



1 Afterward he brought<sup>H935</sup> me to the temple<sup>H1964</sup>, and measured<sup>H4058</sup> the posts<sup>H352</sup>, six<sup>H8337</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> broad<sup>H7341</sup> on the one side<sup>H6311</sup>, and six<sup>H8337</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> broad<sup>H7341</sup> on the other side<sup>H6311</sup>, which was the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup>. 2 And the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of the door<sup>H6607</sup> was ten<sup>H6235</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>; and the sides<sup>H3802</sup> of the door<sup>H6607</sup> were five<sup>H2568</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> on the one side, and five<sup>H2568</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> on the other side: and he measured<sup>H4058</sup> the length<sup>H753</sup> thereof, forty<sup>H705</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>: and the breadth<sup>H7341</sup>, twenty<sup>H6242</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 3 Then went<sup>H935</sup> he inward<sup>H6441</sup>, and measured<sup>H4058</sup> the post<sup>H352</sup> of the door<sup>H6607</sup>, two<sup>H8147</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>; and the door<sup>H6607</sup>, six<sup>H8337</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>; and the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of the door<sup>H6607</sup>, seven<sup>H7651</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 4 So he measured<sup>H4058</sup> the length<sup>H753</sup> thereof, twenty<sup>H6242</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>; and the breadth<sup>H7341</sup>, twenty<sup>H6242</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, before<sup>H6440</sup> the temple<sup>H1964</sup>: and he said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, This is the most<sup>H6944</sup> holy<sup>H6944</sup> place. 5 After he measured<sup>H4058</sup> the wall<sup>H7023</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup>, six<sup>H8337</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>; and the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of every side chamber<sup>H6763</sup>, four<sup>H702</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, round about<sup>H5439</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> on every side<sup>H5439</sup>. 6 And the side<sup>H6763</sup> chambers<sup>H6763</sup> were three<sup>H7969</sup>, one over another<sup>H6763</sup>, and thirty<sup>H7970</sup> in order<sup>H6471</sup>; and they entered<sup>H935</sup> into the wall<sup>H7023</sup> which was of the house<sup>H1004</sup> for the side chambers<sup>H6763</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>, that they might have hold<sup>H270</sup>, but they had not hold<sup>H270</sup> in the wall<sup>H7023</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup>. 7 And there was an enlarging<sup>H7337</sup>, and a winding about<sup>H5437</sup> still upward<sup>H4605</sup> to the side chambers<sup>H6763</sup>: for the winding about<sup>H4141</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> went still upward<sup>H4605</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup>: therefore the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> was still upward<sup>H4605</sup>, and so increased<sup>H5927</sup> from the lowest<sup>H8481</sup> chamber to the highest<sup>H5945</sup> by the midst<sup>H8484</sup>. 8 I saw<sup>H7200</sup> also the height<sup>H1363</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>: the foundations<sup>H4328</sup> of the side chambers<sup>H6763</sup> were a full<sup>H4393</sup> reed<sup>H7070</sup> of six<sup>H8337</sup> great<sup>H679</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 9 The thickness<sup>H7341</sup> of the wall<sup>H7023</sup>, which was for the side chamber<sup>H6763</sup> without<sup>H2351</sup>, was five<sup>H2568</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>: and that which was left<sup>H3240</sup> was the place<sup>H1004</sup> of the side chambers<sup>H6763</sup> that were within<sup>H1004</sup>. 10 And between the chambers<sup>H3957</sup> was the wideness<sup>H7341</sup> of twenty<sup>H6242</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> on every side<sup>H5439</sup>. 11 And the doors<sup>H6607</sup> of the side chambers<sup>H6763</sup> were toward the place that was left<sup>H3240</sup>, one door<sup>H6607</sup> toward<sup>H1870</sup> the north<sup>H6828</sup>, and another<sup>H259</sup> door<sup>H6607</sup> toward the south<sup>H1864</sup>: and the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of the place<sup>H4725</sup> that was left<sup>H3240</sup> was five<sup>H2568</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>.

