

## 2. Samuel 24

1 And again<sup>H3254</sup> the anger<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and he moved<sup>H5496</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> against them to say<sup>H559</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, number<sup>H4487</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 2 For the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup> the captain<sup>H8269</sup> of the host<sup>H2428</sup>, which was with him, Go now through<sup>H7751</sup> all the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, from Dan<sup>H1835</sup> even to Beersheba<sup>H884</sup>, and number<sup>H6485</sup> ye the people<sup>H5971</sup>, that I may know<sup>H3045</sup> the number<sup>H4557</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>. 3 And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>, Now the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> add<sup>H3254</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup>, how many soever<sup>H1992</sup> they be, an hundredfold<sup>H3967 H6471</sup>, and that the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of my lord<sup>H1113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> may see<sup>H7200</sup> it: but why doth my lord<sup>H1113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> delight<sup>H2654</sup> in this thing<sup>H1697</sup>? 4 Notwithstanding the king's<sup>H4428</sup> word<sup>H1697</sup> prevailed<sup>H2388</sup> against Joab<sup>H3097</sup>, and against the captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the host<sup>H2428</sup>. And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> and the captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the host<sup>H2428</sup> went out<sup>H3318</sup> from the presence<sup>H6440</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup>, to number<sup>H6485</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 5 And they passed over<sup>H5674</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup>, and pitched<sup>H2583</sup> in Aroer<sup>H6177</sup>, on the right side<sup>H3225</sup> of the city<sup>H5892</sup> that lieth in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of the river<sup>H5158</sup> of Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, and toward Jazer<sup>H3270</sup>. 6 Then they came<sup>H935</sup> to Gilead<sup>H1568</sup>, and to the land<sup>H776</sup> of Tahtimhodshi<sup>H8483</sup>; and they came<sup>H935</sup> to Danjaan<sup>H1842</sup>, and about<sup>H5439</sup> to Zidon<sup>H6721</sup>. 7 And came<sup>H935</sup> to the strong hold<sup>H4013</sup> of Tyre<sup>H6865</sup>, and to all the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of the Hivites<sup>H2340</sup>, and of the Canaanites<sup>H3669</sup>: and they went out<sup>H3318</sup> to the south<sup>H5045</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, even to Beersheba<sup>H884</sup>. 8 So when they had gone<sup>H7751</sup> through all the land<sup>H776</sup>, they came<sup>H935</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> at the end<sup>H7097</sup> of nine<sup>H8672</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup> and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>. 9 And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> gave up<sup>H5414</sup> the sum<sup>H4557</sup> of the number<sup>H4662</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>: and there were in Israel<sup>H3478</sup> eight<sup>H8083</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> valiant<sup>H2428</sup> men<sup>H376 H381</sup> that drew<sup>H8025</sup> the sword<sup>H2719</sup>; and the men<sup>H376</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> were five<sup>H2568</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>.

