

# Daniel 2

1 And in the second<sup>H8147</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of the reign<sup>H4438</sup> of Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5019</sup> dreamed<sup>H2492</sup> dreams<sup>H2472</sup>, wherewith his spirit<sup>H7307</sup> was troubled<sup>H6470</sup>, and his sleep<sup>H8142</sup> brake<sup>H1961</sup> from him. 2 Then the king<sup>H4428</sup> commanded<sup>H559</sup> to call<sup>H7121</sup> the magicians<sup>H2748</sup>, and the astrologers<sup>H825</sup>, and the sorcerers<sup>H3784</sup>, and the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup>, for to shew<sup>H5046</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> his dreams<sup>H2472</sup>. So they came<sup>H935</sup> and stood<sup>H5975</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>. 3 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, I have dreamed<sup>H2492</sup> a dream<sup>H2472</sup>, and my spirit<sup>H7307</sup> was troubled<sup>H6470</sup> to know<sup>H3045</sup> the dream<sup>H2472</sup>. 4 Then spake<sup>H1696</sup> the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> in Syriack<sup>H762</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, live<sup>H2418</sup> for ever<sup>H5957</sup>: tell<sup>H560</sup> thy servants<sup>H5649</sup> the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, and we will shew<sup>H2324</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup>. 5 The king<sup>H4430</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> to the Chaldeans<sup>H3779</sup>, The thing<sup>H4406</sup> is gone<sup>H230</sup> from me<sup>H4481</sup>: if<sup>H2006</sup> ye will not<sup>H3809</sup> make known<sup>H3046</sup> unto me the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, with the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof, ye shall be cut<sup>H5648</sup> in pieces<sup>H1917</sup>, and your houses<sup>H1005</sup> shall be made<sup>H7761</sup> a dunghill<sup>H5122</sup>. 6 But if<sup>H2006</sup> ye shew<sup>H2324</sup> the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, and the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof, ye shall receive<sup>H6902</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> me<sup>H6925</sup> gifts<sup>H4978</sup> and rewards<sup>H5023</sup> and great<sup>H7690</sup> honour<sup>H3367</sup>: therefore<sup>H3861</sup> shew<sup>H2324</sup> me the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, and the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof. 7 They answered<sup>H6032</sup> again<sup>H8579</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup>, Let the king<sup>H4430</sup> tell<sup>H560</sup> his servants<sup>H5649</sup> the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, and we will shew<sup>H2324</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> of it. 8 The king<sup>H4430</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup>, I<sup>H576</sup> know<sup>H3046</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> certainty<sup>H3330</sup> that ye<sup>H608</sup> would gain<sup>H2084</sup> the time<sup>H5732</sup>, because<sup>H6903</sup> ye see<sup>H2370</sup> the thing<sup>H4406</sup> is gone<sup>H230</sup> from<sup>H4481</sup> me. 9 But if<sup>H2006</sup> ye will not<sup>H3809</sup> make known<sup>H3046</sup> unto me the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, there is but one<sup>H1932</sup> decree<sup>H1882</sup> for you: for ye have prepared<sup>H2164</sup> lying<sup>H3538</sup> and corrupt<sup>H7844</sup> words<sup>H4406</sup> to