**8** Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> shall say, What have I to do any more with idols<sup>H6091</sup>? I have heard<sup>H6030</sup> him, and observed<sup>H7789</sup> him: I am like a green<sup>H7488</sup> fir tree<sup>H1265</sup>. From me is thy fruit<sup>H6529</sup> found<sup>H4672</sup>. **9** Who is wise<sup>H2450</sup>, and he shall understand<sup>H995</sup> these things? prudent<sup>H995</sup>, and he shall know<sup>H3045</sup> them? for the ways<sup>H1870</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> are right<sup>H3477</sup>, and the just<sup>H6662</sup> shall walk<sup>H3212</sup> in them: but the transgressors<sup>H6586</sup> shall fall<sup>H3782</sup> therein.
