

# Leviticus 13

1 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup> and Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 When a man<sup>H120</sup> shall have in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of his flesh<sup>H1320</sup> a rising<sup>H7613</sup>, a scab<sup>H5597</sup>, or bright spot<sup>H934</sup>, and it be in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of his flesh<sup>H1320</sup> like the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>; then he shall be brought<sup>H935</sup> unto Aaron<sup>H175</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, or unto one<sup>H259</sup> of his sons<sup>H1121</sup> the priests<sup>H3548,1</sup>. 3 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on the plague<sup>H5061</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of the flesh<sup>H1320</sup>: and when the hair<sup>H8181</sup> in the plague<sup>H5061</sup> is turned<sup>H2015</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>, and the plague<sup>H5061</sup> in sight<sup>H4758</sup> be deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of his flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, it is a plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>: and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on him, and pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>. 4 If the bright spot<sup>H934</sup> be white<sup>H3836</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of his flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, and in sight<sup>H4758</sup> be not deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, and the hair<sup>H8181</sup> thereof be not turned<sup>H2015</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>; then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> up him that hath the plague<sup>H5061</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: 5 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on him the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>: and, behold, if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> in his sight<sup>H5869</sup> be at a stay<sup>H5975</sup>, and the plague<sup>H5061</sup> spread<sup>H6581</sup> not in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>; then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> him up seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> more<sup>H8145</sup>: 6 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on him again<sup>H8145</sup> the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>: and, behold, if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be somewhat dark<sup>H3544</sup>, and the plague<sup>H5061</sup> spread<sup>H6581</sup> not in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup>: it is but a scab<sup>H4556</sup>: and he shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and be clean<sup>H2891</sup>. 7 But if the scab<sup>H4556</sup> spread much<sup>H6581</sup> abroad<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> that he hath been seen<sup>H7200</sup> of the priest<sup>H3548</sup> for his cleansing<sup>H2893</sup>, he shall be seen<sup>H7200</sup> of the priest<sup>H3548</sup> again<sup>H8145</sup>: 8 And if the priest<sup>H3548</sup> see<sup>H7200</sup> that, behold, the scab<sup>H4556</sup> spreadeth<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: it is a leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>. 9 When the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> is in a man<sup>H120</sup>, then he shall be brought<sup>H935</sup> unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>; 10 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall see<sup>H7200</sup> him: and, behold, if the rising<sup>H7613</sup> be white<sup>H3836</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, and it have turned<sup>H2015</sup> the hair<sup>H8181</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>, and there be quick<sup>H4241</sup> raw<sup>H2416</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup> in the rising<sup>H7613,2</sup>, 11 It is an old<sup>H3462</sup> leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of his flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>, and shall not shut<sup>H5462</sup> him up: for he is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>. 12 And if a leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> break out<sup>H6524</sup> abroad<sup>H6524</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, and the leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> cover<sup>H3680</sup> all the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of him that hath the plague<sup>H5061</sup> from his head<sup>H7218</sup> even to his foot<sup>H7272</sup>, wheresoever the priest<sup>H3548</sup> looketh<sup>H4758</sup> H5869; 13 Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall consider<sup>H7200</sup>: and, behold, if the leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> have covered<sup>H3680</sup> all his flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, he shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup> that hath the plague<sup>H5061</sup>: it is all turned<sup>H2015</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>: he is clean<sup>H2889</sup>. 14 But when<sup>H3117</sup> raw<sup>H2416</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup> appeareth<sup>H7200</sup> in him, he shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>. 15 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall see<sup>H7200</sup> the raw<sup>H2416</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, and pronounce him to be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: for the raw<sup>H2416</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup> is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>: it is a leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>. 16 Or if the raw<sup>H2416</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup> turn again<sup>H7725</sup>, and be changed<sup>H2015</sup> unto white<sup>H3836</sup>, he shall come<sup>H935</sup> unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>; 17 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall see<sup>H7200</sup> him: and, behold, if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be turned<sup>H2015</sup> into white<sup>H3836</sup>, then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup> that hath the plague<sup>H5061</sup>: he is clean<sup>H2889</sup>.

