**5** Dead<sup>H7496</sup> things are formed<sup>H2342</sup> from under the waters<sup>H4325</sup>, and the inhabitants<sup>H7931</sup> thereof.<sup>1</sup> **6** Hell<sup>H7585</sup> is naked<sup>H6174</sup> before him, and destruction<sup>H11</sup> hath no covering<sup>H3682</sup>. **7** He stretcheth out<sup>H5186</sup> the north<sup>H6828</sup> over the empty place<sup>H8414</sup>, and hangeth<sup>H8518</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup> upon nothing<sup>H1099</sup>. **8** He bindeth up<sup>H6887</sup> the waters<sup>H4325</sup> in his thick clouds<sup>H5645</sup>; and the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> is not rent<sup>H1234</sup> under them. **9** He holdeth back<sup>H270</sup> the face<sup>H6440</sup> of his throne<sup>H3678</sup>, and spreadeth<sup>H6576</sup> his cloud<sup>H6051</sup> upon it. **10** He hath compassed<sup>H2328</sup> the waters<sup>H6440</sup> H4325 with bounds<sup>H2706</sup>, until the day<sup>H216</sup> and night<sup>H2822</sup> come to an end<sup>H8503.2</sup> **11** The pillars<sup>H5982</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup> tremble<sup>H7322</sup> and are astonished<sup>H8539</sup> at his reproof<sup>H1606</sup>. **12** He divideth<sup>H7280</sup> the sea<sup>H3220</sup> with his power<sup>H3581</sup>, and by his understanding<sup>H8394</sup> H8394 he smiteth<sup>H4272</sup> through the proud<sup>H7293.3</sup> **13** By his spirit<sup>H7307</sup> he hath garnished<sup>H8235</sup> the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>; his hand<sup>H3027</sup> hath formed<sup>H2342</sup> the crooked<sup>H1281</sup> serpent<sup>H5175</sup>. **14** Lo, these are parts<sup>H7098</sup> of his ways<sup>H1870</sup>: but how little<sup>H8102</sup> a portion<sup>H1697</sup> is heard<sup>H8085</sup> of him? but the thunder<sup>H7482</sup> of his power<sup>H1369</sup> who can understand<sup>H995</sup>?
