

## 2. Samuel 22

1 And David<sup>H1732</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this song<sup>H7892</sup> in the day<sup>H3117</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had delivered<sup>H5337</sup> him out of the hand<sup>H3709</sup> of all his enemies<sup>H341</sup>, and out of the hand<sup>H3709</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>.

2 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is my rock<sup>H5553</sup>, and my fortress<sup>H4686</sup>, and my deliverer<sup>H6403</sup>; 3 The God<sup>H430</sup> of my rock<sup>H6697</sup>; in him will I trust<sup>H2620</sup>: he is my shield<sup>H4043</sup>, and the horn<sup>H7161</sup> of my salvation<sup>H3468</sup>, my high tower<sup>H4869</sup>, and my refuge<sup>H4498</sup>, my saviour<sup>H3467</sup>; thou savest<sup>H3467</sup> me from violence<sup>H2555</sup>. 4 I will call<sup>H7121</sup> on the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, who is worthy to be praised<sup>H1984</sup>: so shall I be saved<sup>H3467</sup> from mine enemies<sup>H341</sup>. 5 When the waves<sup>H4867</sup> of death<sup>H4194</sup> compassed<sup>H661</sup> me, the floods<sup>H5158</sup> of ungodly men<sup>H1100</sup> made me afraid<sup>H1204,12</sup>; 6 The sorrows<sup>H2256</sup> of hell<sup>H7585</sup> compassed me about<sup>H5437</sup>; the snares<sup>H4170</sup> of death<sup>H4194</sup> prevented<sup>H6923</sup> me; 7 In my distress<sup>H7121</sup> I called<sup>H7121</sup> upon the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and cried<sup>H7121</sup> to my God<sup>H430</sup>: and he did hear<sup>H8085</sup> my voice<sup>H6963</sup> out of his temple<sup>H1964</sup>, and my cry<sup>H7775</sup> did enter into his ears<sup>H241</sup>. 8 Then the earth<sup>H776</sup> shook<sup>H1607 H1607</sup> and trembled<sup>H7493</sup>; the foundations<sup>H4146</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup> moved<sup>H7264</sup> and shook<sup>H1607</sup>, because he was wroth<sup>H2734</sup>. 9 There went up<sup>H5927</sup> a smoke<sup>H6227</sup> out of his nostrils<sup>H639</sup>, and fire<sup>H784</sup> out of his mouth<sup>H6310</sup> devoured<sup>H398</sup>: coals<sup>H1513</sup> were kindled<sup>H1197</sup> by it. 10 He bowed<sup>H7392</sup> the heavens<sup>H5186</sup> also, and came down<sup>H3381</sup>; and darkness<sup>H6205</sup> was under his feet<sup>H7272</sup>. 11 And he rode<sup>H7392</sup> upon a cherub<sup>H3742</sup>, and did fly<sup>H5774</sup>: and he was seen<sup>H7200</sup> upon the wings<sup>H3671</sup> of the wind<sup>H7307</sup>. 12 And he made<sup>H7896</sup> darkness<sup>H2822</sup> pavilions<sup>H5521</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> him, dark<sup>H2841</sup> waters<sup>H4325</sup>, and thick clouds<sup>H5645</sup> of the skies<sup>H7834</sup>. 13 Through the brightness<sup>H5051</sup> before him were coals<sup>H1513</sup> of fire<sup>H784</sup> kindled<sup>H1197</sup>. 14 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thundered<sup>H7481</sup> from heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, and the most High<sup>H5945</sup> uttered<sup>H5414</sup> his voice<sup>H6963</sup>. 15 And he sent out<sup>H7971</sup> arrows<sup>H2671</sup>, and scattered<sup>H6327</sup> them; lightning<sup>H1300</sup>, and discomfited<sup>H2000</sup> them. 16 And the channels<sup>H650</sup> of the sea<sup>H3220</sup> appeared<sup>H7200</sup>, the foundations<sup>H4146</sup> of the world<sup>H8398</sup> were discovered<sup>H1540</sup>, at the rebuking<sup>H1606</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, at the blast<sup>H5397</sup> of the breath<sup>H7307</sup> of his nostrils<sup>H639</sup>. 