18 The flesh<sup>H1320</sup> also, in which<sup>H3588</sup>, even in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> thereof, was a boil<sup>H7822</sup>, and is healed<sup>H7495</sup>, 19 And in the place<sup>H4725</sup> of the boil<sup>H7822</sup> there be a white<sup>H3836</sup> rising<sup>H7613</sup>, or a bright spot<sup>H934</sup>, white<sup>H3836</sup>, and somewhat reddish<sup>H125</sup>, and it be shewed<sup>H7200</sup> to the priest<sup>H3548</sup>; 20 And if, when the priest<sup>H3548</sup> seeth<sup>H7200</sup> it, behold, it be in sight<sup>H4758</sup> lower<sup>H8217</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, and the hair<sup>H8181</sup> thereof be turned<sup>H2015</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>; the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: it is a plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> broken<sup>H6524</sup> out of the boil<sup>H7822</sup>. 21 But if the priest<sup>H3548</sup> look<sup>H7200</sup> on it, and, behold, there be no white<sup>H3836</sup> hairs<sup>H8181</sup> therein, and if it be not lower<sup>H8217</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, but be somewhat dark<sup>H3544</sup>; then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> him up seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: 22 And if it spread much<sup>H6581</sup> abroad<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: it is a plague<sup>H5061</sup>. 23 But if the bright spot<sup>H934</sup> stay<sup>H5975</sup> in his place, and spread<sup>H6581</sup> not, it is a burning<sup>H6867</sup> boil<sup>H7822</sup>; and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup>. 24 Or if there be any flesh<sup>H1320</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> whereof there is a hot<sup>H784</sup> burning<sup>H4348</sup>, and the quick<sup>H4241</sup> flesh that burneth<sup>H4348</sup> have a white<sup>H3836</sup> bright spot<sup>H934</sup>, somewhat reddish<sup>H125</sup>, or white<sup>H3836,3</sup>; 25 Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> upon it:

and, behold, if the hair<sup>H8181</sup> in the bright spot<sup>H934</sup> be turned<sup>H2015</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>, and it be in sight<sup>H4758</sup> deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>; it is a leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> broken<sup>H6524</sup> out of the burning<sup>H4348</sup>: wherefore the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: it is the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>. **26** But if the priest<sup>H3548</sup> look<sup>H7200</sup> on it, and, behold, there be no white<sup>H3836</sup> hair<sup>H8181</sup> in the bright spot<sup>H934</sup>, and it be no lower<sup>H8217</sup> than the other skin<sup>H5785</sup>, but be somewhat dark<sup>H3544</sup>, then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> him up seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: **27** And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> upon him the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>: and if it be spread much<sup>H6581</sup> abroad<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: it is the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>. **28** And if the bright<sup>H934</sup> spot<sup>H934</sup> stay<sup>H5975</sup> in his place, and spread<sup>H6581</sup> not in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, but it be somewhat dark<sup>H3544</sup>, it is a rising<sup>H7613</sup> of the burning<sup>H4348</sup>, and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup>: for it is an inflammation<sup>H6867</sup> of the burning<sup>H4348</sup>. **29** If a man<sup>H376</sup> or woman<sup>H802</sup> have a plague<sup>H5061</sup> upon the head<sup>H7218</sup> or the beard<sup>H2206</sup>; **30** Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall see<sup>H7200</sup> the plague<sup>H5061</sup>: and, behold, if it be in sight<sup>H4758</sup> deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, and there be in it a yellow<sup>H6669</sup> thin<sup>H1851</sup> hair<sup>H8181</sup>; then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: it is a dry scall<sup>H5424</sup>, even a leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> upon the head<sup>H7218</sup> or beard<sup>H2206</sup>. **31** And if the priest<sup>H3548</sup> look<sup>H7200</sup> on the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of the scall<sup>H5424</sup>, and, behold, it be not in sight<sup>H4758</sup> deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, and that there is no black<sup>H7838</sup> hair<sup>H8181</sup> in it; then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> up him that hath the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of the scall<sup>H5424</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: **32** And in the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on the plague<sup>H5061</sup>: and, behold, if the scall<sup>H5424</sup> spread<sup>H6581</sup> not, and there be in it no yellow<sup>H6669</sup> hair<sup>H8181</sup>, and the scall<sup>H5424</sup> be not in sight<sup>H4758</sup> deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>; **33** He shall be shaven<sup>H1548</sup>, but the scall<sup>H5424</sup> shall he not shave<sup>H1548</sup>, and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> up him that hath the scall<sup>H5424</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> more<sup>H8145</sup>: **34** And in the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on the scall<sup>H5424</sup>: and, behold, if the scall<sup>H5424</sup> be not spread<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, nor be in sight<sup>H4758</sup> deeper<sup>H6013</sup> than the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup>: and he shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and be clean<sup>H2891</sup>. **35** But if the scall<sup>H5424</sup> spread<sup>H6581</sup> much<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> his cleansing<sup>H2893</sup>; **36** Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on him: and, behold, if the scall<sup>H5424</sup> be spread<sup>H6581</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall not seek<sup>H1239</sup> for yellow<sup>H6669</sup> hair<sup>H8181</sup>; he is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>. **37** But if the scall<sup>H5424</sup> be in his sight<sup>H5869</sup> at a stay<sup>H5975</sup>, and that there is black<sup>H7838</sup> hair<sup>H8181</sup> grown<sup>H6779</sup> up therein; the scall<sup>H5424</sup> is healed<sup>H7495</sup>, he is clean<sup>H2889</sup>: and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him clean<sup>H2891</sup>.

