## Ezekiel 6

**1** And the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came unto me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, **2** Son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, set<sup>H7760</sup> thy face<sup>H6440</sup> toward the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> against them, **3** And say<sup>H559</sup>, Ye mountains<sup>H2022</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, hear<sup>H8085</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup> to the mountains<sup>H2022</sup>, and to the hills<sup>H1389</sup>, to the rivers<sup>H650</sup>, and to the valleys<sup>H1516</sup>; Behold, I, even I, will bring<sup>H935</sup> a sword<sup>H2719</sup> upon you, and I will destroy<sup>H6</sup> your high places<sup>H1116</sup>. **4** And your altars<sup>H4196</sup> shall be desolate<sup>H8074</sup>, and your images<sup>H2553</sup> shall be broken<sup>H7665</sup>: and I will cast down<sup>H5307</sup> your slain<sup>H2491</sup> men before<sup>H6440</sup> your idols<sup>H1544</sup>.<sup>1</sup> **5** And I will lay<sup>H5414</sup> the dead carcases<sup>H6297</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> their idols<sup>H1544</sup>; and I will scatter<sup>H2219</sup> your bones<sup>H6106</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> your altars<sup>H4196.2</sup> **6** In all your dwellingplaces<sup>H4186</sup> the cities<sup>H5892</sup> shall be laid waste<sup>H2717</sup>, and the high places<sup>H1116</sup> shall be desolate<sup>H865</sup>; that your altars<sup>H4196</sup> may be laid waste<sup>H2717</sup> and made desolate<sup>H816</sup>, and your idols<sup>H1544</sup> may be broken<sup>H7665</sup> and cease<sup>H7673</sup>, and your images<sup>H2553</sup> may be cut down<sup>H1438</sup>, and your works<sup>H4639</sup> may be abolished<sup>H4229</sup>. **7** And the slain<sup>H2491</sup> shall fall<sup>H5307</sup> in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of you, and ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

**8** Yet will I leave a remnant<sup>H3498</sup>, that ye may have some that shall escape<sup>H6412</sup> the sword<sup>H2719</sup> among the nations<sup>H1471</sup>, when ye shall be scattered<sup>H2219</sup> through the countries<sup>H776</sup>. **9** And they that escape<sup>H6412</sup> of you shall remember<sup>H2142</sup> me among the nations<sup>H1471</sup> whither they shall be carried captives<sup>H7617</sup>, because I am broken<sup>H7665</sup> with their whorish<sup>H2181</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup>, which hath departed<sup>H5493</sup> from me, and with their eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, which go a whoring<sup>H2181</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> their idols<sup>H1544</sup>: and they shall lothe<sup>H6962</sup> themselves<sup>H6440</sup> for the evils<sup>H7451</sup> which they have committed<sup>H6213</sup> in all their abominations<sup>H8441</sup>. **10** And they shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and that I have not said<sup>H1696</sup> in vain<sup>H2600</sup> that I would do<sup>H6213</sup> this evil<sup>H7451</sup> unto them.

**11** Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Smite<sup>H521</sup> with thine hand<sup>H3709</sup>, and stamp<sup>H754</sup> with thy foot<sup>H7272</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup>, Alas<sup>H253</sup> for all the evil<sup>H7451</sup> abominations<sup>H8441</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>! for they shall fall<sup>H5307</sup> by the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, by the famine<sup>H7458</sup>, and by the pestilence<sup>H1698</sup>. **12** He that is far off<sup>H7350</sup> shall die<sup>H4191</sup> of the pestilence<sup>H1698</sup>; and he that is near<sup>H7138</sup> shall fall<sup>H5307</sup> by the sword<sup>H2719</sup>; and he that remaineth<sup>H7604</sup> and is besieged<sup>H5341</sup> shall die<sup>H4191</sup> by the famine<sup>H7458</sup>: thus will I accomplish<sup>H3615</sup> my fury<sup>H2534</sup> upon them. **13** Then shall ye know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, when their slain<sup>H2491</sup> men shall be among<sup>H8432</sup> their idols<sup>H1544</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> their altars<sup>H4196</sup>, upon every high<sup>H7311</sup> hill<sup>H1389</sup>, in all the tops<sup>H7218</sup> of the mountains<sup>H2022</sup>, and under every green<sup>H7488</sup> tree<sup>H6086</sup>, and under every thick<sup>H5687</sup> oak<sup>H424</sup>, the place<sup>H4725</sup> where they did offer<sup>H5414</sup> sweet<sup>H5207</sup> savour<sup>H7381</sup> to all their idols<sup>H1544</sup>. **14** So will I stretch out<sup>H5186</sup> my hand<sup>H3027</sup> upon them, and make<sup>H5414</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup> desolate<sup>H8077</sup>, yea, more desolate<sup>H4923</sup> than the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> toward Diblath<sup>H1689</sup>, in all their habitations<sup>H4186</sup>: and they shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068.3</sup>
