

# Exodus 1

1 Now these are the names<sup>H8034</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, which came<sup>H935</sup> into Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>; every man<sup>H376</sup> and his household<sup>H1004</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> with Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>. 2 Reuben<sup>H7205</sup>, Simeon<sup>H8095</sup>, Levi<sup>H3878</sup>, and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, 3 Issachar<sup>H3485</sup>, Zebulun<sup>H2074</sup>, and Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup>, 4 Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, and Naphtali<sup>H5321</sup>, Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, and Asher<sup>H836</sup>. 5 And all the souls<sup>H5315</sup> that came out<sup>H3318</sup> of the loins<sup>H3409</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> were seventy<sup>H7657</sup> souls<sup>H5315</sup>: for Joseph<sup>H3130</sup> was in Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> already.<sup>1</sup> 6 And Joseph<sup>H3130</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup>, and all his brethren<sup>H251</sup>, and all that generation<sup>H1755</sup>. 7 And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> were fruitful<sup>H6509</sup>, and increased abundantly<sup>H8317</sup>, and multiplied<sup>H7235</sup>, and waxed exceeding<sup>H3966 H3966</sup> mighty<sup>H6105</sup>; and the land<sup>H776</sup> was filled<sup>H4390</sup> with them.

8 Now there arose up<sup>H6965</sup> a new<sup>H2319</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> over Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, which knew<sup>H3045</sup> not Joseph<sup>H3130</sup>. 9 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto his people<sup>H5971</sup>, Behold, the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> are more<sup>H7227</sup> and mightier<sup>H6099</sup> than we: 10 Come on<sup>H3051</sup>, let us deal wisely<sup>H2449</sup> with them; lest they multiply<sup>H7235</sup>, and it come to pass, that, when there falleth out<sup>H7122</sup> any war<sup>H4421</sup>, they<sup>H1931</sup> join<sup>H3254</sup> also unto our enemies<sup>H8130</sup>, and fight<sup>H3898</sup> against us, and so get them up<sup>H5927</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup>. 11 Therefore they did set<sup>H7760</sup> over them taskmasters<sup>H4522 H8269</sup> to afflict<sup>H6031</sup> them with their burdens<sup>H5450</sup>. And they built<sup>H1129</sup> for Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup> treasure<sup>H4543</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup>, Pithom<sup>H6619</sup> and Raamses<sup>H7486</sup>. 12 But the more they afflicted<sup>H6031</sup> them, the more<sup>H3651</sup> they multiplied<sup>H7235</sup> and grew<sup>H6555</sup>. And they were grieved<sup>H6973</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 13 And the Egyptians<sup>H4714</sup> made<sup>H5647</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to serve<sup>H5647</sup> with rigour<sup>H6531</sup>: 14 And they made<sup>H4843</sup> their lives<sup>H2416</sup> bitter<sup>H4843</sup> with hard<sup>H7186</sup> bondage<sup>H5656</sup>, in mortar<sup>H2563</sup>, and in brick<sup>H3843</sup>, and in all manner of service<sup>H5656</sup> in the field<sup>H7704</sup>: all their service<sup>H5656</sup>, wherein they made them serve<sup>H5647</sup>, was with rigour<sup>H6531</sup>.

15 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> spake<sup>H559</sup> to the Hebrew<sup>H5680</sup> midwives<sup>H3205</sup>, of which the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the one<sup>H259</sup> was Shiphrah<sup>H8236</sup>, and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the other<sup>H8145</sup> Puah<sup>H6326</sup>. 16 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, When ye do the office of a midwife<sup>H3205</sup> to the Hebrew women<sup>H5680</sup>, and see<sup>H7200</sup> them upon the stools<sup>H70</sup>; if it be a son<sup>H1121</sup>, then ye shall kill<sup>H4191</sup> him: but if it be a daughter<sup>H1323</sup>, then she shall live<sup>H2425</sup>. 17 But the midwives<sup>H3205</sup> feared<sup>H3372</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, and did<sup>H6213</sup> not as the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> commanded<sup>H1696</sup> them, but saved<sup>H2421</sup> the men children<sup>H3206</sup> alive<sup>H2421</sup>. 18 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> for the midwives<sup>H3205</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Why<sup>H4069</sup> have ye done<sup>H6213</sup> this thing<sup>H1697</sup>, and have saved<sup>H2421</sup> the men children<sup>H3206</sup> alive<sup>H2421</sup>? 19 And the midwives<sup>H3205</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup>, Because the Hebrew<sup>H5680</sup> women<sup>H802</sup> are not as the Egyptian women<sup>H4713</sup>; for they are lively<sup>H2422</sup>, and are delivered<sup>H3205</sup> ere<sup>H2962</sup> the midwives<sup>H3205</sup> come in<sup>H935</sup> unto them. 20 Therefore God<sup>H430</sup> dealt well<sup>H3190</sup> with the midwives<sup>H3205</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> multiplied<sup>H7235</sup>, and waxed very<sup>H3966</sup> mighty<sup>H6105</sup>. 21 And it came to pass, because the midwives<sup>H3205</sup> feared<sup>H3372</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, that he made<sup>H6213</sup> them houses<sup>H1004</sup>. 22 And Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup> charged<sup>H6680</sup> all his people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Every son<sup>H1121</sup> that is born<sup>H3209</sup> ye shall cast<sup>H7993</sup> into the river<sup>H2975</sup>, and every daughter<sup>H1323</sup> ye shall save alive<sup>H2421</sup>.
