

# Acts 24

1 And<sup>G1161</sup> after<sup>G3326</sup> five<sup>G4002</sup> days<sup>G2250</sup> Ananias<sup>G367</sup> the high priest<sup>G749</sup> descended<sup>G2597</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> the elders<sup>G4245</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> with a certain<sup>G5100</sup> orator<sup>G4489</sup> named Tertullus<sup>G5061</sup>, who<sup>G3748</sup> informed<sup>G1718</sup> the governor<sup>G2232</sup> against<sup>G2596</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>. 2 And<sup>G1161</sup> when he<sup>G846</sup> was called forth<sup>G2564</sup>, Tertullus<sup>G5061</sup> began<sup>G756</sup> to accuse<sup>G2723</sup> him, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, Seeing that by<sup>G1223</sup> thee<sup>G4675</sup> we enjoy<sup>G5177</sup> great<sup>G4183</sup> quietness<sup>G1515</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> that very worthy deeds<sup>G2735</sup> are done<sup>G1096</sup> unto this<sup>G5129</sup> nation<sup>G1484</sup> by<sup>G1223</sup> thy<sup>G4674</sup> providence<sup>G4307</sup>, 3 We accept<sup>G588</sup> it always<sup>G3839</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> in all places<sup>G3837</sup>, most noble<sup>G2903</sup> Felix<sup>G5344</sup>, with<sup>G3326</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> thankfulness<sup>G2169</sup>. 4 Notwithstanding<sup>G1161</sup>, that<sup>G3363</sup> I be<sup>G4119</sup> not<sup>G3363</sup> further<sup>G4119</sup> tedious<sup>G1465</sup> unto thee<sup>G4571</sup>, I pray<sup>G3870</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup> that thou wouldest hear<sup>G191</sup> us<sup>G2257</sup> of thy<sup>G4674</sup> clemency<sup>G1932</sup> a few words<sup>G4935</sup>. 5 For<sup>G1063</sup> we have found<sup>G2147</sup> this<sup>G5126</sup> man<sup>G435</sup> a pestilent<sup>G3061</sup> fellow, and<sup>G2532</sup> a mover<sup>G2795</sup> of sedition<sup>G4714</sup> among all<sup>G3956</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup> throughout<sup>G2596</sup> the world<sup>G3625</sup>, and<sup>G5037</sup> a ringleader<sup>G4414</sup> of the sect<sup>G139</sup> of the Nazarenes<sup>G3480</sup>. 6 Who<sup>G3739</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> hath gone about<sup>G3985</sup> to profane<sup>G953</sup> the temple<sup>G2411</sup> G2532, whom<sup>G3739</sup> we took<sup>G2902</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> would<sup>G2309</sup> have judged<sup>G2919</sup> according<sup>G2596</sup> to our<sup>G2251</sup> law<sup>G3551</sup>. 7 But<sup>G1161</sup> the chief captain<sup>G5506</sup> Lysias<sup>G3079</sup> came<sup>G3928</sup> upon us, and with<sup>G3326</sup> great<sup>G4183</sup> violence<sup>G970</sup> took him away<sup>G520</sup> out of<sup>G1537</sup> our<sup>G2257</sup> hands<sup>G5495</sup>, 8 Commanding<sup>G2753</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> accusers<sup>G2725</sup> to come<sup>G2064</sup> unto<sup>G1909</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup>: by examining<sup>G350</sup> of<sup>G3844</sup> whom<sup>G3739</sup> thyself<sup>G846</sup> mayest<sup>G1410</sup> take knowledge<sup>G1921</sup> of<sup>G4012</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> these things<sup>G5130</sup>, whereof<sup>G3739</sup> we<sup>G2249</sup> accuse<sup>G2723</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. 9 And<sup>G1161</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> assented<sup>G4934</sup>, saying<sup>G5335</sup> that these things<sup>G5023</sup> were<sup>G2192</sup> so<sup>G3779</sup>.

