## Genesis 35

**1** And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, Arise<sup>H6965</sup>, go up<sup>H5927</sup> to Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> there: and make<sup>H6213</sup> there an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto God<sup>H410</sup>, that appeared<sup>H7200</sup> unto thee when thou fleddest<sup>H1272</sup> from the face<sup>H6440</sup> of Esau<sup>H6215</sup> thy brother<sup>H251</sup>. **2** Then Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto his household<sup>H1004</sup>, and to all that were with him, Put away<sup>H5493</sup> the strange<sup>H5236</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup> that are among you<sup>H8432</sup>, and be clean<sup>H2891</sup>, and change<sup>H2498</sup> your garments<sup>H8071</sup>: **3** And let us arise<sup>H6965</sup>, and go up<sup>H5927</sup> to Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>; and I will make<sup>H6213</sup> there an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto God<sup>H410</sup>, who answered<sup>H6030</sup> me in the day<sup>H3117</sup> of my distress<sup>H6869</sup>, and was with me in the way<sup>H1870</sup> which I went<sup>H1980</sup>. **4** And they gave<sup>H5414</sup> unto Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> all the strange<sup>H5236</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup> which were in their hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and all their earrings<sup>H5141</sup> which were in their ears<sup>H241</sup>; and Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> hid<sup>H2934</sup> them under the oak<sup>H424</sup> which was by Shechem<sup>H7927</sup>. **5** And they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>: and the terror<sup>H2847</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> was upon the cities<sup>H5892</sup> that were round about<sup>H5439</sup> them, and they did not pursue<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>.

**6** So Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Luz<sup>H3870</sup>, which is in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Canaan<sup>H3667</sup>, that is, Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>, he and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were with him. **7** And he built<sup>H1129</sup> there an altar<sup>H4196</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> the place<sup>H4725</sup> Elbethel<sup>H416</sup>: because there God<sup>H430</sup> appeared<sup>H1540</sup> unto him, when he fled<sup>H1272</sup> from the face<sup>H6440</sup> of his brother<sup>H251.1</sup> **8** But Deborah<sup>H1683</sup> Rebekah's<sup>H7259</sup> nurse<sup>H3243</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup>, and she was buried<sup>H6912</sup> beneath Bethel<sup>H1008</sup> under an oak<sup>H437</sup>: and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of it was called<sup>H7121</sup> Allonbachuth<sup>H439.2</sup> **9** And God<sup>H430</sup> appeared<sup>H7200</sup> unto Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> again, when he came<sup>H935</sup> out of Padanaram<sup>H6307</sup>, and blessed<sup>H1288</sup> him. **10** And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Thy name<sup>H8034</sup> is Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>: thy name<sup>H8034</sup> shall not be called<sup>H7121</sup> any more Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, but Israel<sup>H3478</sup> shall be thy name<sup>H8034</sup>: and he called<sup>H7121</sup> his name<sup>H8034</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **11** And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, I am God<sup>H410</sup> Almighty<sup>H7706</sup>: be fruitful<sup>H6509</sup> and multiply<sup>H7235</sup>; a nation<sup>H1471</sup> and a company<sup>H6951</sup> of nations<sup>H1471</sup> shall be of thee, and kings<sup>H4428</sup> shall come<sup>H3318</sup> out of thy loins<sup>H2504</sup>; **12** And the land<sup>H776</sup> which I gave<sup>H5114</sup> Abraham<sup>H85</sup> and Isaac<sup>H327</sup>, to thee I will give it<sup>H5114</sup>, and to thy seed<sup>H2233</sup> after thee<sup>H310</sup> will I give<sup>H5141</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>. **13** And God<sup>H430</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> from him in the place<sup>H4725</sup> where he talked<sup>H1696</sup> with him, even a pillar<sup>H4678</sup> of stone<sup>H68</sup>: and he poured<sup>H5258</sup> a drink offering<sup>H5262</sup> thereon, and he poured<sup>H3332</sup> oil<sup>H8081</sup> thereon. **15** And Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the place<sup>H4725</sup> where God<sup>H430</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> with him, Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>.