speak<sup>H560</sup> before<sup>H6925</sup> me, till<sup>H5705</sup> the time<sup>H5732</sup> be changed<sup>H8133</sup>: therefore<sup>H3861</sup> tell<sup>H560</sup> me the dream<sup>H2493</sup>, and I shall know<sup>H3046</sup> that<sup>H1768</sup> ye can shew<sup>H2324</sup> me the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof. 10 The Chaldeans<sup>H3779</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> before<sup>H6925</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup>, There is<sup>H383</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> a man<sup>H606</sup> upon<sup>H5922</sup> the earth<sup>H3007</sup> that can<sup>H3202</sup> shew<sup>H2324</sup> the king's<sup>H4430</sup> matter<sup>H4406</sup>: therefore<sup>H6903</sup> there is no<sup>H3809</sup> king<sup>H4430</sup>, lord<sup>H7229</sup>, nor ruler<sup>H7990</sup>, that asked<sup>H7593</sup> such<sup>H1836</sup> things<sup>H4406</sup> at any<sup>H3606</sup> magician<sup>H2749</sup>, or astrologer<sup>H826</sup>, or Chaldean<sup>H3779</sup>. 11 And it is a rare<sup>H3358</sup> thing<sup>H4406</sup> that the king<sup>H4430</sup> requireth<sup>H7593</sup>, and there is<sup>H383</sup> none<sup>H3809</sup> other<sup>H321</sup> that can shew<sup>H2324</sup> it before<sup>H6925</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>, except<sup>H3861</sup> the gods<sup>H426</sup>, whose dwelling<sup>H4070</sup> is<sup>H383</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> with<sup>H5974</sup> flesh<sup>H1321</sup>. 12 For<sup>H6903</sup> this<sup>H1836</sup> cause<sup>H3606</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> was angry<sup>H1149</sup> and very<sup>H7690</sup> furious<sup>H7108</sup>, and commanded<sup>H560</sup> to destroy<sup>H7</sup> all<sup>H3606</sup> the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>. 13 And the decree<sup>H1882</sup> went forth<sup>H5312</sup> that the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men should be slain<sup>H6992</sup>, and they sought<sup>H1156</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> and his fellows<sup>H2269</sup> to be slain<sup>H6992</sup>.

14 Then<sup>H116</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> answered<sup>H8421</sup> with counsel<sup>H5843</sup> and wisdom<sup>H2942</sup> to Arioch<sup>H746</sup> the captain<sup>H7229</sup> of<sup>H1768</sup> the king's<sup>H4430</sup> guard<sup>H2877</sup>, which was gone forth<sup>H5312</sup> to slay<sup>H6992</sup> the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>. 15 He answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> to Arioch<sup>H746</sup> the king's<sup>H4430</sup> captain<sup>H7990</sup>, Why<sup>H4101</sup> is the decree<sup>H1882</sup> so hasty<sup>H2685</sup> from<sup>H4481</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>? Then<sup>H116</sup> Arioch<sup>H746</sup> made the thing<sup>H4406</sup> known<sup>H3046</sup> to Daniel<sup>H1841</sup>. 16 Then Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> went in<sup>H5954</sup>, and desired<sup>H1156</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> that he would give<sup>H5415</sup> him time<sup>H2166</sup>, and that he would shew<sup>H2324</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup>. 17 Then<sup>H116</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> went<sup>H236</sup> to his house<sup>H1005</sup>, and made the thing<sup>H4406</sup> known<sup>H3046</sup> to Hananiah<sup>H2608</sup>, Mishael<sup>H4333</sup>, and Azariah<sup>H5839</sup>, his companions<sup>H2269</sup>. 