17 He sent<sup>H7971</sup> from above<sup>H4791</sup>, he took<sup>H3947</sup> me; he drew<sup>H4871</sup> me out of many<sup>H7227</sup> waters<sup>H4325,6</sup>. 18 He delivered<sup>H5337</sup> me from my strong<sup>H5794</sup> enemy<sup>H341</sup>, and from them that hated<sup>H8130</sup> me: for they were too strong<sup>H553</sup> for me. 19 They prevented<sup>H6923</sup> me in the day<sup>H3117</sup> of my calamity<sup>H343</sup>: but the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was my stay<sup>H4937</sup>. 20 He brought me forth<sup>H3318</sup> also into a large place<sup>H4800</sup>: he delivered<sup>H2502</sup> me, because he delighted<sup>H2654</sup> in me. 21 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> rewarded<sup>H1580</sup> me according to my righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>: according to the cleanness<sup>H1252</sup> of my hands<sup>H3027</sup> hath he recompensed<sup>H7725</sup> me. 22 For I have kept<sup>H8104</sup> the ways<sup>H1870</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and have not wickedly departed<sup>H7561</sup> from my God<sup>H430</sup>. 23 For all his judgments<sup>H4941</sup> were before me: and as for his statutes<sup>H2708</sup>, I did not depart<sup>H5493</sup> from them. 24 I was also upright<sup>H8549</sup> before him, and have kept<sup>H8104</sup> myself from mine iniquity<sup>H5771</sup>. 25 Therefore the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath recompensed<sup>H7725</sup> me according to my righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>; according to my cleanness<sup>H1252</sup> in his eye sight<sup>H5048 H5869</sup>. 26 With the merciful<sup>H2623</sup> thou wilt shew thyself merciful<sup>H2616</sup>, and with the upright<sup>H8549</sup> man<sup>H1368</sup> thou wilt shew thyself upright<sup>H8552</sup>. 27 With the pure<sup>H1305</sup> thou wilt shew thyself pure<sup>H1305</sup>; and with the froward<sup>H6141</sup> thou wilt shew thyself unsavoury<sup>H6617</sup>. 28 And the afflicted<sup>H6041</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup> thou wilt save<sup>H3467</sup>: but thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> are upon the haughty<sup>H7311</sup>, that thou mayest bring them down<sup>H8213</sup>. 29 For thou art my lamp<sup>H5216</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will lighten<sup>H5050</sup> my darkness<sup>H2822</sup>. 30 For by thee I have run<sup>H7323</sup> through a troop<sup>H1416</sup>: by my God<sup>H430</sup> have I leaped over<sup>H1801</sup> a wall<sup>H7791</sup>. 31 As for God<sup>H410</sup>, his way<sup>H1870</sup> is perfect<sup>H8549</sup>; the word<sup>H565</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is tried<sup>H6884</sup>: he is a buckler<sup>H4043</sup> to all them that trust<sup>H2620</sup> in him. 32 For who is God<sup>H410</sup>, save<sup>H1107</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>? and who is a rock<sup>H6697</sup>, save<sup>H1107</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>? 33 God<sup>H410</sup> is my strength<sup>H4581</sup> and power<sup>H2428</sup>: and he maketh<sup>H5425</sup> my way<sup>H1870</sup> perfect<sup>H8549</sup>. 34 He maketh<sup>H7737</sup> my feet<sup>H7272</sup> like<sup>H7737</sup> hinds<sup>H355</sup> feet: and setteth<sup>H5975</sup> me upon my high places<sup>H1116</sup>. 35 He teacheth<sup>H3925</sup> my hands<sup>H3027</sup> to war<sup>H4421</sup>; so that a bow<sup>H7198</sup> of steel<sup>H5154</sup> is broken<sup>H5181</sup> by mine arms<sup>H2220</sup>. 