

# Leviticus 21

1 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Speak<sup>H559</sup> unto the priests<sup>H3548</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, There shall none be defiled<sup>H2930</sup> for the dead<sup>H5315</sup> among his people<sup>H5971</sup>: 2 But for his kin<sup>H7607</sup>, that is near<sup>H7138</sup> unto him, that is, for his mother<sup>H517</sup>, and for his father<sup>H1</sup>, and for his son<sup>H1121</sup>, and for his daughter<sup>H1323</sup>, and for his brother<sup>H251</sup>, 3 And for his sister<sup>H269</sup> a virgin<sup>H1330</sup>, that is nigh<sup>H7138</sup> unto him, which hath had no husband<sup>H376</sup>; for her may he be defiled<sup>H2930</sup>. 4 But he shall not defile<sup>H2930</sup> himself, being a chief man<sup>H1167</sup> among his people<sup>H5971</sup>, to profane<sup>H2490</sup> himself. 5 They shall not make<sup>H7139</sup> baldness<sup>H7144</sup> upon their head<sup>H7218</sup>, neither shall they shave off<sup>H1548</sup> the corner<sup>H6285</sup> of their beard<sup>H2206</sup>, nor make<sup>H8295</sup> any cuttings<sup>H8296</sup> in their flesh<sup>H1320</sup>. 6 They shall be holy<sup>H6944</sup> unto their God<sup>H430</sup>, and not profane<sup>H2490</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of their God<sup>H430</sup>: for the offerings<sup>H801</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> made by fire<sup>H801</sup>, and the bread<sup>H3899</sup> of their God<sup>H430</sup>, they do offer<sup>H7126</sup>: therefore they shall be holy<sup>H6918</sup>. 7 They shall not take<sup>H3947</sup> a wife<sup>H802</sup> that is a whore<sup>H2181</sup>, or profane<sup>H2491</sup>; neither shall they take<sup>H3947</sup> a woman<sup>H802</sup> put away<sup>H1644</sup> from her husband<sup>H376</sup>: for he is holy<sup>H6918</sup> unto his God<sup>H430</sup>. 8 Thou shalt sanctify<sup>H6942</sup> him therefore; for he offereth<sup>H7126</sup> the bread<sup>H3899</sup> of thy God<sup>H430</sup>: he shall be holy<sup>H6918</sup> unto thee: for I the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, which sanctify<sup>H6942</sup> you, am holy<sup>H6918</sup>. 9 And the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of any<sup>H376</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup>, if she profane<sup>H2490</sup> herself by playing the whore<sup>H2181</sup>, she profaneth<sup>H2490</sup> her father<sup>H1</sup>: she shall be burnt<sup>H8313</sup> with fire<sup>H784</sup>.

10 And he that is the high<sup>H1419</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup> among his brethren<sup>H251</sup>, upon whose head<sup>H7218</sup> the anointing<sup>H4888</sup> oil<sup>H8081</sup> was poured<sup>H3332</sup>, and that is consecrated<sup>H4390 H3027</sup> to put<sup>H3847</sup> on the garments<sup>H899</sup>, shall not uncover<sup>H6544</sup> his head<sup>H7218</sup>, nor rend<sup>H6533</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>; 11 Neither shall he go in<sup>H935</sup> to any dead<sup>H4191</sup> body<sup>H5315</sup>, nor defile<sup>H2930</sup> himself for his father<sup>H1</sup>, or for his mother<sup>H517</sup>; 12 Neither shall he go out<sup>H3318</sup> of the sanctuary<sup>H4720</sup>, nor profane<sup>H2490</sup> the sanctuary<sup>H4720</sup> of his God<sup>H430</sup>; for the crown<sup>H5145</sup> of the anointing<sup>H4888</sup> oil<sup>H8081</sup> of his God<sup>H430</sup> is upon him: I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 13 And he shall take<sup>H3947</sup> a wife<sup>H802</sup> in her virginity<sup>H1331</sup>. 14 A widow<sup>H490</sup>, or a divorced woman<sup>H1644</sup>, or profane<sup>H2491</sup>, or an harlot<sup>H2181</sup>, these shall he not take<sup>H3947</sup>: but he shall take<sup>H3947</sup> a virgin<sup>H1330</sup> of his own people<sup>H5971</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>. 15 Neither shall he profane<sup>H2490</sup> his seed<sup>H2233</sup> among his people<sup>H5971</sup>: for I the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> do sanctify<sup>H6942</sup> him.

16 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 17 Speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Whosoever<sup>H376</sup> he be of thy seed<sup>H2233</sup> in their generations<sup>H1755</sup> that hath any blemish<sup>H3971</sup>, let him not approach<sup>H7126</sup> to offer<sup>H7126</sup> the bread<sup>H3899</sup> of his God<sup>H430</sup>. 18 For whatsoever man<sup>H376</sup> he be that hath a blemish<sup>H3971</sup>, he shall not approach<sup>H7126</sup>: a blind<sup>H5787</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>, or a lame<sup>H6455</sup>, or he that hath a flat nose<sup>H2763</sup>, or any thing superfluous<sup>H8311</sup>, 19 Or a man<sup>H376</sup> that is brokenfooted<sup>H7667 H7272</sup>, or brokenhanded<sup>H7667 H3027</sup>, 20 Or crookbackt<sup>H1384</sup>, or a dwarf<sup>H1851</sup>, or that hath a blemish<sup>H8400</sup> in his eye<sup>H5869</sup>, or be scurvy<sup>H1618</sup>, or scabbed<sup>H3217</sup>, or hath his stones<sup>H810</sup> broken<sup>H4790,3</sup>, 21 No man<sup>H376</sup> that hath a blemish<sup>H3971</sup> of the seed<sup>H2233</sup> of Aaron<sup>H175</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall come nigh<sup>H5066</sup> to offer<sup>H7126</sup> the offerings<sup>H801</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> made by fire<sup>H801</sup>: he hath a blemish<sup>H3971</sup>; he shall not come nigh<sup>H5066</sup> to offer<sup>H7126</sup> the bread<sup>H3899</sup> of his God<sup>H430</sup>. 22 He shall eat<sup>H398</sup> the bread<sup>H3899</sup> of his God<sup>H430</sup>, both of the most<sup>H6944</sup> holy<sup>H6944</sup>, and of the holy<sup>H6944</sup>. 23 Only he shall not go in<sup>H935</sup> unto the vail<sup>H6532</sup>, nor come nigh<sup>H5066</sup> unto the altar<sup>H4196</sup>, because he hath a blemish<sup>H3971</sup>; that he profane<sup>H2490</sup> not my sanctuaries<sup>H4720</sup>: for I the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> do sanctify<sup>H6942</sup> them. 24 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> told<sup>H1696</sup> it unto Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, and to his sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and unto all the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.
