1 Moreover the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came unto me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 Son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, set<sup>H7760</sup> thy face<sup>H6440</sup> against mount<sup>H2022</sup> Seir<sup>H8165</sup>, and prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> against it, 3 And say<sup>H559</sup> unto it, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Behold, O mount<sup>H2022</sup> Seir<sup>H8165</sup>, I am against thee, and I will stretch out<sup>H5186</sup> mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> against thee, and I will make<sup>H5414</sup> thee most<sup>H4923</sup> desolate<sup>H8077</sup>.¹ 4 I will lay<sup>H7760</sup> thy cities<sup>H5892</sup> waste<sup>H2723</sup>, and thou shalt be desolate<sup>H8077</sup>, and thou shalt know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 5 Because thou hast had a perpetual<sup>H5769</sup> hatred<sup>H342</sup>, and hast shed<sup>H5064</sup> the blood of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> by the force<sup>H3027</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup> in the time<sup>H6256</sup> of their calamity<sup>H343</sup>, in the time<sup>H6256</sup> that their iniquity<sup>H5771</sup> had an end<sup>H7093</sup>:<sup>234</sup> 6 Therefore, as I live<sup>H2416</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, I will prepare<sup>H6213</sup> thee unto blood<sup>H1818</sup>, and blood<sup>H1818</sup> shall pursue<sup>H7291</sup> thee: sith<sup>H518</sup> thou hast not hated<sup>H8130</sup> blood<sup>H1818</sup>, even blood<sup>H1818</sup> shall pursue<sup>H7291</sup> thee. 7 Thus will I make<sup>H5414</sup> mount<sup>H2022</sup> Seir<sup>H8165</sup> most<sup>H8077</sup> desolate<sup>H8077</sup>, and cut off<sup>H3772</sup> from it him that passeth out<sup>H5674</sup> and him that returneth<sup>H7725</sup>. 8 And I will fill<sup>H4390</sup> his mountains<sup>H2022</sup> with his slain<sup>H2491</sup> men: in thy hills<sup>H1389</sup>, and in thy valleys<sup>H1516</sup>, and in all thy rivers<sup>H650</sup>, shall they fall<sup>H5307</sup> that are slain<sup>H2491</sup> with the sword<sup>H2719</sup>. 9 I will make<sup>H5414</sup> thee perpetual<sup>H5769</sup> desolations<sup>H8077</sup>, and thy cities<sup>H5892</sup> shall not return<sup>H7725</sup> and ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

10 Because thou hast said<sup>H559</sup>, These two<sup>H8147</sup> nations<sup>H1471</sup> and these two<sup>H8147</sup> countries<sup>H776</sup> shall be mine, and we will possess<sup>H3423</sup> it; whereas the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was there:<sup>6</sup> 11 Therefore, as I live<sup>H2416</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, I will even do<sup>H6213</sup> according to thine anger<sup>H639</sup>, and according to thine envy<sup>H7068</sup> which thou hast used<sup>H6213</sup> out of thy hatred<sup>H8135</sup> against them; and I will make myself known<sup>H3045</sup> among them, when I have judged<sup>H8199</sup> thee. 12 And thou shalt know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and that I have heard<sup>H8085</sup> all thy blasphemies<sup>H5007</sup> which thou hast spoken<sup>H559</sup> against the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, They are laid desolate<sup>H8074</sup> H8077, they are given<sup>H5414</sup> us to consume<sup>H402</sup>.<sup>7</sup> 13 Thus with your mouth<sup>H6310</sup> ye have boasted<sup>H1431</sup> against me, and have multiplied<sup>H6280</sup> your words<sup>H1697</sup> against me: I have heard<sup>H8085</sup> them.<sup>8</sup> 14 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; When the whole earth<sup>H776</sup> rejoiceth<sup>H8055</sup>, I will make<sup>H6213</sup> thee desolate<sup>H8077</sup>. 15 As thou didst rejoice<sup>H8057</sup> at the inheritance<sup>H5159</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, because it was desolate<sup>H8074</sup>, so will I do<sup>H6213</sup> unto thee: thou shalt be desolate<sup>H8077</sup>, O mount<sup>H2022</sup> Seir<sup>H8165</sup>, and all Idumea<sup>H123</sup>, even all of it: and they shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
