

# Ecclesiastes 3

1 To every thing there is a season<sup>H2165</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to every purpose<sup>H2656</sup> under the heaven<sup>H8064</sup>: 2 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to be born<sup>H3205</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to die<sup>H4191</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> to plant<sup>H5193</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to pluck up<sup>H6131</sup> that which is planted<sup>H5193,1</sup>; 3 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to kill<sup>H2026</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to heal<sup>H7495</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> to break down<sup>H6555</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to build up<sup>H1129</sup>; 4 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to weep<sup>H1058</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to laugh<sup>H7832</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> to mourn<sup>H5594</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to dance<sup>H7540</sup>; 5 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to cast away<sup>H7993</sup> stones<sup>H68</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to gather<sup>H3664</sup> stones<sup>H68</sup> together<sup>H3664</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> to embrace<sup>H2263</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to refrain<sup>H7368</sup> from embracing<sup>H2263,2</sup>; 6 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to get<sup>H1245</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to lose<sup>H6</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> to keep<sup>H8104</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to cast away<sup>H7993,3</sup>; 7 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to rend<sup>H7167</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to sew<sup>H8609</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> to keep silence<sup>H2814</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to speak<sup>H1696</sup>; 8 A time<sup>H6256</sup> to love<sup>H157</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> to hate<sup>H8130</sup>; a time<sup>H6256</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup>, and a time<sup>H6256</sup> of peace<sup>H7965</sup>. 9 What profit<sup>H3504</sup> hath he that worketh<sup>H6213</sup> in that wherein<sup>H834</sup> he laboureth<sup>H6001</sup>? 10 I have seen<sup>H7200</sup> the travail<sup>H6045</sup>, which God<sup>H430</sup> hath given<sup>H5414</sup> to the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup> to be exercised<sup>H6031</sup> in it.

11 He hath made<sup>H6213</sup> every thing beautiful<sup>H3303</sup> in his time<sup>H6256</sup>: also he hath set<sup>H5414</sup> the world<sup>H5769</sup> in their heart<sup>H3820</sup>, so that<sup>H1097</sup> no man<sup>H120</sup> can find out<sup>H4672</sup> the work<sup>H4639</sup> that God<sup>H430</sup> maketh<sup>H6213</sup> from the beginning<sup>H7218</sup> to the end<sup>H5490</sup>. 12 I know<sup>H3045</sup> that there is no good<sup>H2896</sup> in them, but for a man to rejoice<sup>H8055</sup>, and to do<sup>H6213</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup> in his life<sup>H2416</sup>. 13 And also that every man<sup>H120</sup> should eat<sup>H398</sup> and drink<sup>H8354</sup>, and enjoy<sup>H7200</sup> the good<sup>H2896</sup> of all his labour<sup>H5999</sup>, it is the gift<sup>H4991</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>. 14 I know<sup>H3045</sup> that, whatsoever God<sup>H430</sup> doeth<sup>H6213</sup>, it shall be for ever<sup>H5769</sup>: nothing<sup>H369</sup> can be put<sup>H3254</sup> to it, nor any thing taken<sup>H1639</sup> from it: and God<sup>H430</sup> doeth<sup>H6213</sup> it, that men should fear<sup>H3372</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> him. 15 That which hath been is now<sup>H3528</sup>, and that which is to be hath already<sup>H3528</sup> been; and God<sup>H430</sup> requireth<sup>H1245</sup> that which is past<sup>H7291</sup>. 4

16 And moreover I saw<sup>H7200</sup> under the sun<sup>H8121</sup> the place<sup>H4725</sup> of judgment<sup>H4941</sup>, that wickedness<sup>H7562</sup> was there; and the place<sup>H4725</sup> of righteousness<sup>H6664</sup>, that iniquity<sup>H7562</sup> was there. 17 I said<sup>H559</sup> in mine heart<sup>H3820</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> shall judge<sup>H8199</sup> the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> and the wicked<sup>H7563</sup>: for there is a time<sup>H6256</sup> there for every purpose<sup>H2656</sup> and for every work<sup>H4639</sup>. 18 I said<sup>H559</sup> in mine heart<sup>H3820</sup> concerning the estate<sup>H1700</sup> of the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>, that God<sup>H430</sup> might manifest<sup>H1305</sup> them, and that they might see<sup>H7200</sup> that they<sup>H1992</sup> themselves are beasts<sup>H929</sup>. 19 For that which befalleth<sup>H4745</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup> befalleth<sup>H4745</sup> beasts<sup>H929</sup>; even one thing<sup>H259</sup> befalleth<sup>H4745</sup> them: as the one dieth<sup>H4194</sup>, so dieth<sup>H4194</sup> the other<sup>H2088</sup>; yea, they have all one<sup>H259</sup> breath<sup>H7307</sup>; so that a man<sup>H120</sup> hath no preeminence<sup>H4195</sup> above a beast<sup>H929</sup>: for all is vanity<sup>H1892</sup>. 20 All go<sup>H1980</sup> unto one<sup>H259</sup> place<sup>H4725</sup>; all are of the dust<sup>H6083</sup>, and all turn<sup>H7725</sup> to dust<sup>H6083</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup>. 21 Who knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of man<sup>H1121</sup> that goeth<sup>H5927</sup> upward<sup>H4605</sup>, and the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of the beast<sup>H929</sup> that goeth<sup>H3381</sup> downward<sup>H4295</sup> to the earth<sup>H776</sup>? 22 Wherefore I perceive<sup>H7200</sup> that there is nothing better<sup>H2896</sup>, than that a man<sup>H120</sup> should rejoice<sup>H8055</sup> in his own works<sup>H4639</sup>; for that is his portion<sup>H2506</sup>: for who shall bring<sup>H935</sup> him to see<sup>H7200</sup> what shall be after<sup>H310</sup> him?