12 Now the building<sup>H1146</sup> that was before<sup>H6440</sup> the separate place<sup>H1508</sup> at the end<sup>H6285</sup> toward<sup>H1870</sup> the west<sup>H3220</sup> was seventy<sup>H7657</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> broad<sup>H7341</sup>; and the wall<sup>H7023</sup> of the building<sup>H1146</sup> was five<sup>H2568</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> thick<sup>H7341</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>, and the length<sup>H753</sup> thereof ninety<sup>H8673</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 13 So he measured<sup>H4058</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup>, an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> long<sup>H753</sup>; and the separate place<sup>H1508</sup>, and the building<sup>H1140</sup>, with the walls<sup>H7023</sup> thereof, an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> long<sup>H753</sup>. 14 Also the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup>, and of the separate place<sup>H1508</sup> toward the east<sup>H6921</sup>, an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 15 And he measured<sup>H4058</sup> the length<sup>H753</sup> of the building<sup>H1146</sup> over against<sup>H6440</sup> the separate place<sup>H1508</sup> which was behind<sup>H310</sup> it, and the galleries<sup>H862</sup> thereof on the one side and on the other side, an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, with the inner<sup>H6442</sup> temple<sup>H1964</sup>, and the porches<sup>H197</sup> of the court<sup>H2691</sup>. 16 The door posts<sup>H5592</sup>, and the narrow<sup>H331</sup> windows<sup>H2474</sup>, and the galleries<sup>H862</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> on their three stories<sup>H7969</sup>, over against<sup>H5048</sup> the door<sup>H5592</sup>, cieled<sup>H7824</sup> with wood<sup>H6086</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>, and from the ground<sup>H776</sup> up to the windows<sup>H2474</sup>, and the windows<sup>H2474</sup> were covered<sup>H3680,78</sup>. 17 To that above the door<sup>H6607</sup>, even unto the inner<sup>H6442</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and without<sup>H2351</sup>, and by all the wall<sup>H7023</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> within<sup>H6442</sup> and without<sup>H2435</sup>, by measure<sup>H4060</sup>. 18 And it was made<sup>H6213</sup> with cherubims<sup>H3742</sup> and palm trees<sup>H8561</sup>, so that a palm tree<sup>H8561</sup> was between a cherub<sup>H3742</sup> and a cherub<sup>H3742</sup>; and every cherub<sup>H3742</sup> had two<sup>H8147</sup> faces<sup>H6440</sup>. 19 So that the face<sup>H6440</sup> of a man<sup>H120</sup> was toward the palm tree<sup>H8561</sup> on the one side, and the face<sup>H6440</sup> of a young lion<sup>H3715</sup> toward the palm tree<sup>H8561</sup> on the other side: it was made<sup>H6213</sup> through all the house<sup>H1004</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>. 20 From the ground<sup>H776</sup> unto above the door<sup>H6607</sup> were cherubims<sup>H3742</sup> and palm trees<sup>H8561</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup>, and on the wall<sup>H7023</sup> of the temple<sup>H1964</sup>. 21 The posts<sup>H4201</sup> of the temple<sup>H1964</sup> were squared<sup>H7251</sup>, and the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the sanctuary<sup>H6944</sup>; the appearance<sup>H4758</sup> of the one as the

appearance<sup>H4758</sup> of the other.<sup>10</sup> **22** The altar<sup>H4196</sup> of wood<sup>H6086</sup> was three<sup>H7969</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup> high<sup>H1364</sup>, and the length<sup>H753</sup> thereof two<sup>H8147</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>; and the corners<sup>H4740</sup> thereof, and the length<sup>H753</sup> thereof, and the walls<sup>H7023</sup> thereof, were of wood<sup>H6086</sup>; and he said<sup>H1696</sup> unto me, This is the table<sup>H7979</sup> that is before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **23** And the temple<sup>H1964</sup> and the sanctuary<sup>H6944</sup> had two<sup>H8147</sup> doors<sup>H1817</sup>. **24** And the doors<sup>H1817</sup> had two<sup>H8147</sup> leaves<sup>H1817</sup> apiece, two<sup>H8147</sup> turning<sup>H4142</sup> leaves<sup>H1817</sup>; two<sup>H8147</sup> leaves for the one<sup>H259</sup> door<sup>H1817</sup>, and two<sup>H8147</sup> leaves<sup>H1817</sup> for the other<sup>H312</sup> door. **25** And there were made<sup>H6213</sup> on them, on the doors<sup>H1817</sup> of the temple<sup>H1964</sup>, cherubims<sup>H3742</sup> and palm trees<sup>H8561</sup>, like as were made<sup>H6213</sup> upon the walls<sup>H7023</sup>; and there were thick<sup>H5646</sup> planks<sup>H6086</sup> upon the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the porch<sup>H197</sup> without<sup>H2351</sup>. **26** And there were narrow<sup>H331</sup> windows<sup>H2474</sup> and palm trees<sup>H8561</sup> on the one side and on the other side, on the sides<sup>H3802</sup> of the porch<sup>H197</sup>, and upon the side chambers<sup>H6763</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup>, and thick planks<sup>H5646</sup>.
