## **Deuteronomy 6**

**1** Now these are the commandments<sup>H4687</sup>, the statutes<sup>H2706</sup>, and the judgments<sup>H4941</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> to teach<sup>H3925</sup> you, that ye might do<sup>H6213</sup> them in the land<sup>H776</sup> whither ye go<sup>H5674</sup> to possess<sup>H3423</sup> it:<sup>1</sup> **2** That thou mightest fear<sup>H3372</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, to keep<sup>H8104</sup> all his statutes<sup>H2708</sup> and his commandments<sup>H4687</sup>, which I command<sup>H6680</sup> thee, thou, and thy son<sup>H1121</sup>, and thy son's<sup>H1121</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup>, all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of thy life<sup>H2416</sup>; and that thy days<sup>H3117</sup> may be prolonged<sup>H748</sup>. **3** Hear<sup>H8085</sup> therefore, O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and observe<sup>H8104</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> it; that it may be well<sup>H3190</sup> with thee, and that ye may increase<sup>H7235</sup> mightily<sup>H3966</sup>, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of thy fathers<sup>H1</sup> hath promised<sup>H1696</sup> thee, in the land<sup>H776</sup> that floweth<sup>H2100</sup> with milk<sup>H2461</sup> and honey<sup>H1706</sup>.

4 Hear<sup>H8085</sup>, O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> is one<sup>H259</sup> LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: 5 And thou shalt love<sup>H157</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> with all thine heart<sup>H3824</sup>, and with all thy soul<sup>H5315</sup>, and with all thy might<sup>H3966</sup>. 6 And these words<sup>H1697</sup>, which I command<sup>H6680</sup> thee this day<sup>H3117</sup>, shall be in thine heart<sup>H3824</sup>: 7 And thou shalt teach them diligently<sup>H8150</sup> unto thy children<sup>H1121</sup>, and shalt talk<sup>H1696</sup> of them when thou sittest<sup>H3427</sup> in thine house<sup>H1004</sup>, and when thou walkest<sup>H3212</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup>, and when thou liest down<sup>H7901</sup>, and when thou risest up<sup>H6965,2</sup> 8 And thou shalt bind<sup>H7194</sup> them for a sign<sup>H226</sup> upon thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and they shall be as frontlets<sup>H2903</sup> between thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>. **9** And thou shalt write<sup>H3789</sup> them upon the posts<sup>H4201</sup> of thy house<sup>H1004</sup>, and on thy gates<sup>H8179</sup>. **10** And it shall be, when the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> shall have brought<sup>H935</sup> thee into the land<sup>H776</sup> which he sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto thy fathers<sup>H1</sup>, to Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, to Isaac<sup>H3327</sup>, and to Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, to give<sup>H5414</sup> thee great<sup>H1419</sup> and goodly<sup>H2896</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup>, which thou buildedst<sup>H1129</sup> not, **11** And houses<sup>H1004</sup> full<sup>H4392</sup> of all good<sup>H2898</sup> things, which thou filledst<sup>H4390</sup> not, and wells<sup>H953</sup> digged<sup>H2672</sup>, which thou diggedst<sup>H2672</sup> not, vineyards<sup>H3754</sup> and olive trees<sup>H2132</sup>, which thou plantedst<sup>H5193</sup> not; when thou shalt have eaten<sup>H398</sup> and be full<sup>H7646</sup>; **12** Then beware<sup>H8104</sup> lest thou forget<sup>H7911</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, which brought thee forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, from the house<sup>H1004</sup> of bondage<sup>H5650, 3</sup> **13** Thou shalt fear<sup>H3372</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, and serve<sup>H5647</sup> him, and shalt swear<sup>H7650</sup> by his name<sup>H8034</sup>. **14** Ye shall not go<sup>H3212</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> other<sup>H312</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup>, of the gods<sup>H430</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> which are round about<sup>H5439</sup> you; **15** (For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> is a jealous<sup>H7067</sup> God<sup>H410</sup> among<sup>H7130</sup> you) lest the anger<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> be kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against thee, and destroy<sup>H8045</sup> thee from off the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>. **16** Ye shall not tempt<sup>H5254</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup>, as ye tempted<sup>H5254</sup> him in Massah<sup>H4532</sup>.

**17** Ye shall diligently<sup>H8104</sup> keep<sup>H8104</sup> the commandments<sup>H4687</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup>, and his testimonies<sup>H5713</sup>, and his statutes<sup>H2706</sup>, which he hath commanded<sup>H6680</sup> thee. **18** And thou shalt do<sup>H6213</sup> that which is right<sup>H3477</sup> and good<sup>H2896</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: that it may be well<sup>H3190</sup> with thee, and that thou mayest go in<sup>H935</sup> and possess<sup>H3423</sup> the good<sup>H2896</sup> land<sup>H776</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto thy fathers<sup>H1</sup>, **19** To cast out<sup>H1920</sup> all thine enemies<sup>H341</sup> from before<sup>H6440</sup> thee, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath spoken<sup>H1696</sup>. **20** And when thy son<sup>H1121</sup> asketh<sup>H7592</sup> thee in time to come<sup>H4279</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, What mean the testimonies<sup>H5713</sup>, and the statutes<sup>H2706</sup>, and the judgments<sup>H4941</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> hath commanded<sup>H6680</sup> you?<sup>4</sup> **21** Then thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> unto thy son<sup>H1121</sup>, We were Pharaoh's<sup>H6547</sup> bondmen<sup>H5650</sup> in Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>; and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> brought us out<sup>H3318</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> with a mighty<sup>H2389</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>: **22** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shewed<sup>H5141</sup> signs<sup>H226</sup> and wonders<sup>H4159</sup>, great<sup>H1419</sup> and sore<sup>H7451</sup>, upon Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, upon Pharaoh<sup>H6647</sup>, and upon all his household<sup>H1004</sup>, before our eyes<sup>H5869.5</sup> **23** And he brought us out<sup>H3318</sup> from thence, that he might bring us in<sup>H935</sup>, to give<sup>H5141</sup> us the land<sup>H776</sup> which he sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto our fathers<sup>H1</sup>. **24** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> us to do<sup>H6213</sup> all these statutes<sup>H2706</sup>, to fear<sup>H3372</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>, for our good<sup>H2896</sup> always<sup>H3117</sup>, that he might preserve us alive<sup>H2421</sup>, as it is at this day<sup>H3117</sup>. **25** And it shall be our righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>, if we observe<sup>H8104</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> all these<sup>H2063</sup> commandmets<sup>H4687</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>, as he hath commanded<sup>H6680</sup> us.
