1 Then answered<sup>H6030</sup> Bildad<sup>H1085</sup> the Shuhite<sup>H7747</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, 2 How long<sup>H5704</sup> will it be ere ye make<sup>H7760</sup> an end<sup>H7078</sup> of words<sup>H4405</sup>? mark<sup>H995</sup>, and afterwards<sup>H310</sup> we will speak<sup>H1696</sup>. 3 Wherefore are we counted<sup>H2803</sup> as beasts<sup>H929</sup>, and reputed vile<sup>H2933</sup> in your sight<sup>H5869</sup>? 4 He teareth<sup>H2963</sup> himself<sup>H5315</sup> in his anger<sup>H639</sup>: shall the earth<sup>H776</sup> be forsaken<sup>H5800</sup> for thee? and shall the rock<sup>H6697</sup> be removed<sup>H6275</sup> out of his place<sup>H4725</sup>?<sup>1</sup>

5 Yea, the light<sup>H216</sup> of the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> shall be put out<sup>H1846</sup>, and the spark<sup>H7632</sup> of his fire<sup>H784</sup> shall not shine<sup>H5050</sup>. 6 The light<sup>H216</sup> shall be dark<sup>H2821</sup> in his tabernacle<sup>H168</sup>, and his candle<sup>H5216</sup> shall be put out<sup>H1846</sup> with him.<sup>2</sup> 7 The steps<sup>H6806</sup> of his strength<sup>H202</sup> shall be straitened<sup>H3334</sup>, and his own counsel<sup>H6098</sup> shall cast him down<sup>H7993</sup>. 8 For he is cast<sup>H7971</sup> into a net<sup>H7568</sup> by his own feet<sup>H7272</sup>, and he walketh<sup>H1980</sup> upon a snare<sup>H7639</sup>. 9 The gin<sup>H6341</sup> shall take<sup>H270</sup> him by the heel<sup>H6119</sup>, and the robber<sup>H6782</sup> shall prevail<sup>H2388</sup> against him. 10 The snare<sup>H2256</sup> is laid<sup>H2934</sup> for him in the ground<sup>H776</sup>, and a trap<sup>H4434</sup> for him in the way<sup>H5410</sup>.<sup>3</sup>

11 Terrors<sup>H1091</sup> shall make him afraid<sup>H1204</sup> on every side<sup>H5439</sup>, and shall drive<sup>H6327</sup> him to his feet<sup>H7272</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 12 His strength<sup>H202</sup> shall be hungerbitten<sup>H7457</sup>, and destruction<sup>H343</sup> shall be ready<sup>H3559</sup> at his side<sup>H6763</sup>. 13 It shall devour<sup>H398</sup> the strength<sup>H905</sup> of his skin<sup>H5785</sup>: even the firstborn<sup>H1060</sup> of death<sup>H4194</sup> shall devour<sup>H398</sup> his strength<sup>H905</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 14 His confidence<sup>H4009</sup> shall be rooted out<sup>H5423</sup> of his tabernacle<sup>H168</sup>, and it shall bring<sup>H6805</sup> him to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of terrors<sup>H1091</sup>. 15 It shall dwell<sup>H7931</sup> in his tabernacle<sup>H168</sup>, because it is none<sup>H1097</sup> of his: brimstone<sup>H1614</sup> shall be scattered<sup>H2219</sup> upon his habitation<sup>H5116</sup>. 16 His roots<sup>H8328</sup> shall be dried up<sup>H3001</sup> beneath, and above<sup>H4605</sup> shall his branch<sup>H7105</sup> be cut off<sup>H5243</sup>. 17 His remembrance<sup>H2143</sup> shall perish<sup>H6</sup> from the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and he shall have no name<sup>H8034</sup> in the street<sup>H6440</sup>.<sup>6</sup> 18 He shall be driven<sup>H1920</sup> from light<sup>H216</sup> into darkness<sup>H2822</sup>, and chased<sup>H5074</sup> out of the world<sup>H8398</sup>.<sup>6</sup> 19 He shall neither have son<sup>H5209</sup> nor nephew<sup>H5220</sup> among his people<sup>H5971</sup>, nor any remaining<sup>H8300</sup> in his dwellings<sup>H4033</sup>. 20 They that come after<sup>H314</sup> him shall be astonished<sup>H8074</sup> at his day<sup>H3117</sup>, as they that went before<sup>H6931</sup> were affrighted<sup>H270</sup>.<sup>7</sup> 21 Surely such are the dwellings<sup>H4908</sup> of the wicked<sup>H5767</sup>, and this is the place<sup>H4725</sup> of him that knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> not God<sup>H410</sup>.