36 Thou hast also given<sup>H5414</sup> me the shield<sup>H4043</sup> of thy salvation<sup>H3468</sup>: and thy gentleness<sup>H6031 H6038</sup> hath made me great<sup>H7235</sup>. 37 Thou hast enlarged<sup>H7337</sup> my steps<sup>H6806</sup> under me; so that my feet<sup>H7166</sup> did not slip<sup>H4571</sup>. 38 I have pursued<sup>H7291</sup> mine enemies<sup>H341</sup>, and destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> them; and turned not again<sup>H7725</sup> until I had consumed<sup>H3615</sup> them. 39 And I have

consumed<sup>H3615</sup> them, and wounded<sup>H4272</sup> them, that they could not arise<sup>H6965</sup>: yea, they are fallen<sup>H5307</sup> under my feet<sup>H7272</sup>. **40** For thou hast girded<sup>H247</sup> me with strength<sup>H2428</sup> to battle<sup>H4421</sup>: them that rose up<sup>H6965</sup> against me hast thou subdued<sup>H3766</sup> under me.<sup>18</sup> **41** Thou hast also given<sup>H5414</sup> me the necks<sup>H6203</sup> of mine enemies<sup>H341</sup>, that I might destroy<sup>H6789</sup> them that hate<sup>H8130</sup> me. **42** They looked<sup>H8159</sup>, but there was none to save<sup>H3467</sup>; even unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, but he answered<sup>H6030</sup> them not. **43** Then did I beat<sup>H7833</sup> them as small as the dust<sup>H6083</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>, I did stamp<sup>H1854</sup> them as the mire<sup>H2916</sup> of the street<sup>H2351</sup>, and did spread them abroad<sup>H7554</sup>. **44** Thou also hast delivered<sup>H6403</sup> me from the strivings<sup>H7379</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup>, thou hast kept<sup>H8104</sup> me to be head<sup>H7218</sup> of the heathen<sup>H1471</sup>: a people<sup>H5971</sup> which I knew<sup>H3045</sup> not shall serve<sup>H5647</sup> me. **45** Strangers<sup>H1121 H5236</sup> shall submit<sup>H3584</sup> themselves unto me: as soon as they hear<sup>H8085 H241</sup>, they shall be obedient<sup>H8085</sup> unto me.<sup>1920</sup> **46** Strangers<sup>H1121 H5236</sup> shall fade away<sup>H5034</sup>, and they shall be afraid<sup>H2296</sup> out of their close places<sup>H4526</sup>. **47** The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>; and blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be my rock<sup>H6697</sup>; and exalted<sup>H7311</sup> be the God<sup>H430</sup> of the rock<sup>H6697</sup> of my salvation<sup>H3468</sup>. **48** It is God<sup>H410</sup> that avengeth<sup>H5414 H5360</sup> me, and that bringeth down<sup>H3381</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> under me,<sup>21</sup> **49** And that bringeth me forth<sup>H3318</sup> from mine enemies<sup>H341</sup>: thou also hast lifted me up on high<sup>H7311</sup> above them that rose up<sup>H6965</sup> against me: thou hast delivered<sup>H5337</sup> me from the violent<sup>H2555</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>. **50** Therefore I will give thanks<sup>H3034</sup> unto thee, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, among the heathen<sup>H1471</sup>, and I will sing praises<sup>H2167</sup> unto thy name<sup>H8034</sup>. **51** He is the tower<sup>H4024 H1431</sup> of salvation<sup>H3444</sup> for his king<sup>H4428</sup>: and sheweth<sup>H6213</sup> mercy<sup>H2617</sup> to his anointed<sup>H4899</sup>, unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, and to his seed<sup>H2233</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> evermore<sup>H5769</sup>.
