



1 And it came to pass, when all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the Amorites<sup>H567</sup>, which were on the side<sup>H5676</sup> of Jordan<sup>H3383</sup> westward<sup>H3220</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the Canaanites<sup>H3669</sup>, which were by the sea<sup>H3220</sup>, heard<sup>H8085</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had dried up<sup>H3001</sup> the waters<sup>H4325</sup> of Jordan<sup>H3383</sup> from before<sup>H6440</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, until we were passed over<sup>H5674</sup>, that their heart<sup>H3824</sup> melted<sup>H4549</sup>, neither was there spirit<sup>H7307</sup> in them any more, because<sup>H6440</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 2 At that time<sup>H6256</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Joshua<sup>H3091</sup>, Make<sup>H6213</sup> thee sharp<sup>H6697</sup> knives<sup>H2719</sup>, and circumcise<sup>H4135</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> the second time<sup>H8145</sup>. 3 And Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> him sharp<sup>H6697</sup> knives<sup>H2719</sup>, and circumcised<sup>H4135</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> at the hill<sup>H1389</sup> of the foreskins<sup>H6190</sup>. 4 And this is the cause<sup>H1697</sup> why Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> did circumcise<sup>H4135</sup>. All the people<sup>H5971</sup> that came out<sup>H3318</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, that were males<sup>H2145</sup>, even all the men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup>, died<sup>H4191</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup>, after they came out<sup>H3318</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 5 Now<sup>H3588</sup> all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that came out<sup>H3318</sup> were circumcised<sup>H4135</sup>: but all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that were born<sup>H3209</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup> as they came forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, them they had not circumcised<sup>H4135</sup>. 6 For the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> walked<sup>H1980</sup> forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>, till all the people<sup>H1471</sup> that were men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup>, which came out<sup>H3318</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, were consumed<sup>H8552</sup>, because they obeyed<sup>H8085</sup> not the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: unto whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sware<sup>H7650</sup> that he would not shew<sup>H7200</sup> them the land<sup>H776</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto their fathers<sup>H1</sup> that he would give<sup>H5414</sup> us, a land<sup>H776</sup> that floweth<sup>H2100</sup> with milk<sup>H2461</sup> and honey<sup>H1706</sup>. 7 And their children<sup>H1121</sup>, whom he raised up<sup>H6965</sup> in their stead, them Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> circumcised<sup>H4135</sup>: for they were uncircumcised<sup>H6189</sup>, because they had not circumcised<sup>H4135</sup> them by the way<sup>H1870</sup>. 8 And it came to pass, when they had done<sup>H8552</sup> circumcising<sup>H4135</sup> all the people<sup>H1471</sup>, that they abode<sup>H3427</sup> in their places in the camp<sup>H4264</sup>, till they were whole<sup>H2421</sup>. 9 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Joshua<sup>H3091</sup>, This day<sup>H3117</sup> have I rolled away<sup>H1556</sup> the reproach<sup>H2781</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> from off you. Wherefore the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the place<sup>H4725</sup> is called<sup>H7121</sup> Gilgal<sup>H1537</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>.

10 And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> encamped<sup>H2583</sup> in Gilgal<sup>H1537</sup>, and kept<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> on the fourteenth<sup>H702</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> of the month<sup>H2320</sup> at even<sup>H6153</sup> in the plains<sup>H6160</sup> of Jericho<sup>H3405</sup>. 11 And they did eat<sup>H398</sup> of the old corn<sup>H5669</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> on the morrow<sup>H4283</sup> after the passover<sup>H6453</sup>, unleavened cakes<sup>H4682</sup>, and parched<sup>H7033</sup> corn in the selfsame<sup>H6106</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>. 12 And the manna<sup>H4478</sup> ceased<sup>H7673</sup> on the morrow<sup>H4283</sup> after they had eaten<sup>H398</sup> of the old corn<sup>H5669</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>; neither had the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> manna<sup>H4478</sup> any more; but they did eat<sup>H398</sup> of the fruit<sup>H8393</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Canaan<sup>H3667</sup> that year<sup>H8141</sup>.

13 And it came to pass, when Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> was by Jericho<sup>H3405</sup>, that he lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> his eyes<sup>H5869</sup> and looked<sup>H7200</sup>, and, behold, there stood<sup>H5975</sup> a man<sup>H376</sup> over against him with his sword<sup>H2719</sup> drawn<sup>H8025</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>: and Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> unto him, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries<sup>H6862</sup>? 14 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Nay; but as captain<sup>H8269</sup> of the host<sup>H6635</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> am I now come<sup>H935</sup>. And Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> fell<sup>H5307</sup> on his face<sup>H6440</sup> to the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and did worship<sup>H7812</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, What saith<sup>H1696</sup> my lord<sup>H1113</sup> unto his servant<sup>H5650</sup>? 15 And the captain<sup>H8269</sup> of the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> host<sup>H6635</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Joshua<sup>H3091</sup>, Loose<sup>H5394</sup> thy shoe<sup>H5275</sup> from off thy foot<sup>H7272</sup>, for the place<sup>H4725</sup> whereon thou standest<sup>H5975</sup> is holy<sup>H6944</sup>. And Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> so.
