## **Deuteronomy 20**

1 When thou goest out<sup>H3318</sup> to battle<sup>H4421</sup> against thine enemies<sup>H341</sup>, and seest<sup>H7200</sup> horses<sup>H5483</sup>, and chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and a people<sup>H5971</sup> more<sup>H7227</sup> than thou, be not afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of them: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> is with thee, which brought thee up<sup>H5927</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 2 And it shall be, when ye are come nigh<sup>H7126</sup> unto the battle<sup>H4421</sup>, that the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall approach<sup>H5066</sup> and speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup>, 3 And shall say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Hear<sup>H8085</sup>, O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, ye approach<sup>H7131</sup> this day<sup>H3117</sup> unto battle<sup>H4421</sup> against your enemies<sup>H341</sup>: let not your hearts<sup>H3824</sup> faint<sup>H7401</sup>, fear<sup>H3372</sup> not, and do not tremble<sup>H2648</sup>, neither be ye terrified<sup>H6206</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of them;<sup>12</sup> 4 For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup> is he that goeth<sup>H1980</sup> with you, to fight<sup>H3898</sup> for you against your enemies<sup>H341</sup>, to save<sup>H3467</sup> you. 5 And the officers<sup>H7860</sup> shall speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, What man<sup>H376</sup> is there that hath built<sup>H1129</sup> a new<sup>H2319</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and hath not dedicated<sup>H2596</sup> it? let him go<sup>H3212</sup> and return<sup>H7725</sup> to his house<sup>H1004</sup>, lest he die<sup>H4191</sup> in the battle<sup>H4421</sup>, and another<sup>H312</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> dedicate<sup>H2596</sup> it. 6 And what man<sup>H376</sup> is he that hath planted<sup>H5193</sup> a vinevard<sup>H3754</sup>, and hath not yet eaten<sup>H2490</sup> of it? let him also go<sup>H3212</sup> and return<sup>H7725</sup> unto his house<sup>H1004</sup>, lest he die<sup>H4191</sup> in the battle<sup>H4421</sup>, and another<sup>H312</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> eat<sup>H2490</sup> of it.<sup>3</sup> 7 And what man<sup>H376</sup> is there that hath betrothed<sup>H781</sup> a wife<sup>H802</sup>, and hath not taken<sup>H3947</sup> her? let him go<sup>H3212</sup> and return<sup>H7725</sup> unto his house<sup>H1004</sup>, lest he die<sup>H4191</sup> in the battle<sup>H4421</sup>, and another<sup>H312</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> take<sup>H3947</sup> her. 8 And the officers<sup>H7860</sup> shall speak<sup>H1696</sup> further<sup>H3254</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and they shall say<sup>H559</sup>, What man<sup>H376</sup> is there that is fearful<sup>H3373</sup> and fainthearted<sup>H7390 H3824</sup>? let him go<sup>H3212</sup> and return<sup>H7725</sup> unto his house<sup>H1004</sup>, lest his brethren's<sup>H251</sup> heart<sup>H3824</sup> faint<sup>H4549</sup> as well as his heart<sup>H3824,4</sup> 9 And it shall be, when the officers<sup>H7860</sup> have made an end<sup>H3615</sup> of speaking<sup>H1696</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup>, that they shall make<sup>H6485</sup> captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the armies<sup>H6635</sup> to lead<sup>H7218</sup> the people<sup>H5971.5</sup>

10 When thou comest nigh<sup>H7126</sup> unto a city<sup>H5892</sup> to fight<sup>H3898</sup> against it, then proclaim<sup>H7121</sup> peace<sup>H7965</sup> unto it. 11 And it shall be, if it make thee answer<sup>H6030</sup> of peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and open<sup>H6605</sup> unto thee, then it shall be, that all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that is found<sup>H4672</sup> therein shall be tributaries<sup>H4522</sup> unto thee, and they shall serve<sup>H5647</sup> thee. 12 And if it will make no peace<sup>H7999</sup> with thee, but will make<sup>H6213</sup> war<sup>H4421</sup> against thee, then thou shalt besiege<sup>H6696</sup> it: 13 And when the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hath delivered<sup>H5414</sup> it into thine hands<sup>H3027</sup>, thou shalt smite<sup>H5221</sup> every male<sup>H2138</sup> thereof with the edge<sup>H6310</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup>: **14** But the women<sup>H802</sup>, and the little ones<sup>H2945</sup>, and the cattle<sup>H929</sup>, and all that is in the city<sup>H5892</sup>, even all the spoil<sup>H7998</sup> thereof, shalt thou take<sup>H962</sup> unto thyself; and thou shalt eat<sup>H398</sup> the spoil<sup>H7998</sup> of thine enemies<sup>H341</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hath given<sup>H5414</sup> thee.<sup>6</sup> **15** Thus shalt thou do<sup>H6213</sup> unto all the cities<sup>H5892</sup> which are very<sup>H3966</sup> far off<sup>H7350</sup> from thee, which<sup>H2007</sup> are not of the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of these nations<sup>H1471</sup>. **16** But of the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of these people<sup>H5971</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> doth give<sup>H5414</sup> thee for an inheritance<sup>H5159</sup>, thou shalt save alive<sup>H2421</sup> nothing that breatheth<sup>H5397</sup>: **17** But thou shalt utterly<sup>H2763</sup> destroy<sup>H2763</sup> them; namely, the Hittites<sup>H2850</sup>, and the Amorites<sup>H567</sup>, the Canaanites<sup>H3669</sup>, and the Perizzites<sup>H6522</sup>, the Hivites<sup>H2340</sup>, and the Jebusites<sup>H2983</sup>; as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hath commanded<sup>H6680</sup> thee: **18** That they teach<sup>H3925</sup> you not to do<sup>H6213</sup> after all their abominations<sup>H8441</sup>, which they have done<sup>H6213</sup> unto their gods<sup>H430</sup>; so should ye sin<sup>H2398</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your  $God^{H430}$ . **19** When thou shalt besiege<sup>H6696</sup> a city<sup>H5892</sup> a long<sup>H7227</sup> time<sup>H3117</sup>, in making war<sup>H3898</sup> against it to take<sup>H8610</sup> it, thou shalt not destroy<sup>H7843</sup> the trees<sup>H6086</sup> thereof by forcing<sup>H5080</sup> an axe<sup>H1631</sup> against them: for thou mayest eat<sup>H398</sup> of them, and thou shalt not cut them down<sup>H3772</sup> (for the tree<sup>H6086</sup> of the field<sup>H7704</sup> is man's<sup>H120</sup> life) to employ<sup>H935</sup> them in the siege<sup>H6440 H4692,78</sup> 20 Only the trees<sup>H6086</sup> which thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> that they be not trees<sup>H6086</sup> for meat<sup>H3978</sup>, thou shalt destroy<sup>H7843</sup> and cut them down<sup>H3772</sup>; and thou shalt build<sup>H1129</sup> bulwarks<sup>H4692</sup> against the city<sup>H5892</sup> that maketh<sup>H6213</sup> war<sup>H4421</sup> with thee, until it be subdued<sup>H3381,9</sup>