18 That they would desire<sup>H1156</sup> mercies<sup>H7359</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> the God<sup>H426</sup> of heaven<sup>H8065</sup> concerning<sup>H5922</sup> this<sup>H1836</sup> secret<sup>H7328</sup>; that Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> and his fellows<sup>H2269</sup> should not<sup>H3809</sup> perish<sup>H7</sup> with<sup>H5974</sup> the rest<sup>H7606</sup> of the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>. 19 Then<sup>H116</sup> was the secret<sup>H7328</sup> revealed<sup>H1541</sup> unto Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> in a night<sup>H3916</sup> vision<sup>H2376</sup>. Then<sup>H116</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> blessed<sup>H1289</sup> the God<sup>H426</sup> of heaven<sup>H8065</sup>. 20 Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup>, Blessed<sup>H1289</sup> be<sup>H1934</sup> the name<sup>H8036</sup> of God<sup>H426</sup> for<sup>H4481</sup> ever<sup>H5957</sup> and ever<sup>H5705</sup>: for wisdom<sup>H2452</sup> and might<sup>H1370</sup> are<sup>H1932</sup> his: 21 And he changeth<sup>H8133</sup> the times<sup>H5732</sup> and the seasons<sup>H2166</sup>: he removeth<sup>H5709</sup> kings<sup>H4430</sup>, and setteth up<sup>H6966</sup> kings<sup>H4430</sup>: he giveth<sup>H3052</sup> wisdom<sup>H2452</sup> unto the wise<sup>H2445</sup>, and knowledge<sup>H4486</sup> to them that know<sup>H3046</sup> understanding<sup>H999</sup>: 22 He revealeth<sup>H1541</sup> the deep<sup>H5994</sup> and secret things<sup>H5642</sup>: he knoweth<sup>H3046</sup> what<sup>H4101</sup> is in the darkness<sup>H2816</sup>, and the light<sup>H5094</sup> dwelleth<sup>H8271</sup> with him<sup>H5974</sup>. 23 I<sup>H576</sup>

thank<sup>H3029</sup> thee, and praise<sup>H7624</sup> thee, O thou God<sup>H426</sup> of my fathers<sup>H2</sup>, who hast given<sup>H3052</sup> me wisdom<sup>H2452</sup> and might<sup>H1370</sup>, and hast made known<sup>H3046</sup> unto me now<sup>H3705</sup> what we desired<sup>H1156</sup> of thee<sup>H4481</sup>: for thou hast now made known<sup>H3046</sup> unto us the king's<sup>H4430</sup> matter<sup>H4406</sup>.

**24** Therefore<sup>H3606 H6903 H1836</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> went in<sup>H5954</sup> unto<sup>H5922</sup> Arioch<sup>H746</sup>, whom the king<sup>H4430</sup> had ordained<sup>H4483</sup> to destroy<sup>H7</sup> the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>: he went<sup>H236</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> thus<sup>H3652</sup> unto him; Destroy<sup>H7</sup> not<sup>H409</sup> the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>: bring me in<sup>H5954</sup> before<sup>H6925</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>, and I will shew<sup>H2324</sup> unto the king<sup>H4430</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup>. **25** Then<sup>H116</sup> Arioch<sup>H746</sup> brought in<sup>H5954</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> before<sup>H6925</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> in haste<sup>H927</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup> thus<sup>H3652</sup> unto him, I have found<sup>H7912</sup> a man<sup>H1400</sup> of the captives<sup>H1123 H1547</sup> of Judah<sup>H3061</sup>, that will make known<sup>H3046</sup> unto the king<sup>H4430</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup>. **26** The king<sup>H4430</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> to Daniel<sup>H1841</sup>, whose name<sup>H8036</sup> was Belteshazzar<sup>H1096</sup>, Art<sup>H383</sup> thou able<sup>H3546</sup> to make