**38** If a man<sup>H376</sup> also or a woman<sup>H802</sup> have in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of their flesh<sup>H1320</sup> bright spots<sup>H934</sup>, even white<sup>H3836</sup> bright spots<sup>H934</sup>; **39** Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup>: and, behold, if the bright spots<sup>H934</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of their flesh<sup>H1320</sup> be darkish<sup>H3544</sup> white<sup>H3836</sup>, it is a freckled spot<sup>H933</sup> that groweth<sup>H6524</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>; he is clean<sup>H2889</sup>. **40** And the man<sup>H376</sup> whose hair is fallen<sup>H4803</sup> off his head<sup>H7218</sup>, he is bald<sup>H7142</sup>; yet is he clean<sup>H2889</sup>. **41** And he that hath his hair fallen<sup>H4803</sup> off from the part<sup>H6285</sup> of his head<sup>H7218</sup> toward his face<sup>H6440</sup>, he is forehead bald<sup>H1371</sup>: yet is he clean<sup>H2889</sup>. **42** And if there be in the bald head<sup>H7146</sup>, or bald forehead<sup>H1372</sup>, a white<sup>H3836</sup> reddish<sup>H125</sup> sore<sup>H5061</sup>; it is a leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> sprung<sup>H6524</sup> up in his bald head<sup>H7146</sup>, or his bald forehead<sup>H1372</sup>. **43** Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> upon it: and, behold, if the rising<sup>H7613</sup> of the sore<sup>H5061</sup> be white<sup>H3836</sup> reddish<sup>H125</sup> in his bald head<sup>H7146</sup>, or in his bald forehead<sup>H1372</sup>, as the leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> appeareth<sup>H4758</sup> in the skin<sup>H5785</sup> of the flesh<sup>H1320</sup>; **44** He is a leprous<sup>H6879</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>, he is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>: the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall pronounce him utterly<sup>H2930</sup> unclean<sup>H2930</sup>; his plague<sup>H5061</sup> is in his head<sup>H7218</sup>. **45** And the leper<sup>H6879</sup> in whom the plague<sup>H5061</sup> is, his clothes<sup>H899</sup> shall be rent<sup>H6533</sup>, and his head<sup>H7218</sup> bare<sup>H6544</sup>, and he shall put a covering<sup>H5844</sup> upon his upper lip<sup>H8222</sup>, and shall cry<sup>H7121</sup>, Unclean<sup>H2931</sup>, unclean<sup>H2931</sup>. **46** All the days<sup>H3117</sup> wherein the plague<sup>H5061</sup> shall be in him he shall be defiled<sup>H2930</sup>; he is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>: he shall dwell<sup>H3427</sup> alone<sup>H910</sup>; without<sup>H2351</sup> the camp<sup>H4264</sup> shall his habitation<sup>H4186</sup> be.