10 Then<sup>G1161</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>, after that the governor<sup>G2232</sup> had beckoned<sup>G3506</sup> unto him<sup>G846</sup> to speak<sup>G3004</sup>, answered<sup>G611</sup>, Forasmuch as I know<sup>G1987</sup> that thou<sup>G4571</sup> hast been<sup>G5607</sup> of<sup>G1537</sup> many<sup>G4183</sup> years<sup>G2094</sup> a judge<sup>G2923</sup> unto this nation<sup>G1484</sup>, I do<sup>G626</sup> the more cheerfully<sup>G2115</sup> answer<sup>G626</sup> for<sup>G4012</sup> myself<sup>G1683</sup>: 11 Because that thou<sup>G4675</sup> mayest<sup>G1410</sup> understand<sup>G1097</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> there are<sup>G1526</sup> yet but<sup>G2228</sup> G3756 twelve<sup>G1177</sup> days<sup>G2250</sup> G4119 since<sup>G575</sup> G3739 I<sup>G3427</sup> went up<sup>G305</sup> to<sup>G1722</sup> Jerusalem<sup>G2419</sup> for to worship<sup>G4352</sup>. 12 And<sup>G2532</sup> they neither<sup>G3777</sup> found<sup>G2147</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the temple<sup>G2411</sup> disputing<sup>G1256</sup> with<sup>G4314</sup> any man<sup>G5100</sup>, neither<sup>G2228</sup> raising up<sup>G1999</sup> G4160 the people<sup>G3793</sup> G1999, neither<sup>G3777</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the synagogues<sup>G4864</sup>, nor<sup>G3777</sup> in<sup>G2596</sup> the city<sup>G4172</sup>: 13 Neither<sup>G3777</sup> can<sup>G1410</sup> they prove<sup>G3936</sup> G3165 the things<sup>G4012</sup> whereof<sup>G3739</sup> they<sup>G2723</sup> now<sup>G3568</sup> accuse<sup>G2723</sup> me<sup>G3450</sup>. 14 But<sup>G1161</sup> this<sup>G5124</sup> I confess<sup>G3670</sup> unto thee<sup>G4671</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> after<sup>G2596</sup> the way<sup>G3598</sup> which<sup>G3739</sup> they call<sup>G3004</sup> heresy<sup>G139</sup>, so<sup>G3779</sup> worship I<sup>G3000</sup> the God<sup>G2316</sup> of my fathers<sup>G3971</sup>, believing<sup>G4100</sup> all things<sup>G3956</sup> which<sup>G3588</sup> are written<sup>G1125</sup> in<sup>G2596</sup> the law<sup>G3551</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the prophets<sup>G4396</sup>: 15 And have<sup>G2192</sup> hope<sup>G1680</sup> toward<sup>G1519</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, which<sup>G3739</sup> they<sup>G3778</sup> themselves<sup>G846</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> allow<sup>G4327</sup>, that there shall be<sup>G3195</sup> G1510 a resurrection<sup>G386</sup> of the dead<sup>G3498</sup>, both<sup>G5037</sup> of the just<sup>G1342</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> unjust<sup>G94</sup>. 16 And<sup>G1161</sup> herein<sup>G1722</sup> do I exercise<sup>G778</sup> myself<sup>G846</sup>, to have<sup>G2192</sup> always<sup>G1275</sup> a conscience<sup>G4893</sup> void of offence<sup>G677</sup> toward<sup>G4314</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> toward men<sup>G444</sup>. 17 Now<sup>G1161</sup> after<sup>G1223</sup> many<sup>G4119</sup> years<sup>G2094</sup> I came<sup>G3854</sup> to bring<sup>G4160</sup> alms<sup>G1654</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> my<sup>G3450</sup> nation<sup>G1484</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> offerings<sup>G4376</sup>. 18 Whereupon<sup>G1722</sup> G3739 certain<sup>G5100</sup> Jews<sup>G2453</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> Asia<sup>G773</sup> found<sup>G2147</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> purified<sup>G48</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the temple<sup>G2411</sup>, neither<sup>G3756</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> multitude<sup>G3793</sup>, nor<sup>G3761</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> tumult<sup>G2351</sup>. 19 Who<sup>G3739</sup> ought<sup>G1163</sup> to have been here<sup>G3918</sup> before<sup>G1909</sup> thee<sup>G4675</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> object<sup>G2723</sup>, if<sup>G1536</sup> they had<sup>G2192</sup> ought<sup>G1536</sup> against<sup>G4314</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>. 20 Or else<sup>G2228</sup> let<sup>G2036</sup> these<sup>G846</sup> same<sup>G3778</sup> here say<sup>G2036</sup>, if<sup>G1536</sup> they have found<sup>G2147</sup> any<sup>G1536</sup> evil doing<sup>G92</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> me<sup>G1698</sup>, while I<sup>G3450</sup> stood<sup>G2476</sup> before<sup>G1909</sup> the council<sup>G4892</sup>, 21 Except<sup>G2228</sup> it be for<sup>G4012</sup> this<sup>G5026</sup> one<sup>G3391</sup> voice<sup>G5456</sup>, that<sup>G3739</sup> I cried<sup>G2896</sup> standing<sup>G2476</sup> among<sup>G1722</sup> them<sup>G846</sup>, Touching<sup>G3754</sup> G4012 the resurrection<sup>G386</sup> of the dead<sup>G3498</sup> I<sup>G1473</sup> am called in question<sup>G2919</sup> by<sup>G5259</sup> you<sup>G5216</sup> this day<sup>G4594</sup>.