known<sup>H3046</sup> unto me the dream<sup>H2493</sup> which I have seen<sup>H2370</sup>, and the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof? **27** Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> in the presence<sup>H6925</sup> of the king<sup>H4430</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup>, The secret<sup>H7328</sup> which the king<sup>H4430</sup> hath demanded<sup>H7593</sup> cannot<sup>H3202 H3809</sup> the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men, the astrologers<sup>H826</sup>, the magicians<sup>H2749</sup>, the soothsayers<sup>H1505</sup>, shew<sup>H2324</sup> unto the king<sup>H4430</sup>; **28** But<sup>H1297</sup> there is<sup>H383</sup> a God<sup>H426</sup> in heaven<sup>H8065</sup> that revealeth<sup>H1541</sup> secrets<sup>H7328</sup>, and maketh known<sup>H3046</sup> to the king<sup>H4430</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> what<sup>H4101</sup> shall be<sup>H1934</sup> in the latter<sup>H320</sup> days<sup>H3118</sup>. Thy dream<sup>H2493</sup>, and the visions<sup>H2376</sup> of thy head<sup>H7217</sup> upon<sup>H5922</sup> thy bed<sup>H4903</sup>, are these<sup>H1836,10</sup>; **29** As for thee<sup>H607</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, thy thoughts<sup>H7476</sup> came<sup>H5559</sup> into thy mind upon<sup>H5922</sup> thy bed<sup>H4903</sup>, what<sup>H4101</sup> should come to pass<sup>H1934</sup> hereafter<sup>H311</sup>: and he that revealeth<sup>H1541</sup> secrets<sup>H7328</sup> maketh known<sup>H3046</sup> to thee what<sup>H4101</sup> shall come to pass<sup>H1934</sup>. **30** But as for me<sup>H576</sup>, this<sup>H1836</sup> secret<sup>H7328</sup> is not<sup>H3809</sup> revealed<sup>H1541</sup> to me for any wisdom<sup>H2452</sup> that I have<sup>H383</sup> more than<sup>H4481</sup> any<sup>H3606</sup> living<sup>H2417</sup>, but<sup>H3861</sup> for their sakes<sup>H1701</sup> that<sup>H5922</sup> shall make known<sup>H3046</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> to the king<sup>H4430</sup>, and that thou mightest know<sup>H3046</sup> the thoughts<sup>H7476</sup> of thy heart<sup>H3825</sup>.

**31** Thou<sup>H607</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, sawest<sup>H1934 H2370</sup>, and behold<sup>H431</sup> a great<sup>H2298 H7690</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup>. This<sup>H1797</sup> great<sup>H7229</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup>, whose brightness<sup>H2122</sup> was excellent<sup>H3493</sup>, stood<sup>H6966</sup> before<sup>H6903</sup> thee; and the form<sup>H7299</sup> thereof was terrible<sup>H1763</sup>. **32** This image's<sup>H6755</sup> head<sup>H7217</sup> was of fine<sup>H2869</sup> gold<sup>H1722</sup>, his breast<sup>H2306</sup> and his arms<sup>H1872</sup> of silver<sup>H3702</sup>, his belly<sup>H4577</sup> and his thighs<sup>H3410</sup> of brass<sup>H5174</sup>, **33** His legs<sup>H8243</sup> of iron<sup>H6523</sup>, his feet<sup>H7271</sup> part<sup>H4481</sup> of iron<sup>H6523</sup> and part<sup>H4481</sup> of clay<sup>H2635</sup>. **34** Thou sawest<sup>H2370 H1934</sup> till<sup>H5705</sup> that a stone<sup>H69</sup> was cut out<sup>H1505</sup> without<sup>H3809</sup> hands<sup>H3028</sup>, which smote<sup>H4223</sup> the image<sup>H6755</sup> upon<sup>H5922</sup> his feet<sup>H7271</sup> that were of iron<sup>H6523</sup> and clay<sup>H2635</sup>, and brake<sup>H1855</sup> them<sup>H1994</sup> to pieces<sup>H1855</sup>. **35** Then<sup>H116</sup> was the iron<sup>H6523</sup>, the clay<sup>H2635</sup>, the brass<sup>H5174</sup>, the