**47** The garment<sup>H899</sup> also that the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> is in, whether it be a woollen<sup>H6785</sup> garment<sup>H899</sup>, or a linen<sup>H6593</sup> garment<sup>H899</sup>; **48** Whether it be in the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or woof<sup>H6154</sup>; of linen<sup>H6593</sup>, or of woollen<sup>H6785</sup>; whether in a skin<sup>H5785</sup>, or in any thing made<sup>H4399</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup>; **49** And if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be greenish<sup>H3422</sup> or reddish<sup>H125</sup> in the garment<sup>H899</sup>, or in the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, either<sup>H176</sup> in the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or in the woof<sup>H6154</sup>, or in any thing<sup>H3627</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup>; it is a plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>, and shall be shewed<sup>H7200</sup> unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>. **50** And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> upon the plague<sup>H5061</sup>, and shut<sup>H5462</sup> up it that hath the plague<sup>H5061</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: **51** And he shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on the plague<sup>H5061</sup> on the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>: if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be spread<sup>H6581</sup> in the garment<sup>H899</sup>, either in the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or in the woof<sup>H6154</sup>, or in a skin<sup>H5785</sup>, or in any work<sup>H4399</sup> that is made<sup>H6213</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup>; the plague<sup>H5061</sup> is a fretting<sup>H3992</sup>

leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>; it is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>. **52** He shall therefore burn<sup>H8313</sup> that garment<sup>H899</sup>, whether warp<sup>H8359</sup> or woof<sup>H6154</sup>, in woollen<sup>H6785</sup> or in linen<sup>H6593</sup>, or any thing<sup>H3627</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup>, wherein the plague<sup>H5061</sup> is: for it is a fretting<sup>H3992</sup> leprosy<sup>H6883</sup>, it shall be burnt<sup>H8313</sup> in the fire<sup>H784</sup>. **53** And if the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup>, and, behold, the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be not spread<sup>H6581</sup> in the garment<sup>H899</sup>, either<sup>H176</sup> in the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or<sup>H176</sup> in the woof<sup>H6154</sup>, or<sup>H176</sup> in any thing<sup>H3627</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup>, **54** Then the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall command<sup>H6680</sup> that they wash<sup>H3526</sup> the thing wherein the plague<sup>H5061</sup> is, and he shall shut<sup>H5462</sup> it up seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> more<sup>H8145</sup>: **55** And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall look<sup>H7200</sup> on the plague<sup>H5061</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> that it is washed<sup>H3526</sup>: and, behold, if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> have not changed<sup>H2015</sup> his colour<sup>H5869</sup>, and the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be not spread<sup>H6581</sup>; it is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>; thou shalt burn<sup>H8313</sup> it in the fire<sup>H784</sup>; it is fret<sup>H6356</sup> inward, whether it be bare within<sup>H7146</sup> or without<sup>H1372 7</sup>. **56** And if the priest<sup>H3548</sup> look<sup>H7200</sup>, and, behold, the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be somewhat dark<sup>H3544</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the washing<sup>H3526</sup> of it; then he shall rend<sup>H7167</sup> it out of the garment<sup>H899</sup>, or out of the skin<sup>H5785</sup>, or out of the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or out of the woof<sup>H6154</sup>. **57** And if it appear<sup>H7200</sup> still<sup>H5750</sup> in the garment<sup>H899</sup>, either in the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or in the woof<sup>H6154</sup>, or in any thing<sup>H3627</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup>, it is a spreading<sup>H6524</sup> plague: thou shalt burn<sup>H8313</sup> that wherein the plague<sup>H5061</sup> is with fire<sup>H784</sup>. **58** And the garment<sup>H899</sup>, either warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or woof<sup>H6154</sup>, or whatsoever thing<sup>H3627</sup> of skin<sup>H5785</sup> it be, which thou shalt wash<sup>H3526</sup>, if the plague<sup>H5061</sup> be departed<sup>H5493</sup> from them, then it shall be washed<sup>H3526</sup> the second<sup>H8145</sup> time, and shall be clean<sup>H2891</sup>. **59** This is the law<sup>H8451</sup> of the plague<sup>H5061</sup> of leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> in a garment<sup>H899</sup> of woollen<sup>H6785</sup> or linen<sup>H6593</sup>, either in the warp<sup>H8359</sup>, or woof<sup>H6154</sup>, or any thing<sup>H3627</sup> of skins<sup>H5785</sup>, to pronounce it clean<sup>H2891</sup>, or to pronounce it unclean<sup>H2930</sup>.