10 And David's<sup>H1732</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> him after<sup>H310</sup> that he had numbered<sup>H5608</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>. And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, I have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> greatly<sup>H3966</sup> in that I have done<sup>H6213</sup>: and now, I beseech thee, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, take away<sup>H5674</sup> the iniquity<sup>H5771</sup> of thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>, for I have done very<sup>H3966</sup> foolishly<sup>H5528</sup>. 11 For when David<sup>H1732</sup> was up<sup>H6965</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came unto the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, David's<sup>H1732</sup> seer<sup>H2374</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 12 Go<sup>H1980</sup> and say<sup>H559</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H1696</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, I offer<sup>H5190</sup> thee three<sup>H7969</sup> things; choose<sup>H977</sup> thee one<sup>H259</sup> of them, that I may do it unto thee<sup>H6213</sup>. 13 So Gad<sup>H1410</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and told<sup>H5046</sup> him, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Shall seven<sup>H7651</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> of famine<sup>H7458</sup> come<sup>H935</sup> unto thee in thy land<sup>H776</sup>? or wilt thou flee<sup>H5127</sup> three<sup>H7969</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thine enemies<sup>H6862</sup>, while they pursue<sup>H7291</sup> thee? or that there be three<sup>H7969</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> pestilence<sup>H1698</sup> in thy land<sup>H776</sup>? now advise<sup>H3045</sup>, and see<sup>H7200</sup> what answer<sup>H1697</sup> I shall return<sup>H7725</sup> to him that sent<sup>H7971</sup> me. 14 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, I am in a great<sup>H3966</sup> strait<sup>H6887</sup>: let us fall<sup>H5307</sup> now into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, for his mercies<sup>H7356</sup> are great<sup>H7227</sup>: and let me not fall<sup>H5307</sup> into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>. 15 So the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H5414</sup> a pestilence<sup>H1698</sup> upon Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from the morning<sup>H1242</sup> even to the time<sup>H6256</sup> appointed<sup>H4150</sup>: and there died<sup>H4191</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> from Dan<sup>H1835</sup> even to Beersheba<sup>H884</sup> seventy<sup>H7657</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>. 16 And when the angel<sup>H4397</sup> stretched out<sup>H7971</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> upon Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> to destroy<sup>H7843</sup> it, the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> him of the evil<sup>H7451</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> to the angel<sup>H4397</sup> that destroyed<sup>H7843</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, It is enough<sup>H7227</sup>: stay<sup>H7503</sup> now thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. And the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was by the threshingplace<sup>H1637</sup> of Araunah<sup>H728</sup> the Jebusite<sup>H2983</sup>. 17 And David<sup>H1732</sup> spake<sup>H559</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> when he saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup> that smote<sup>H5221</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Lo, I have sinned<sup>H2398</sup>, and I have done wickedly<sup>H5753</sup>: but these sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, what have they done<sup>H6213</sup>? let thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, I pray thee, be against me, and against my father's<sup>H1</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>.

18 And Gad<sup>H1410</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Go up<sup>H5927</sup>, rear<sup>H6965</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup> of Araunah<sup>H728</sup> the Jebusite<sup>H2983</sup>. 19 And David<sup>H1732</sup>, according to the saying<sup>H1697</sup> of Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, went up<sup>H5927</sup> as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup>. 20 And Araunah<sup>H728</sup> looked<sup>H8259</sup>, and

saw<sup>H7200</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> and his servants<sup>H5650</sup> coming on<sup>H5674</sup> toward him: and Araunah<sup>H728</sup> went out<sup>H3318</sup>, and bowed<sup>H7812</sup> himself before the king<sup>H4428</sup> on his face<sup>H639</sup> upon the ground<sup>H776</sup>. **21** And Araunah<sup>H728</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Wherefore is my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> come<sup>H935</sup> to his servant<sup>H5650</sup>? And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, To buy<sup>H7069</sup> the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup> of thee, to build<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that the plague<sup>H4046</sup> may be stayed<sup>H6113</sup> from the people<sup>H5971</sup>. **22** And Araunah<sup>H728</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, Let my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> take<sup>H3947</sup> and offer up<sup>H5927</sup> what seemeth good<sup>H2896</sup> unto him<sup>H5869</sup>: behold<sup>H7200</sup>, here be oxen<sup>H1241</sup> for burnt sacrifice<sup>H5930</sup>, and threshing instruments<sup>H4173</sup> and other instruments<sup>H3627</sup> of the oxen<sup>H1241</sup> for wood<sup>H6086</sup>. **23** All these things did Araunah<sup>H728</sup>, as a king<sup>H4428</sup>, give<sup>H5414</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>. And Araunah<sup>H728</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> accept<sup>H7521</sup> thee. **24** And the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Araunah<sup>H728</sup>, Nay; but I will surely<sup>H7069</sup> buy<sup>H7069</sup> it of thee at a price<sup>H4242</sup>: neither will I offer<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> my God<sup>H430</sup> of that which doth cost me nothing<sup>H2600</sup>. So David<sup>H1732</sup> bought<sup>H7069</sup> the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup> and the oxen<sup>H1241</sup> for fifty<sup>H2572</sup> shekels<sup>H8255</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup>. **25** And David<sup>H1732</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> there an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and offered<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> and peace offerings<sup>H8002</sup>. So the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was intreated<sup>H6279</sup> for the land<sup>H776</sup>, and the plague<sup>H4046</sup> was stayed<sup>H6113</sup> from Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.
