## **Daniel 9**

1 In the first<sup>H259</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Darius<sup>H1867</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahasuerus<sup>H325</sup>, of the seed<sup>H2233</sup> of the Medes<sup>H4074</sup>, which was made king<sup>H4427</sup> over the realm<sup>H4438</sup> of the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup>, 2 In the first<sup>H259</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of his reign<sup>H4427</sup> I Daniel<sup>H1840</sup> understood<sup>H995</sup> by books<sup>H5612</sup> the number<sup>H4557</sup> of the years<sup>H8141</sup>, whereof the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came to Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, that he would accomplish<sup>H4390</sup> seventy<sup>H7657</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in the desolations<sup>H2723</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 3 And I set<sup>H5414</sup> my face<sup>H6440</sup> unto the Lord<sup>H136</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, to seek<sup>H1245</sup> by prayer<sup>H8605</sup> and supplications<sup>H8469</sup>, with fasting<sup>H6685</sup>, and sackcloth<sup>H8242</sup>, and ashes<sup>H665</sup>:

4 And I prayed<sup>H6419</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> my God<sup>H430</sup>, and made my confession<sup>H3034</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, O<sup>H577</sup> Lord<sup>H136</sup>, the great<sup>H1419</sup> and dreadful<sup>H3372</sup> God<sup>H410</sup>, keeping<sup>H8104</sup> the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> and mercy<sup>H2617</sup> to them that love<sup>H157</sup> him, and to them that keep H8104 his commandments H4687; 5 We have sinned H2398, and have committed iniquity H5753, and have done wickedly<sup>H7561</sup>, and have rebelled<sup>H4775</sup>, even by departing<sup>H5493</sup> from thy precepts<sup>H4687</sup> and from thy judgments<sup>H4941</sup>: 6 Neither have we hearkened H8085 unto thy servants the prophets have we hearkened in thy name to our kings<sup>H4428</sup>, our princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and our fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and to all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>. **7** O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, righteousness H6666 belongeth unto thee, but unto us confusion faces faces H6440, as at this day H3117; to the men H376 of Judah H3063, and to the inhabitants H3427 of Jerusalem H3389, and unto all Israel H3478, that are near H7138, and that are far off<sup>H7350</sup>, through all the countries<sup>H776</sup> whither thou hast driven<sup>H5080</sup> them, because of their trespass<sup>H4604</sup> that they have trespassed<sup>H4603</sup> against thee.<sup>2</sup> 8 O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, to us belongeth confusion<sup>H1322</sup> of face<sup>H6440</sup>, to our kings<sup>H4428</sup>, to our princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and to our fathers<sup>H1</sup>, because we have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against thee. **9** To the Lord<sup>H136</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> belong mercies H7356 and forgivenesses H5547, though we have rebelled against him; 10 Neither have we obeyed the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>, to walk<sup>H3212</sup> in his laws<sup>H8451</sup>, which he set<sup>H5414</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> us by<sup>H3027</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup> the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>. 11 Yea, all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> have transgressed<sup>H5674</sup> thy law<sup>H8451</sup>, even by departing<sup>H5493</sup>, that they might not obey H8085 thy voice H6963; therefore the curse H423 is poured upon us, and the oath that is written H3789 in the law H8451 of Moses H4872 the servant God God God H430, because we have sinned against him. 12 And he hath confirmed his words his words his words hat his words hat against us, and against our judges that judged<sup>H8199</sup> us, by bringing<sup>H935</sup> upon us a great<sup>H1419</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>: for under the whole heaven<sup>H8064</sup> hath not been done<sup>H6213</sup> as hath been done H6213 upon Jerusalem H3389. 13 As it is written H3789 in the law H8451 of Moses H4872, all this evil come<sup>H935</sup> upon us: yet made we not our prayer<sup>H2470</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>, that we might turn<sup>H7725</sup> from our iniquities  $^{H5771}$ , and understand  $^{H7919}$  thy truth  $^{H571.3}$  14 Therefore hath the LORD  $^{H3068}$  watched  $^{H8245}$  upon the evil H7451, and brought H935 it upon us: for the LORD H3068 our God H430 is righteous H6662 in all his works H4639 which he doeth<sup>H6213</sup>: for we obeyed<sup>H8085</sup> not his voice<sup>H6963</sup>. **15** And now, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>, that hast brought<sup>H3318</sup> thy people<sup>H5971</sup> forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> with a mighty<sup>H2389</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and hast gotten<sup>H6213</sup> thee renown<sup>H8034</sup>, as at this day<sup>H3117</sup>; we have sinned<sup>H2398</sup>, we have done wickedly<sup>H7561</sup>. <sup>4</sup> 16 O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, according to all thy righteousness H6666, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury H2534 be turned away F7725 from thy city H5892 Jerusalem H3389, thy holy H6944 mountain H2022: because for our sins H2399, and for the iniquities H5771 of our fathers H1, Jerusalem H3389 and thy people H5971 are become a reproach H2781 to all that are about H5439 us. 17 Now therefore, O our  $God^{H430}$ , hear  $^{H8085}$  the prayer  $^{H8605}$  of thy servant  $^{H5650}$ , and his supplications  $^{H8469}$ , and cause thy face  $^{H6440}$  to shine  $^{H215}$ upon thy sanctuary H4720 that is desolate H8076, for the Lord's sake. 18 O my God H430, incline H5186 thine ear H241, and hear<sup>H8085</sup>; open<sup>H6491</sup> thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, and behold<sup>H7200</sup> our desolations<sup>H8074</sup>, and the city<sup>H5892</sup> which is called<sup>H7121</sup> by thy name H8034: for we do not present our supplications before before the for our righteousnesses but for thy great<sup>H7227</sup> mercies<sup>H7356</sup>.56 **19** O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, hear<sup>H8085</sup>; O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, forgive<sup>H5545</sup>; O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, hearken<sup>H7181</sup> and do<sup>H6213</sup>; defer<sup>H309</sup> not<sup>H408</sup>, for thine own sake, O my God<sup>H430</sup>: for thy city<sup>H5892</sup> and thy people<sup>H5971</sup> are called<sup>H7121</sup> by thy name<sup>H8034</sup>.

