</sup> the Jezreelitess<sup>H3159</sup>, and Abigail<sup>H26</sup> Nabal's<sup>H5037</sup> wife<sup>H802</sup> the Carmelite<sup>H3761</sup>. 3 And his men<sup>H582</sup> that were with him did David<sup>H1732</sup> bring up<sup>H5927</sup>, every man<sup>H376</sup> with his household<sup>H1004</sup>: and they dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>. 4 And the men<sup>H582</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> came<sup>H935</sup>, and there they anointed<sup>H4886</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> over the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. And they told<sup>H5046</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, That the men<sup>H582</sup> of Jabeshgilead<sup>H3003</sup> H1568 were they that buried<sup>H6912</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>. 5 And David<sup>H1732</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> messengers<sup>H4397</sup> unto the men<sup>H582</sup> of Jabeshgilead<sup>H3003</sup> H1568, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be ye of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that ye have shewed<sup>H6213</sup> this kindness<sup>H2617</sup> unto your lord<sup>H1113</sup>, even unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, and have buried<sup>H6912</sup> him. 6 And now the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shew<sup>H6213</sup> kindness<sup>H2617</sup> and truth<sup>H571</sup> unto you: and I also will requite<sup>H6213</sup> you this kindness<sup>H2896</sup>, because ye have done<sup>H6213</sup> this thing<sup>H1697</sup>. 7 Therefore now let your hands<sup>H3027</sup> be strengthened<sup>H2388</sup>, and be ye valiant<sup>H1121</sup> H2428: for your master<sup>H1113</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> is dead<sup>H4191</sup>, and also the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> have anointed<sup>H4886</sup> me king<sup>H4428</sup> over them.<sup>1</sup>

8 But Abner<sup>H74</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ner<sup>H5369</sup>, captain<sup>H8269</sup> of Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> host<sup>H6635</sup>, took<sup>H3947</sup> Ishbosheth<sup>H378</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, and brought him over<sup>H5674</sup> to Mahanaim<sup>H4266</sup>,<sup>23</sup> 9 And made him king<sup>H4427</sup> over Gilead<sup>H1568</sup>, and over the Ashurites<sup>H805</sup>, and over Jezreel<sup>H3157</sup>, and over Ephraim<sup>H669</sup>, and over Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup>, and over all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 10 Ishbosheth<sup>H378</sup> Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> was forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. But the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> followed<sup>H310</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>. 11 And the time<sup>H4557</sup> H3117 that David<sup>H1732</sup> was king<sup>H4428</sup> in Hebron<sup>H2275</sup> over the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> was seven<sup>H7651</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> and six<sup>H8337</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 12 And Abner<sup>H74</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ner<sup>H5369</sup>, and the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Ishbosheth<sup>H378</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, went out<sup>H3318</sup> from Mahanaim<sup>H4266</sup> to Gibeon<sup>H1391</sup>. 13 And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zeruiah<sup>H6870</sup>, and the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, went out<sup>H3318</sup>, and met<sup>H6298</sup> together<sup>H3162</sup> by the pool<sup>H1295</sup> of Gibeon<sup>H1391</sup>: and they sat down<sup>H3427</sup>, the one on the one side of the pool<sup>H1295</sup>, and the other on the other side of the pool<sup>H1295</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 14 And Abner<sup>H74</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup>, Let the young men<sup>H5288</sup> now arise<sup>H6965</sup>, and play<sup>H7832</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> us. And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Let them arise<sup>H6965</sup>. 15 Then there arose<sup>H6965</sup> and went over<sup>H5674</sup> by number<sup>H4557</sup> twelve<sup>H8147</sup> H6240 of Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup>, which pertained to Ishbosheth<sup>H378</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, and twelve<sup>H8147</sup> H6240 of the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. 16 And they caught<sup>H2388</sup> every one<sup>H376</sup> his fellow<sup>H7453</sup> by the head<sup>H7218</sup>, and thrust his sword<sup>H2719</sup> in his fellow's<sup>H7453</sup> side<sup>H6654</sup>; so they fell down<sup>H5307</sup> together<sup>H3162</sup>: wherefore that place<sup>H4725</sup> was called<sup>H7121</sup> Helkathazzurim<sup>H2521</sup>, which is in Gibeon<sup>H1391</sup>.<sup>6</sup> 17 And there was a very<sup>H3966</sup> sore<sup>H7186</sup> battle<sup>H4421</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup>; and Abner<sup>H74</sup> was beaten<sup>H5062</sup>, and the men<sup>H582</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, before<sup>H6440</sup> the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>.