**16** And they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup> from Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>; and there was but<sup>H5750</sup> a little<sup>H3530</sup> way<sup>H776</sup> to come<sup>H935</sup> to Ephrath<sup>H672</sup>: and Rachel<sup>H7354</sup> travailed<sup>H3205</sup>, and she had hard<sup>H7185</sup> labour<sup>H3205,3</sup> **17** And it came to pass, when she was in hard<sup>H7185</sup> labour<sup>H3205</sup>, that the midwife<sup>H3205</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto her, Fear<sup>H3372</sup> not; thou shalt have this son<sup>H1121</sup> also. **18** And it came to pass, as her soul<sup>H5315</sup> was in departing<sup>H3318</sup>, (for she died<sup>H4191</sup>) that she called<sup>H7121</sup> his name<sup>H8034</sup> Benoni<sup>H1126</sup>: but his father<sup>H1</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> him Benjamin<sup>H1144,45</sup> **19** And Rachel<sup>H7354</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> to Ephrath<sup>H672</sup>, which is Bethlehem<sup>H1035</sup>. **20** And Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> set<sup>H5324</sup> a pillar<sup>H4676</sup> upon her grave<sup>H6900</sup>: that is the pillar<sup>H4678</sup> of Rachel's<sup>H7354</sup> grave<sup>H6900</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>.

**21** And Israel<sup>H3478</sup> journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>, and spread<sup>H5186</sup> his tent<sup>H168</sup> beyond<sup>H1973</sup> the tower<sup>H4026</sup> of Edar<sup>H4029</sup>. **22** And it came to pass, when Israel<sup>H3478</sup> dwelt<sup>H7931</sup> in that land<sup>H776</sup>, that Reuben<sup>H7205</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> and lay<sup>H7901</sup> with Bilhah<sup>H1090</sup> his father's<sup>H1</sup> concubine<sup>H6370</sup>: and Israel<sup>H3478</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> it. Now the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> were twelve<sup>H8147 H6240</sup>: **23** The sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Leah<sup>H3812</sup>; Reuben<sup>H7205</sup>, Jacob's<sup>H3290</sup> firstborn<sup>H1060</sup>, and Simeon<sup>H8095</sup>, and Levi<sup>H3878</sup>, and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and Issachar<sup>H3485</sup>, and Zebulun<sup>H2074</sup>: **24** The sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Rachel<sup>H7354</sup>; Joseph<sup>H3130</sup>, and Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup>: **25** And the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Bilhah<sup>H1090</sup>, Rachel's<sup>H7354</sup> handmaid<sup>H8198</sup>; Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, and Naphtali<sup>H5321</sup>: **26** And the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Zilpah<sup>H2153</sup>, Leah's<sup>H3812</sup> handmaid<sup>H8198</sup>; Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, and Asher<sup>H836</sup>: these are the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, which were born<sup>H3205</sup> to him in Padanaram<sup>H6307</sup>. **27** And Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> unto Isaac<sup>H3327</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup> unto Mamre<sup>H4471</sup>, unto the city of

Arbah<sup>H7153</sup>, which is Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>, where Abraham<sup>H85</sup> and Isaac<sup>H3327</sup> sojourned<sup>H1481</sup>. **28** And the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Isaac<sup>H3327</sup> were an hundred<sup>H3967 H8141</sup> and fourscore<sup>H8084</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. **29** And Isaac<sup>H3327</sup> gave up the ghost<sup>H1478</sup>, and died<sup>H4191</sup>, and was gathered<sup>H622</sup> unto his people<sup>H5971</sup>, being old<sup>H2205</sup> and full<sup>H7649</sup> of days<sup>H3117</sup>: and his sons<sup>H1121</sup> Esau<sup>H6215</sup> and Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> buried<sup>H6912</sup> him.
