## Malachi 2

**1** And now, O ye priests<sup>H3548</sup>, this commandment<sup>H4687</sup> is for you. **2** If ye will not hear<sup>H6085</sup>, and if ye will not lay<sup>H7760</sup> it to heart<sup>H3820</sup>, to give<sup>H5414</sup> glory<sup>H3519</sup> unto my name<sup>H8034</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, I will even send<sup>H7971</sup> a curse<sup>H3994</sup> upon you, and I will curse<sup>H779</sup> your blessings<sup>H1293</sup>: yea, I have cursed<sup>H779</sup> them already, because ye do not lay<sup>H7760</sup> it to heart<sup>H3820</sup>. **3** Behold, I will corrupt<sup>H1605</sup> your seed<sup>H2233</sup>, and spread<sup>H2219</sup> dung<sup>H6569</sup> upon your faces<sup>H6440</sup>, even the dung<sup>H6569</sup> of your solemn feasts<sup>H2282</sup>; and one shall take you away<sup>H5375</sup> with it.<sup>123</sup> **4** And ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I have sent<sup>H7971</sup> this commandment<sup>H4687</sup> unto you, that my covenant<sup>H1285</sup> might be with Levi<sup>H3878</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>. **5** My covenant<sup>H1285</sup> was with him of life<sup>H2416</sup> and peace<sup>H7965</sup>; and I gave<sup>H5414</sup> them to him for the fear<sup>H4172</sup> wherewith he feared<sup>H3372</sup> me, and was afraid<sup>H2865</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> my name<sup>H8034</sup>. **6** The law<sup>H8451</sup> of truth<sup>H571</sup> was in his mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, and iniquity<sup>H5766</sup> was not found<sup>H4672</sup> in his lips<sup>H8193</sup>: he walked<sup>H1980</sup> with me in peace<sup>H7965</sup> and equity<sup>H4334</sup>, and did turn<sup>H7725</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> away<sup>H7725</sup> from iniquity<sup>H5771</sup>. **7** For the priest's<sup>H3548</sup> lips<sup>H8193</sup> should keep<sup>H8104</sup> knowledge<sup>H1847</sup>, and they should seek<sup>H1245</sup> the law<sup>H8451</sup> at his mouth<sup>H6310</sup>: for he is the messenger<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>. **8** But ye are departed<sup>H5493</sup> out of the way<sup>H1870</sup>; ye have caused many<sup>H7227</sup> to stumble<sup>H3782</sup> at the law<sup>H8451</sup>; ye have corrupted<sup>H7843</sup> the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> of Levi<sup>H3878</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>. **4 9** Therefore have I also made<sup>H5144</sup> you contemptible<sup>H599</sup> and base<sup>H8217</sup> before all the people<sup>H5971</sup>, according<sup>H6310</sup> as ye have not kept<sup>H8104</sup> my ways<sup>H1870</sup>, but have been partial<sup>H5375 H6440</sup> in the law<sup>H8451.5</sup>

**10** Have we not all one<sup>H259</sup> father<sup>H1</sup>? hath not one<sup>H259</sup> God<sup>H410</sup> created<sup>H1254</sup> us? why do we deal treacherously<sup>H898</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> against his brother<sup>H251</sup>, by profaning<sup>H2490</sup> the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> of our fathers<sup>H1</sup>? **11** Judah<sup>H3063</sup> hath dealt treacherously<sup>H898</sup>, and an abomination<sup>H8441</sup> is committed<sup>H6213</sup> in Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>; for Judah<sup>H3063</sup> hath profaned<sup>H2490</sup> the holiness<sup>H6944</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> which he loved<sup>H157</sup>, and hath married<sup>H1166</sup> the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of a strange<sup>H5236</sup> god<sup>H410,6</sup> **12** The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the man<sup>H376</sup> that doeth<sup>H6213</sup> this, the master<sup>H5782</sup> and the scholar<sup>H6030</sup>, out of the tabernacles<sup>H168</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, and him that offereth<sup>H5066</sup> an offering<sup>H4503</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635 7</sup> **13** And this have ye done<sup>H6213</sup> again<sup>H8145</sup>, covering<sup>H3680</sup> the altar<sup>H4196</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> with tears<sup>H1832</sup>, with weeping<sup>H1065</sup>, and with crying out<sup>H603</sup>, insomuch that he regardeth<sup>H6437</sup> not the offering<sup>H4503</sup> any more, or receiveth<sup>H3947</sup> it with good will<sup>H7522</sup> at your hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 14 Yet ye say<sup>H559</sup>, Wherefore<sup>H4100</sup>? Because the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath been witness<sup>H5749</sup> between thee and the wife<sup>H802</sup> of thy youth<sup>H5271</sup>, against whom thou hast dealt treacherously<sup>H898</sup>: yet is she thy companion<sup>H2278</sup>, and the wife<sup>H802</sup> of thy covenant<sup>H1285</sup>. **15** And did not he make<sup>H6213</sup> one<sup>H259</sup>? Yet had he the residue<sup>H7605</sup> of the spirit<sup>H7307</sup>. And wherefore one<sup>H259</sup>? That he might seek<sup>H1245</sup> a godly<sup>H430</sup> seed<sup>H2233</sup>. Therefore take heed<sup>H8104</sup> to your spirit<sup>H7307</sup>, and let none deal treacherously<sup>H898</sup> against the wife<sup>H802</sup> of his youth<sup>H5271</sup>.<sup>8910</sup> **16** For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> that he hateth<sup>H8130</sup> putting away<sup>H7971</sup>: for one covereth<sup>H3680</sup> violence<sup>H2555</sup> with his garment<sup>H3830</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>: therefore take heed<sup>H8104</sup> to your spirit<sup>H7307</sup>, that ye deal not treacherously<sup>H898</sup>.<sup>1112</sup> **17** Ye have wearied<sup>H3021</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> with your words<sup>H1697</sup>. Yet ye say<sup>H559</sup>, Wherein have we wearied<sup>H3021</sup> him? When ye say<sup>H559</sup>, Every one that doeth<sup>H6213</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> is good<sup>H2896</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and he delighteth<sup>H2654</sup> in them; or, Where is the God<sup>H430</sup> of judgment<sup>H4941</sup>?