silver<sup>H3702</sup>, and the gold<sup>H1722</sup>, broken to pieces<sup>H1855 H1751</sup> together<sup>H2298</sup>, and became<sup>H1934</sup> like the chaff<sup>H5784</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> the summer<sup>H7007</sup> threshingfloors<sup>H147</sup>; and the wind<sup>H7308</sup> carried<sup>H5376</sup> them<sup>H1994</sup> away<sup>H5376</sup>, that<sup>H3606</sup> no<sup>H3809</sup> place<sup>H870</sup> was found<sup>H7912</sup> for them: and the stone<sup>H69</sup> that smote<sup>H4223</sup> the image<sup>H6755</sup> became<sup>H1934</sup> a great<sup>H7229</sup> mountain<sup>H2906</sup>, and filled<sup>H4391</sup> the whole<sup>H3606</sup> earth<sup>H772</sup>. **36** This<sup>H1836</sup> is the dream<sup>H2493</sup>; and we will tell<sup>H560</sup> the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof before<sup>H6925</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>. **37** Thou<sup>H607</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, art a king<sup>H4430</sup> of kings<sup>H4430</sup>: for the God<sup>H426</sup> of heaven<sup>H8065</sup> hath given<sup>H3052</sup> thee a kingdom<sup>H4437</sup>, power<sup>H2632</sup>, and strength<sup>H8632</sup>, and glory<sup>H3367</sup>. **38** And wheresoever<sup>H3606</sup> the children<sup>H1123</sup> of men<sup>H606</sup> dwell<sup>H1753</sup>, the beasts<sup>H2423</sup> of the field<sup>H1251</sup> and the fowls<sup>H5776</sup> of the heaven<sup>H8065</sup> hath he given<sup>H3052</sup> into thine hand<sup>H3028</sup>, and hath made thee ruler<sup>H7981</sup> over them all<sup>H3606</sup>. Thou<sup>H607</sup> art this head<sup>H7217</sup> of gold<sup>H1722</sup>. **39** And after<sup>H870</sup> thee shall arise<sup>H6966</sup> another<sup>H317</sup> kingdom<sup>H4437</sup> inferior<sup>H772</sup> to thee<sup>H4481</sup>, and another<sup>H317</sup> third<sup>H8523</sup> kingdom<sup>H4437</sup> of brass<sup>H5174</sup>, which shall bear rule<sup>H7981</sup> over all<sup>H3606</sup> the earth<sup>H772</sup>. **40** And the fourth<sup>H7244</sup> kingdom<sup>H4437</sup> shall be<sup>H1934</sup> strong<sup>H8624</sup> as iron<sup>H6523</sup>: forasmuch as iron<sup>H6523</sup> breaketh in pieces<sup>H1855</sup> and subdueth<sup>H2827</sup> all<sup>H3606</sup> things: and as<sup>H6903</sup> iron<sup>H6523</sup> that breaketh<sup>H7490</sup> all<sup>H3606</sup> these<sup>H459</sup>, shall it break in pieces<sup>H1855</sup> and bruise<sup>H7490</sup>. **41** And whereas thou sawest<sup>H2370</sup> the feet<sup>H7271</sup> and toes<sup>H677</sup>, part<sup>H4481</sup> of potters<sup>H6353</sup> clay<sup>H2635</sup>, and part<sup>H4481</sup> of iron<sup>H6523</sup>, the kingdom<sup>H4437</sup> shall be<sup>H1934</sup> divided<sup>H6386</sup>, but<sup>H4481</sup> there shall be<sup>H1934</sup> in it of<sup>H4481</sup> the strength<sup>H5326</sup> of the iron<sup>H6523</sup>, forasmuch as<sup>H3606 H6903</sup> thou sawest<sup>H2370</sup> the iron<sup>H6523</sup> mixed<sup>H6151</sup> with miry<sup>H2917</sup> clay<sup>H2635</sup>. **42** And as the toes<sup>H677</sup> of the feet<sup>H7271</sup> were part<sup>H4481</sup> of iron<sup>H6523</sup>, and part<sup>H4481</sup> of clay<sup>H2635</sup>, so the kingdom<sup>H4437</sup> shall be<sup>H1934</sup> partly<sup>H4481 H7118</sup> strong<sup>H8624</sup>, and partly<sup>H4481 H7118</sup> broken<sup>H8406</sup>. **43** And whereas<sup>H1768</sup> thou sawest<sup>H2370</sup> iron<sup>H6523</sup> mixed<sup>H6151</sup> with miry<sup>H2917</sup> clay<sup>H2635</sup>, they shall mingle themselves<sup>H1934 