

# Jeremiah 26



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 In the beginning<sup>H7225</sup> of the reign<sup>H4468</sup> of Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Josiah<sup>H2977</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> came this word<sup>H1697</sup> from the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Stand<sup>H5975</sup> in the court<sup>H2691</sup> of the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto all the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, which come<sup>H935</sup> to worship<sup>H7812</sup> in the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, all the words<sup>H1697</sup> that I command<sup>H6680</sup> thee to speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto them; diminish<sup>H1639</sup> not a word<sup>H1697</sup>: 3 If so be they will hearken<sup>H8085</sup>, and turn<sup>H7725</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> from his evil<sup>H7451</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>, that I may repent<sup>H5162</sup> me of the evil<sup>H7451</sup>, which I purpose<sup>H2803</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> unto them because<sup>H6440</sup> of the evil<sup>H7455</sup> of their doings<sup>H4611</sup>. 4 And thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; If ye will not hearken<sup>H8085</sup> to me, to walk<sup>H3212</sup> in my law<sup>H8451</sup>, which I have set<sup>H5414</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> you, 5 To hearken<sup>H8085</sup> to the words<sup>H1697</sup> of my servants<sup>H5650</sup> the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, whom I sent<sup>H7971</sup> unto you, both rising up early<sup>H7925</sup>, and sending<sup>H7971</sup> them, but ye have not hearkened<sup>H8085</sup>; 6 Then will I make<sup>H5414</sup> this house<sup>H1004</sup> like Shiloh<sup>H7887</sup>, and will make<sup>H5414</sup> this city<sup>H5892</sup> a curse<sup>H7045</sup> to all the nations<sup>H1471</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>.

7 So the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> speaking<sup>H1696</sup> these words<sup>H1697</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 8 Now it came to pass, when Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> had made an end<sup>H3615</sup> of speaking<sup>H1696</sup> all that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had commanded<sup>H6680</sup> him to speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto all the people<sup>H5971</sup>, that the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> took<sup>H8610</sup> him, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Thou shalt surely<sup>H4191</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>. 9 Why hast thou prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> in the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, This house<sup>H1004</sup> shall be like Shiloh<sup>H7887</sup>, and this city<sup>H5892</sup> shall be desolate<sup>H2717</sup> without an inhabitant<sup>H3427</sup>? And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> were gathered<sup>H6950</sup> against Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 10 When the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> these things<sup>H1697</sup>, then they came up<sup>H5927</sup> from the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup> unto the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and sat down<sup>H3427</sup> in the entry<sup>H6607</sup> of the new<sup>H2319</sup> gate<sup>H8179</sup> of the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> house. 11 Then spake<sup>H559</sup> the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> unto the princes<sup>H8269</sup> and to all the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, This man<sup>H376</sup> is worthy<sup>H4941</sup> to die<sup>H4194</sup>; for he hath prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> against this city<sup>H5892</sup>, as ye have heard<sup>H8085</sup> with your ears<sup>H241</sup>. 12 Then spake<sup>H559</sup> Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> unto all the princes<sup>H8269</sup> and to all the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> me to prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> against this house<sup>H1004</sup> and against this city<sup>H5892</sup> all the words<sup>H1697</sup> that ye have heard<sup>H8085</sup>. 13 Therefore now amend<sup>H3190</sup> your ways<sup>H1870</sup> and your doings<sup>H4611</sup>, and obey<sup>H8085</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup>; and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will repent<sup>H5162</sup> him of the evil<sup>H7451</sup> that he hath pronounced<sup>H1696</sup> against you. 14 As for me, behold, I am in your hand<sup>H3027</sup>: do<sup>H6213</sup> with me as seemeth<sup>H5869</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup> and meet<sup>H3477</sup> unto you. 15 But know<sup>H3045</sup> ye for certain<sup>H3045</sup>, that if ye put me to death<sup>H4191</sup>, ye shall surely bring<sup>H5414</sup> innocent<sup>H5355</sup> blood<sup>H1818</sup> upon yourselves, and upon this city<sup>H5892</sup>, and upon the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> thereof: for of a truth<sup>H571</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath sent<sup>H7971</sup> me unto you to speak<sup>H1696</sup> all these words<sup>H1697</sup> in your ears<sup>H241</sup>.

16 Then said<sup>H559</sup> the princes<sup>H8269</sup> and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> unto the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and to the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, This man<sup>H376</sup> is not worthy<sup>H4941</sup> to die<sup>H4194</sup>: for he hath spoken<sup>H1696</sup> to us in the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>. 17 Then rose up<sup>H6965</sup> certain<sup>H582</sup> of the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, and spake<sup>H559</sup> to all the assembly<sup>H6951</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 18 Micah<sup>H4320</sup> the Morasthite<sup>H4183</sup> prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> in the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Hezekiah<sup>H2396</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and spake<sup>H559</sup> to all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>; Zion<sup>H6726</sup> shall be plowed<sup>H2790</sup> like a field<sup>H7704</sup>, and Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> shall become heaps<sup>H5856</sup>, and the mountain<sup>H2022</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> as the high places<sup>H1116</sup> of a forest<sup>H3293</sup>. 19 Did Hezekiah<sup>H2396</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and all Judah<sup>H3063</sup> put him at all<sup>H4191</sup> to death<sup>H4191</sup>? did he not fear<sup>H3373</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and besought<sup>H2470</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> H6440, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> him of the evil<sup>H7451</sup> which he had pronounced<sup>H1696</sup> against them? Thus<sup>H587</sup> might we procure<sup>H6213</sup> great<sup>H1419</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> against our souls<sup>H5315</sup>. 20 And there was also a man<sup>H376</sup> that prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> in the

name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Urijah<sup>H223</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Shemaiah<sup>H8098</sup> of Kirjathjearim<sup>H7157</sup>, who prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> against this city<sup>H5892</sup> and against this land<sup>H776</sup> according to all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup>. **21** And when Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, with all his mighty men<sup>H1368</sup>, and all the princes<sup>H8269</sup>, heard<sup>H8085</sup> his words<sup>H1697</sup>, the king<sup>H4428</sup> sought<sup>H1245</sup> to put him to death<sup>H4191</sup>: but when Urijah<sup>H223</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> it, he was afraid<sup>H3372</sup>, and fled<sup>H1272</sup>, and went<sup>H935</sup> into Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>; **22** And Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> into Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, namely, Elnathan<sup>H494</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Achbor<sup>H5907</sup>, and certain men<sup>H582</sup> with him into Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. **23** And they fetched forth<sup>H3318</sup> Urijah<sup>H223</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, and brought<sup>H935</sup> him unto Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>; who slew<sup>H5221</sup> him with the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and cast<sup>H7993</sup> his dead body<sup>H5038</sup> into the graves<sup>H6913</sup> of the common<sup>H1121</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup>. <sup>5</sup> **24** Nevertheless the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Ahikam<sup>H296</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Shaphan<sup>H8227</sup> was with Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup>, that they should not give<sup>H5414</sup> him into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> to put him to death<sup>H4191</sup>.