18 And there were three<sup>H7969</sup> sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Zeruiah<sup>H6870</sup> there, Joab<sup>H3097</sup>, and Abishai<sup>H52</sup>, and Asahel<sup>H6214</sup>: and Asahel<sup>H6214</sup> was as light<sup>H7031</sup> of foot<sup>H7272</sup> as a<sup>H259</sup> wild<sup>H7704</sup> roe<sup>H6643</sup>.<sup>78</sup> 19 And Asahel<sup>H6214</sup> pursued<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Abner<sup>H74</sup>; and in going<sup>H3212</sup> he turned<sup>H5186</sup> not to the right hand<sup>H3225</sup> nor to the left<sup>H8040</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> Abner<sup>H74</sup>.<sup>9</sup> 20 Then Abner<sup>H74</sup> looked<sup>H6437</sup> behind<sup>H310</sup> him, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Art thou Asahel<sup>H6214</sup>? And he answered<sup>H559</sup>, I am. 21 And Abner<sup>H74</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to him, Turn thee aside<sup>H5186</sup> to thy right hand<sup>H3225</sup> or to thy left<sup>H8040</sup>, and lay thee hold<sup>H270</sup> on one<sup>H259</sup> of the young men<sup>H5288</sup>, and take<sup>H3947</sup> thee his armour<sup>H2488</sup>. But Asahel<sup>H6214</sup> would<sup>H14</sup> not turn aside<sup>H5493</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> of him.<sup>10</sup> 22 And Abner<sup>H74</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> again<sup>H3254</sup> to Asahel<sup>H6214</sup>, Turn thee aside<sup>H5493</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> me: wherefore should I smite<sup>H5221</sup> thee to the ground<sup>H776</sup>? how then should I hold up<sup>H5375</sup> my face<sup>H6440</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup> thy brother<sup>H251</sup>? 23 Howbeit he refused<sup>H3985</sup> to turn aside<sup>H5493</sup>: wherefore Abner<sup>H74</sup> with the hinder end<sup>H310</sup> of the spear<sup>H2595</sup>

smote<sup>H5221</sup> him under<sup>H413</sup> the fifth<sup>H2570</sup> rib, that the spear<sup>H2595</sup> came out<sup>H3318</sup> behind<sup>H310</sup> him; and he fell down<sup>H5307</sup> there, and died<sup>H4191</sup> in the same place<sup>H8478</sup>: and it came to pass, that as many as came<sup>H935</sup> to the place<sup>H4725</sup> where Asahel<sup>H6214</sup> fell down<sup>H5307</sup> and died<sup>H4191</sup> stood still<sup>H5975</sup>. **24** Joab<sup>H3097</sup> also and Abishai<sup>H52</sup> pursued<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Abner<sup>H74</sup>: and the sun<sup>H8121</sup> went down<sup>H935</sup> when they were come<sup>H935</sup> to the hill<sup>H1389</sup> of Ammah<sup>H522</sup>, that lieth before<sup>H6440</sup> Giah<sup>H1520</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Gibeon<sup>H1391</sup>.

**25** And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup> gathered themselves together<sup>H6908</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Abner<sup>H74</sup>, and became one<sup>H259</sup> troop<sup>H92</sup>, and stood<sup>H5975</sup> on the top<sup>H7218</sup> of an hill<sup>H1389</sup>. **26** Then Abner<sup>H74</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Shall the sword<sup>H2719</sup> devour<sup>H398</sup> for ever<sup>H5331</sup>? knowest<sup>H3045</sup> thou not that it will be bitterness<sup>H4751</sup> in the latter end<sup>H314</sup>? how long shall it be then, ere thou bid<sup>H559</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> return<sup>H7725</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> their brethren<sup>H251</sup>? **27** And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, As God<sup>H430</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>, unless<sup>H3884</sup> thou hadst spoken<sup>H1696</sup>, surely then in the morning<sup>H1242</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> had gone up<sup>H5927</sup> every one<sup>H376</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> his brother<sup>H251</sup>. **28** So Joab<sup>H3097</sup> blew<sup>H8628</sup> a trumpet<sup>H7782</sup>, and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> stood still<sup>H5975</sup>, and pursued<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> no more, neither fought<sup>H3898</sup> they any more<sup>H3254</sup>. **29** And Abner<sup>H74</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> walked<sup>H1980</sup> all that night<sup>H3915</sup> through the plain<sup>H6160</sup>, and passed over<sup>H5674</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup>, and went through<sup>H3212</sup> all Bithron<sup>H1338</sup>, and they came<sup>H935</sup> to Mahanaim<sup>H4266</sup>. **30** And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> returned<sup>H7725</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> Abner<sup>H74</sup>: and when he had gathered<sup>H6908</sup> all the people<sup>H5971</sup> together<sup>H6908</sup>, there lacked<sup>H6485</sup> of David's<sup>H1732</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup> nineteen<sup>H8672</sup> men<sup>H6240</sup> and Asahel<sup>H6214</sup>. **31** But the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> had smitten<sup>H5221</sup> of Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup>, and of Abner's<sup>H74</sup> men<sup>H582</sup>, so that three<sup>H7969</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> and threescore<sup>H8346</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup>. **32** And they took up<sup>H5375</sup> Asahel<sup>H6214</sup>, and buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in the sepulchre<sup>H6913</sup> of his father<sup>H1</sup>, which was in Bethlehem<sup>H1035</sup>. And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> all night<sup>H3915</sup>, and they came to Hebron<sup>H2275</sup> at break of day<sup>H215</sup>.
