## Amos 7

1 Thus hath the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup> shewed<sup>H7200</sup> unto me; and, behold, he formed<sup>H3335</sup> grasshoppers<sup>H1462</sup> in the beginning<sup>H8462</sup> of the shooting up<sup>H5927</sup> of the latter growth<sup>H3954</sup>; and, lo, it was the latter growth<sup>H3954</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the king's<sup>H4428</sup> mowings<sup>H1488</sup>.¹ 2 And it came to pass, that when they had made an end<sup>H3615</sup> of eating<sup>H398</sup> the grass<sup>H6212</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, then I said<sup>H559</sup>, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, forgive<sup>H5545</sup>, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> arise<sup>H6965</sup>? for he is small<sup>H6996</sup>.² 3 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> for this: It shall not be, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 4 Thus hath the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup> shewed<sup>H7200</sup> unto me: and, behold, the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> to contend<sup>H7378</sup> by fire<sup>H784</sup>, and it devoured<sup>H398</sup> the great<sup>H7227</sup> deep<sup>H8415</sup>, and did eat up<sup>H398</sup> a part<sup>H2506</sup>. 5 Then said<sup>H559</sup> I, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, cease<sup>H2308</sup>, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> arise<sup>H6965</sup>? for he is small<sup>H6996</sup>.³ 6 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> for this: This also shall not be, saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>. 7 Thus he shewed<sup>H7200</sup> me: and, behold, the Lord<sup>H136</sup> stood<sup>H5324</sup> upon a wall<sup>H2346</sup> made by a plumbline<sup>H594</sup>, with a plumbline<sup>H594</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 8 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Amos<sup>H5986</sup>, what seest<sup>H7200</sup> thou? And I said<sup>H559</sup>, A plumbline<sup>H594</sup>. Then said<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup>, Behold, I will set<sup>H7760</sup> a plumbline<sup>H594</sup> in the midst<sup>H7130</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: I will not again<sup>H3254</sup> pass by<sup>H5674</sup> them any more: 9 And the high places<sup>H1116</sup> of Isaac<sup>H3446</sup> shall be desolate<sup>H8074</sup>, and the sanctuaries<sup>H4720</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> shall be laid waste<sup>H2717</sup>; and I will rise<sup>H6965</sup> against the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> with the sword<sup>H2719</sup>.

10 Then Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> of Bethel<sup>H1008</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> to Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Amos<sup>H5986</sup> hath conspired<sup>H7194</sup> against thee in the midst<sup>H7130</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: the land<sup>H776</sup> is not able<sup>H3201</sup> to bear<sup>H3557</sup> all his words<sup>H1697</sup>. 11 For thus Amos<sup>H5986</sup> saith<sup>H559</sup>, Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> shall die<sup>H4191</sup> by the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and Israel<sup>H3478</sup> shall surely<sup>H1540</sup> be led away captive<sup>H1540</sup> out of their own land<sup>H127</sup>. 12 Also Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Amos<sup>H5986</sup>, O thou seer<sup>H2374</sup>, go<sup>H3212</sup>, flee thee away<sup>H1272</sup> into the land<sup>H776</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and there eat<sup>H398</sup> bread<sup>H3899</sup>, and prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> there: 13 But prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> not again<sup>H3254</sup> any more at Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>: for it is the king's<sup>H4428</sup> chapel<sup>H4720</sup>, and it is the king's<sup>H4467</sup> court<sup>H1004</sup>. <sup>45</sup> 14 Then answered<sup>H6030</sup> Amos<sup>H5986</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> to Amaziah<sup>H558</sup>, I was no prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, neither was I a prophet's<sup>H5030</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup>; but I was an herdman<sup>H951</sup>, and a gatherer<sup>H1103</sup> of sycomore fruit<sup>H8256</sup>.6 15 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> me as I followed<sup>H310</sup> the flock<sup>H6629</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> unto my people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.7 16 Now therefore hear<sup>H8085</sup> thou the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: Thou sayest<sup>H559</sup>, Prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> not against Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and drop<sup>H5197</sup> not thy word against the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Isaac<sup>H3446</sup>. 17 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; Thy wife<sup>H802</sup> shall be an harlot<sup>H2181</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and thy sons<sup>H1121</sup> and thy daughters<sup>H1323</sup> shall fall<sup>H5307</sup> by the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and thy land<sup>H127</sup> shall be divided<sup>H2505</sup> by line<sup>H2256</sup>; and thou shall die<sup>H4191</sup> in<sup>H5921</sup> a polluted<sup>H2931</sup> land<sup>H127</sup>: and Israel<sup>H3478</sup> shall surely<sup>H1540</sup> go into captivity<sup>H1540</sup> forth of his land<sup>H127</sup>.