H6151</sup> with the seed<sup>H2234</sup> of men<sup>H606</sup>: but they shall<sup>H1934</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> cleave<sup>H1693</sup> one<sup>H1836</sup> to<sup>H5974</sup> another<sup>H1836</sup>, even<sup>H1888</sup> as iron<sup>H6523</sup> is not<sup>H3809</sup> mixed<sup>H6151</sup> with clay<sup>H2635</sup>. **44** And in the days<sup>H3118</sup> of these<sup>H581</sup> kings<sup>H4430</sup> shall the God<sup>H426</sup> of heaven<sup>H8065</sup> set

up<sup>H6966</sup> a kingdom<sup>H4437</sup>, which shall never<sup>H5957 H3809</sup> be destroyed<sup>H2255</sup>: and the kingdom<sup>H4437</sup> shall not<sup>H3809</sup> be left<sup>H7662</sup> to other<sup>H321</sup> people<sup>H5972</sup>, but it shall break in pieces<sup>H1855</sup> and consume<sup>H5487</sup> all<sup>H3606</sup> these<sup>H459</sup> kingdoms<sup>H4437</sup>, and it<sup>H1932</sup> shall stand<sup>H6966</sup> for ever<sup>H5957 1819</sup>. **45** Forasmuch as<sup>H3606 H6903</sup> thou sawest<sup>H2370</sup> that the stone<sup>H69</sup> was cut out<sup>H1505</sup> of the mountain<sup>H2906</sup> without<sup>H3809</sup> hands<sup>H3028</sup>, and that it brake in pieces<sup>H1855</sup> the iron<sup>H6523</sup>, the brass<sup>H5174</sup>, the clay<sup>H2635</sup>, the silver<sup>H3702</sup>, and the gold<sup>H1722</sup>; the great<sup>H7229</sup> God<sup>H426</sup> hath made known<sup>H3046</sup> to the king<sup>H4430</sup> what<sup>H4101</sup> shall come to pass<sup>H1934</sup> hereafter<sup>H311 H1836</sup>: and the dream<sup>H2493</sup> is certain<sup>H3330</sup>, and the interpretation<sup>H6591</sup> thereof sure<sup>H540 2021</sup>.

**46** Then<sup>H116</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> fell<sup>H5308</sup> upon<sup>H5922</sup> his face<sup>H600</sup>, and worshipped<sup>H5457</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup>, and commanded<sup>H560</sup> that they should offer<sup>H5260</sup> an oblation<sup>H4504</sup> and sweet odours<sup>H5208</sup> unto him. **47** The king<sup>H4430</sup> answered<sup>H6032</sup> unto Daniel<sup>H1841</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup>, Or<sup>H4481</sup> a truth<sup>H7187</sup> it is, that<sup>H1768</sup> your God<sup>H426</sup> is a God<sup>H426</sup> of gods<sup>H426</sup>, and a Lord<sup>H4756</sup> of kings<sup>H4430</sup>, and a revealer<sup>H1541</sup> of secrets<sup>H7328</sup>, seeing thou couldst<sup>H3202</sup> reveal<sup>H1541</sup> this<sup>H1836</sup> secret<sup>H7328</sup>. **48** Then<sup>H116</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> made<sup>H7236</sup> Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> a great man<sup>H7236</sup>, and gave<sup>H3052</sup> him many<sup>H7690</sup> great<sup>H7260</sup> gifts<sup>H4978</sup>, and made him ruler<sup>H7981</sup> over<sup>H5922</sup> the whole<sup>H3606</sup> province<sup>H4083</sup> of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>, and chief<sup>H7229</sup> of the governors<sup>H5460</sup> over<sup>H5922</sup> all<sup>H3606</sup> the wise<sup>H2445</sup> men of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>. **49** Then Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> requested<sup>H1156</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>, and he set<sup>H4483</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, over<sup>H5922</sup> the affairs<sup>H5673</sup> of the province<sup>H4083</sup> of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>: but Daniel<sup>H1841</sup> sat in the gate<sup>H8651</sup> of the king<sup>H4430</sup>.