20 And whiles I was speaking H1696, and praying H6419, and confessing H3034 my sin H2403 and the sin H2403 of my people H5971 Israel H3478, and presenting H5307 my supplication H8467 before H6440 the LORD H3068 my God H430 for the holy H6944 mountain<sup>H2022</sup> of my God<sup>H430</sup>; **21** Yea, whiles I was speaking<sup>H1696</sup> in prayer<sup>H8605</sup>, even the man<sup>H376</sup> Gabriel<sup>H1403</sup>, whom I had seen H7200 in the vision H2377 at the beginning H8462, being caused to fly H3286 swiftly H3288, touched me about the time  $^{H6256}$  of the evening  $^{H6153}$  oblation  $^{H4503.7}$  22 And he informed  $^{H995}$  me, and talked  $^{H1696}$  with me, and said  $^{H559}$ , O Daniel H1840, I am now come forth to give thee skill and understanding H998.8 23 At the beginning H8462 of thy supplications H8469 the commandment came forth and I am come should be supplications to shew the commandment the commandment came forth and I am come should be supplications. beloved H2532: therefore understand H995 the matter H1697, and consider the vision 44758 910 24 Seventy weeks weeks are determined H2852 upon thy people and upon thy holy H6944 city H5892, to finish H3607 the transgression H6588, and to make an end H8552 H2856 of sins H2403, and to make reconciliation H3722 for iniquity H5771, and to bring in H935 everlasting H5769 righteousness H6664, and to seal upH2856 the visionH2377 and prophecyH5030, and to anointH4886 the mostH6944 Holy H6944. 111213 25 Know H3045 therefore and understand H7919, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore H7725 and to build H1129 Jerusalem unto the Messiah H4899 the Prince H5057 shall be seven weeks H7620, and threescore H8346 and two H8147 weeks H7620: the street H7339 shall be built again again again, and the wall even in troublous H6695 times H6256.
