

# Isaiah 48



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

**1** Hear<sup>H8085</sup> ye this, O house<sup>H1004</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, which are called<sup>H7121</sup> by the name<sup>H8034</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and are come forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the waters<sup>H4325</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, which swear<sup>H7650</sup> by the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and make mention<sup>H2142</sup> of the God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, but not in truth<sup>H571</sup>, nor in righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>. **2** For they call<sup>H7121</sup> themselves of the holy<sup>H6944</sup> city<sup>H5892</sup>, and stay<sup>H5564</sup> themselves upon the God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup> is his name<sup>H8034</sup>. **3** I have declared<sup>H5046</sup> the former things<sup>H7223</sup> from the beginning<sup>H227</sup>; and they went forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of my mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, and I shewed<sup>H8085</sup> them; I did<sup>H6213</sup> them suddenly<sup>H6597</sup>, and they came to pass<sup>H935</sup>. **4** Because I knew<sup>H1847</sup> that thou art obstinate<sup>H7186</sup>, and thy neck<sup>H6203</sup> is an iron<sup>H1270</sup> sinew<sup>H1517</sup>, and thy brow<sup>H4696</sup> brass<sup>H5154.1</sup>; **5** I have even from the beginning<sup>H227</sup> declared<sup>H5046</sup> it to thee; before it came to pass<sup>H935</sup> I shewed<sup>H8085</sup> it thee: lest thou shouldest say<sup>H559</sup>, Mine idol<sup>H6090</sup> hath done<sup>H6213</sup> them, and my graven image<sup>H6459</sup>, and my molten image<sup>H5262</sup>, hath commanded<sup>H6680</sup> them. **6** Thou hast heard<sup>H8085</sup>, see<sup>H2372</sup> all this; and will not ye declare<sup>H5046</sup> it? I have shewed<sup>H8085</sup> thee new things<sup>H2319</sup> from this time<sup>H6258</sup>, even hidden things<sup>H5341</sup>, and thou didst not know<sup>H3045</sup> them. **7** They are created<sup>H1254</sup> now, and not from the beginning; even before<sup>H6440</sup> the day<sup>H3117</sup> when thou heardest<sup>H8085</sup> them not; lest thou shouldest say<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, I knew<sup>H3045</sup> them. **8** Yea, thou heardest<sup>H8085</sup> not; yea, thou knewest<sup>H3045</sup> not; yea, from that time that thine ear<sup>H241</sup> was not opened<sup>H6605</sup>: for I knew<sup>H3045</sup> that thou wouldest deal very<sup>H898</sup> treacherously<sup>H898</sup>, and wast called<sup>H7121</sup> a transgressor<sup>H6586</sup> from the womb<sup>H990</sup>.

**9** For my name's<sup>H8034</sup> sake will I defer<sup>H748</sup> mine anger<sup>H639</sup>, and for my praise<sup>H8416</sup> will I refrain<sup>H2413</sup> for thee, that I cut thee not off<sup>H3772</sup>. **10** Behold, I have refined<sup>H6884</sup> thee, but not with silver<sup>H3701</sup>; I have chosen<sup>H977</sup> thee in the furnace<sup>H3564</sup> of affliction<sup>H6040.2</sup>. **11** For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do<sup>H6213</sup> it: for how should my name be polluted<sup>H2490</sup>? and I will not give<sup>H5414</sup> my glory<sup>H3519</sup> unto another<sup>H312</sup>. **12** Harken<sup>H8085</sup> unto me, O Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> and Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, my called<sup>H7121</sup>; I am he; I am the first<sup>H7223</sup>, I also am the last<sup>H314</sup>. **13** Mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> also hath laid the foundation<sup>H3245</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and my right hand<sup>H3225</sup> hath spanned<sup>H2946</sup> the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>: when I call<sup>H7121</sup> unto them, they stand up<sup>H5975</sup> together<sup>H3162.3</sup>. **14** All ye, assemble<sup>H6908</sup> yourselves, and hear<sup>H8085</sup>; which among them hath declared<sup>H5046</sup> these things? The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath loved<sup>H157</sup> him: he will do<sup>H6213</sup> his pleasure<sup>H2656</sup> on Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, and his arm<sup>H2220</sup> shall be on the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup>. **15** I, even I, have spoken<sup>H1696</sup>; yea, I have called<sup>H7121</sup> him: I have brought<sup>H935</sup> him, and he shall make his way<sup>H1870</sup> prosperous<sup>H6743</sup>.

**16** Come<sup>H7126</sup> ye near<sup>H7126</sup> unto me, hear<sup>H8085</sup> ye this; I have not spoken<sup>H1696</sup> in secret<sup>H5643</sup> from the beginning<sup>H7218</sup>, from the time<sup>H6256</sup> that it was, there am I: and now the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, and his Spirit<sup>H7307</sup>, hath sent<sup>H7971</sup> me. **17** Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, thy Redeemer<sup>H1350</sup>, the Holy One<sup>H6918</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> which teacheth<sup>H3925</sup> thee to profit<sup>H3276</sup>, which leadeth<sup>H1869</sup> thee by the way<sup>H1870</sup> that thou shouldest go<sup>H3212</sup>. **18** O that<sup>H3863</sup> thou hadst hearkened<sup>H7181</sup> to my commandments<sup>H4687</sup>! then had thy peace<sup>H7965</sup> been as a river<sup>H5104</sup>, and thy righteousness<sup>H6666</sup> as the waves<sup>H1530</sup> of the sea<sup>H3220</sup>. **19** Thy seed<sup>H2233</sup> also had been as the sand<sup>H2344</sup>, and the offspring<sup>H6631</sup> of thy bowels<sup>H4578</sup> like the gravel<sup>H4579</sup> thereof; his name<sup>H8034</sup> should not have been cut off<sup>H3772</sup> nor destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> from before<sup>H6440</sup> me. **20** Go ye forth<sup>H3318</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, flee<sup>H1272</sup> ye from the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup>, with a voice<sup>H6963</sup> of singing<sup>H7440</sup> declare<sup>H5046</sup> ye, tell<sup>H8085</sup> this, utter<sup>H3318</sup> it even to the end<sup>H7097</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>; say<sup>H559</sup> ye, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath redeemed<sup>H1350</sup> his servant<sup>H5650</sup> Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>. **21** And they thirsted<sup>H6770</sup> not when he led<sup>H3212</sup> them through the deserts<sup>H2723</sup>: he caused the waters<sup>H4325</sup> to flow<sup>H5140</sup> out of the rock<sup>H6697</sup> for them: he clave<sup>H1234</sup> the rock<sup>H6697</sup> also, and the waters<sup>H4325</sup> gushed out<sup>H2100</sup>. **22** There is no peace<sup>H7965</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, unto the wicked<sup>H7563</sup>.
