

# Hosea 8

1 Set the trumpet<sup>H7782</sup> to thy mouth<sup>H2441</sup>. He shall come as an eagle<sup>H5404</sup> against the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, because they have transgressed<sup>H5674</sup> my covenant<sup>H1285</sup>, and trespassed<sup>H6586</sup> against my law<sup>H8451</sup>. 1 2 Israel<sup>H3478</sup> shall cry<sup>H2199</sup> unto me, My God<sup>H430</sup>, we know<sup>H3045</sup> thee. 3 Israel<sup>H3478</sup> hath cast off<sup>H2186</sup> the thing that is good<sup>H2896</sup>: the enemy<sup>H341</sup> shall pursue<sup>H7291</sup> him. 4 They have set up kings<sup>H4427</sup>, but not by me: they have made princes<sup>H7786</sup>, and I knew<sup>H3045</sup> it not: of their silver<sup>H3701</sup> and their gold<sup>H2091</sup> have they made<sup>H6213</sup> them idols<sup>H6091</sup>, that they may be cut off<sup>H3772</sup>. 5 Thy calf<sup>H5695</sup>, O Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, hath cast<sup>H2186</sup> thee off; mine anger<sup>H639</sup> is kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against them: how long will it be ere<sup>H3808</sup> they attain<sup>H3201</sup> to innocency<sup>H5356</sup>? 6 For from Israel<sup>H3478</sup> was it also: the workman<sup>H2796</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> it; therefore it is not God<sup>H430</sup>: but the calf<sup>H5695</sup> of Samaria<sup>H8111</sup> shall be broken in pieces<sup>H7616</sup>. 7 For they have sown<sup>H2232</sup> the wind<sup>H7307</sup>, and they shall reap<sup>H7114</sup> the whirlwind<sup>H5492</sup>: it hath no stalk<sup>H7054</sup>: the bud<sup>H6780</sup> shall yield<sup>H6213</sup> no meal<sup>H7058</sup>: if<sup>H194</sup> so be it yield<sup>H6213</sup>, the strangers<sup>H2114</sup> shall swallow it up<sup>H1104</sup>. 2

8 Israel<sup>H3478</sup> is swallowed up<sup>H1104</sup>: now shall they be among the Gentiles<sup>H1471</sup> as a vessel<sup>H3627</sup> wherein is no pleasure<sup>H2656</sup>. 9 For they are gone up<sup>H5927</sup> to Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, a wild ass<sup>H6501</sup> alone<sup>H909</sup> by himself: Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> hath hired<sup>H8566</sup> lovers<sup>H158</sup>. 3 10 Yea, though they have hired<sup>H8566</sup> among the nations<sup>H1471</sup>, now will I gather<sup>H6908</sup> them, and they shall sorrow<sup>H2490</sup> a little<sup>H4592</sup> for the burden<sup>H4853</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of princes<sup>H8269</sup>. 45 11 Because Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> hath made many<sup>H7235</sup> altars<sup>H4196</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>, altars<sup>H4196</sup> shall be unto him to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. 12 I have written<sup>H3789</sup> to him the great things<sup>H7230</sup> of my law<sup>H8451</sup>, but they were counted<sup>H2803</sup> as a strange thing<sup>H2114</sup>. 13 They sacrifice<sup>H2076</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup> for the sacrifices<sup>H2077</sup> of mine offerings<sup>H1890</sup>, and eat<sup>H398</sup> it; but the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> accepteth<sup>H7521</sup> them not; now will he remember<sup>H2142</sup> their iniquity<sup>H5771</sup>, and visit<sup>H6485</sup> their sins<sup>H2403</sup>: they shall return<sup>H7725</sup> to Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 6 14 For Israel<sup>H3478</sup> hath forgotten<sup>H7911</sup> his Maker<sup>H6213</sup>, and buildeth<sup>H1129</sup> temples<sup>H1964</sup>, and Judah<sup>H3063</sup> hath multiplied<sup>H7235</sup> fenced<sup>H1219</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup>: but I will send<sup>H7971</sup> a fire<sup>H784</sup> upon his cities<sup>H5892</sup>, and it shall devour<sup>H398</sup> the palaces<sup>H759</sup> thereof.
