

# Judges 17

1 And there was a man<sup>H376</sup> of mount<sup>H2022</sup> Ephraim<sup>H669</sup>, whose name<sup>H8034</sup> was Micah<sup>H4321</sup>. 2 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto his mother<sup>H517</sup>, The eleven hundred<sup>H505 H3967</sup> shekels of silver<sup>H3701</sup> that were taken<sup>H3947</sup> from thee, about which thou cursedst<sup>H422</sup>, and spakest<sup>H559</sup> of also in mine ears<sup>H241</sup>, behold, the silver<sup>H3701</sup> is with me; I took<sup>H3947</sup> it. And his mother<sup>H517</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be thou of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, my son<sup>H1121</sup>. 3 And when he had restored<sup>H7725</sup> the eleven hundred<sup>H505 H3967</sup> shekels of silver<sup>H3701</sup> to his mother<sup>H517</sup>, his mother<sup>H517</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, I had wholly<sup>H6942</sup> dedicated<sup>H6942</sup> the silver<sup>H3701</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> from my hand<sup>H3027</sup> for my son<sup>H1121</sup>, to make<sup>H6213</sup> a graven image<sup>H6459</sup> and a molten image<sup>H4541</sup>: now therefore I will restore<sup>H7725</sup> it unto thee. 4 Yet he restored<sup>H7725</sup> the money<sup>H3701</sup> unto his mother<sup>H517</sup>; and his mother<sup>H517</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> two hundred<sup>H3967</sup> shekels of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and gave<sup>H5414</sup> them to the founder<sup>H6884</sup>, who made<sup>H6213</sup> thereof a graven image<sup>H6459</sup> and a molten image<sup>H4541</sup>: and they were in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Micah<sup>H4321</sup>. 5 And the man<sup>H376</sup> Micah<sup>H4318</sup> had an house<sup>H1004</sup> of gods<sup>H430</sup>, and made<sup>H6213</sup> an ephod<sup>H646</sup>, and teraphim<sup>H8655</sup>, and consecrated<sup>H4390 H3027</sup> one<sup>H259</sup> of his sons<sup>H1121</sup>, who became his priest<sup>H3548</sup>. 6 In those days<sup>H3117</sup> there was no king<sup>H4428</sup> in Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, but every man<sup>H376</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in his own eyes<sup>H5869</sup>.

7 And there was a young man<sup>H5288</sup> out of Bethlehemjudah<sup>H1035 H3063</sup> of the family<sup>H4940</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, who was a Levite<sup>H3881</sup>, and he sojourned<sup>H11481</sup> there. 8 And the man<sup>H376</sup> departed<sup>H3212</sup> out of the city<sup>H5892</sup> from Bethlehemjudah<sup>H1035 H3063</sup> to sojourn<sup>H11481</sup> where he could find<sup>H4672</sup> a place: and he came<sup>H935</sup> to mount<sup>H2022</sup> Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> to the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Micah<sup>H4318</sup>, as he journeyed<sup>H6213 H1870</sup>. 9 And Micah<sup>H4318</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Whence<sup>H370</sup> comest<sup>H935</sup> thou? And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, I am a Levite<sup>H3881</sup> of Bethlehemjudah<sup>H1035 H3063</sup>, and I go<sup>H1980</sup> to sojourn<sup>H11481</sup> where I may find<sup>H4672</sup> a place. 10 And Micah<sup>H4318</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Dwell<sup>H3427</sup> with me, and be unto me a father<sup>H1</sup> and a priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and I will give<sup>H5414</sup> thee ten<sup>H6235</sup> shekels of silver<sup>H3701</sup> by the year<sup>H3117</sup>, and a suit<sup>H6187</sup> of apparel<sup>H899</sup>, and thy victuals<sup>H4241</sup>. So the Levite<sup>H3881</sup> went in<sup>H3212</sup>. 11 And the Levite<sup>H3881</sup> was content<sup>H2974</sup> to dwell<sup>H3427</sup> with the man<sup>H376</sup>; and the young man<sup>H5288</sup> was unto him as one<sup>H259</sup> of his sons<sup>H1121</sup>. 12 And Micah<sup>H4318</sup> consecrated<sup>H4390 H3027</sup> the Levite<sup>H3881</sup>; and the young man<sup>H5288</sup> became his priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and was in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Micah<sup>H4318</sup>. 13 Then said<sup>H559</sup> Micah<sup>H4318</sup>, Now know<sup>H3045</sup> I that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will do me good<sup>H3190</sup>, seeing I have a Levite<sup>H3881</sup> to my priest<sup>H3548</sup>.
