

# Isaiah 4

1 And in that day<sup>H3117</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> women<sup>H802</sup> shall take hold<sup>H2388</sup> of one<sup>H259</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, We will eat<sup>H398</sup> our own bread<sup>H3899</sup>, and wear<sup>H3847</sup> our own apparel<sup>H8071</sup>: only let us be called<sup>H7121</sup> by thy name<sup>H8034</sup>, to take away<sup>H622</sup> our reproach<sup>H2781</sup>.<sup>12</sup>

2 In that day<sup>H3117</sup> shall the branch<sup>H6780</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> be beautiful<sup>H6643</sup> and glorious<sup>H3519</sup>, and the fruit<sup>H6529</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> shall be excellent<sup>H1347</sup> and comely for<sup>H8597</sup> them that are escaped<sup>H6413</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.<sup>34</sup> 3 And it shall come to pass, that he that is left<sup>H7604</sup> in Zion<sup>H6726</sup>, and he that remaineth<sup>H3498</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, shall be called<sup>H559</sup> holy<sup>H6918</sup>, even every one that is written<sup>H3789</sup> among the living<sup>H2416</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 4 When the Lord<sup>H136</sup> shall have washed away<sup>H7364</sup> the filth<sup>H6675</sup> of the daughters<sup>H1323</sup> of Zion<sup>H6726</sup>, and shall have purged<sup>H1740</sup> the blood<sup>H1818</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> from the midst<sup>H7130</sup> thereof by the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of judgment<sup>H4941</sup>, and by the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of burning<sup>H1197</sup>. 5 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will create<sup>H1254</sup> upon every dwelling place<sup>H4349</sup> of mount<sup>H2022</sup> Zion<sup>H6726</sup>, and upon her assemblies<sup>H4744</sup>, a cloud<sup>H6051</sup> and smoke<sup>H6227</sup> by day<sup>H3119</sup>, and the shining<sup>H5051</sup> of a flaming<sup>H3852</sup> fire<sup>H784</sup> by night<sup>H3915</sup>: for upon all the glory<sup>H3519</sup> shall be a defence<sup>H2646</sup>.<sup>67</sup> 6 And there shall be a tabernacle<sup>H5521</sup> for a shadow<sup>H6738</sup> in the daytime<sup>H3119</sup> from the heat<sup>H2721</sup>, and for a place of refuge<sup>H4268</sup>, and for a covert<sup>H4563</sup> from storm<sup>H2230</sup> and from rain<sup>H4306</sup>.