22 And<sup>G1161</sup> when Felix<sup>G5344</sup> heard<sup>G191</sup> these things<sup>G5023</sup>, having more perfect<sup>G197</sup> knowledge<sup>G1492</sup> of<sup>G4012</sup> that way<sup>G3598</sup>, he deferred<sup>G306</sup> them<sup>G846</sup>, and said<sup>G2036</sup>, When<sup>G3752</sup> Lysias<sup>G3079</sup> the chief captain<sup>G5506</sup> shall come down<sup>G2597</sup>, I will know the uttermost<sup>G1231</sup> of your<sup>G5209</sup> matter<sup>G2596</sup>. 23 And<sup>G5037</sup> he commanded<sup>G1299</sup> a centurion<sup>G1543</sup> to keep<sup>G5083</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>,

and<sup>G5037</sup> to let him have<sup>G2192</sup> liberty<sup>G425</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> that he should forbid<sup>G2967</sup> none<sup>G3367</sup> of his<sup>G846</sup> acquaintance<sup>G2398</sup> to minister<sup>G5256</sup> or<sup>G2228</sup> come<sup>G4334</sup> unto him<sup>G846</sup>. **24** And<sup>G1161</sup> after<sup>G3326</sup> certain<sup>G5100</sup> days<sup>G2250</sup>, when Felix<sup>G5344</sup> came<sup>G3854</sup> with<sup>G4862</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> wife<sup>G1135</sup> Drusilla<sup>G1409</sup>, which was<sup>G5607</sup> a Jewess<sup>G2453</sup>, he sent for<sup>G3343</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> heard<sup>G191</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> concerning<sup>G4012</sup> the faith<sup>G4102</sup> in<sup>G1519</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>. **25** And<sup>G1161</sup> as he<sup>G846</sup> reasoned<sup>G1256</sup> of<sup>G4012</sup> righteousness<sup>G1343</sup>, temperance<sup>G2532 G1466</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> judgment<sup>G2917</sup> to come<sup>G3195 G1510</sup>, Felix<sup>G5344</sup> trembled<sup>G1096 G1719</sup>, and answered<sup>G611</sup>, Go thy way<sup>G4198</sup> for this time<sup>G3568</sup>; when<sup>G1161</sup> I have<sup>G2192 G3335</sup> a convenient season<sup>G2540</sup>, I will call for<sup>G3333</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup>. **26** He hoped<sup>G1679</sup> also<sup>G260 G1161 G2532</sup> that<sup>G3754</sup> money<sup>G5536</sup> should have been given<sup>G1325</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> of<sup>G5259</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>, that<sup>G3704</sup> he might loose<sup>G3089</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>: wherefore<sup>G1352</sup> he sent for<sup>G3343</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> the oftener<sup>G4437</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> communed with<sup>G3656</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. **27** But<sup>G1161</sup> after<sup>G4137</sup> two years<sup>G1333</sup> Porcius<sup>G4201</sup> Festus<sup>G5347</sup> came<sup>G2983</sup> into Felix<sup>G5344</sup> room<sup>G1240</sup>: and<sup>G5037</sup> Felix<sup>G5344</sup>, willing<sup>G2309</sup> to shew<sup>G2698</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup> a pleasure<sup>G5485</sup>, left<sup>G2641</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup> bound<sup>G1210</sup>.
