

# Nehemiah 13



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 On that day<sup>H3117</sup> they read<sup>H7121</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of Moses<sup>H4872</sup> in the audience<sup>H241</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>; and therein was found<sup>H4672</sup> written<sup>H3789</sup>, that the Ammonite<sup>H5984</sup> and the Moabite<sup>H4125</sup> should not come<sup>H935</sup> into the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769,12</sup>. 2 Because they met<sup>H6923</sup> not the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> with bread<sup>H3899</sup> and with water<sup>H4325</sup>, but hired<sup>H7936</sup> Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> against them, that he should curse<sup>H7043</sup> them: howbeit our God<sup>H430</sup> turned<sup>H2015</sup> the curse<sup>H7045</sup> into a blessing<sup>H1293</sup>. 3 Now it came to pass, when they had heard<sup>H1293</sup> the law<sup>H8085</sup>, that they separated<sup>H914</sup> from Israel<sup>H3478</sup> all the mixed multitude<sup>H6154</sup>. 4 And before<sup>H6440</sup> this, Eliashib<sup>H475</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, having the oversight<sup>H5414</sup> of the chamber<sup>H3957</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of our God<sup>H430</sup>, was allied<sup>H7138</sup> unto Tobiah<sup>H2900,3</sup>. 5 And he had prepared<sup>H6213</sup> for him a great<sup>H1419</sup> chamber<sup>H3957</sup>, where aforetime<sup>H6440</sup> they laid<sup>H5414</sup> the meat offerings<sup>H4503</sup>, the frankincense<sup>H3828</sup>, and the vessels<sup>H3627</sup>, and the tithes<sup>H4643</sup> of the corn<sup>H1715</sup>, the new wine<sup>H8492</sup>, and the oil<sup>H3323</sup>, which was commanded<sup>H4687</sup> to be given to the Levites<sup>H3881</sup>, and the singers<sup>H7891</sup>, and the porters<sup>H7778</sup>; and the offerings<sup>H8641</sup> of the priests<sup>H3548</sup>. 6 But in all this time was not I at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>: for in the two<sup>H8147</sup> and thirtieth<sup>H7970</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Artaxerxes<sup>H783</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> I unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and after<sup>H7093</sup> certain days<sup>H3117</sup> obtained I leave<sup>H7592</sup> of the king<sup>H4428,56</sup>. 7 And I came<sup>H935</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and understood<sup>H995</sup> of the evil<sup>H7451</sup> that Eliashib<sup>H475</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> for Tobiah<sup>H2900</sup>, in preparing<sup>H6213</sup> him a chamber<sup>H5393</sup> in the courts<sup>H2691</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>. 8 And it grieved<sup>H3415</sup> me sore<sup>H3966</sup>: therefore I cast forth<sup>H7993</sup> all the household<sup>H1004</sup> stuff<sup>H3627</sup> of Tobiah<sup>H2900</sup> out of<sup>H2351</sup> the chamber<sup>H3957</sup>. 9 Then I commanded<sup>H559</sup>, and they cleansed<sup>H2891</sup> the chambers<sup>H3957</sup>: and thither brought I again<sup>H7725</sup> the vessels<sup>H3627</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, with the meat offering<sup>H4503</sup> and the frankincense<sup>H3828</sup>.

10 And I perceived<sup>H3045</sup> that the portions<sup>H4521</sup> of the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> had not been given<sup>H5414</sup> them: for the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> and the singers<sup>H7891</sup>, that did<sup>H6213</sup> the work<sup>H4399</sup>, were fled<sup>H1272</sup> every one<sup>H376</sup> to his field<sup>H7704</sup>. 11 Then contended<sup>H7378</sup> I with the rulers<sup>H5461</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Why is the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> forsaken<sup>H5800</sup>? And I gathered them together<sup>H6908</sup>, and set<sup>H5975</sup> them in their place<sup>H5977,7</sup>. 12 Then brought<sup>H935</sup> all Judah<sup>H3063</sup> the tithe<sup>H4643</sup> of the corn<sup>H1715</sup> and the new wine<sup>H8492</sup> and the oil<sup>H3323</sup> unto the treasuries<sup>H214,8</sup>. 13 And I made treasurers<sup>H686</sup> over the treasuries<sup>H214</sup>, Shelemiah<sup>H8018</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> the scribe<sup>H5608</sup>, and of the Levites<sup>H3881</sup>, Pedaiah<sup>H6305</sup>: and next to them<sup>H3027</sup> was Hanan<sup>H2605</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zaccur<sup>H2139</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Mattaniah<sup>H4983</sup>: for they were counted<sup>H2803</sup> faithful<sup>H539</sup>, and their office was to distribute<sup>H2505</sup> unto their brethren<sup>H251,91011</sup>. 14 Remember<sup>H2142</sup> me, O my God<sup>H430</sup>, concerning this, and wipe not out<sup>H4229</sup> my good<sup>H2617</sup> deeds that I have done<sup>H6213</sup> for the house<sup>H1004</sup> of my God<sup>H430</sup>, and for the offices<sup>H4929</sup> thereof.<sup>1213</sup>

15 In those days<sup>H3117</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> I in Judah<sup>H3063</sup> some treading<sup>H1869</sup> wine presses<sup>H1660</sup> on the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup>, and bringing in<sup>H935</sup> sheaves<sup>H6194</sup>, and lading<sup>H6006</sup> asses<sup>H2543</sup>, as also wine<sup>H3196</sup>, grapes<sup>H6025</sup>, and figs<sup>H8384</sup>, and all manner of burdens<sup>H4853</sup>, which they brought<sup>H935</sup> into Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> on the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>: and I testified<sup>H5749</sup> against them in the day<sup>H3117</sup> wherein they sold<sup>H4376</sup> victuals<sup>H6718</sup>. 16 There dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> men of Tyre<sup>H6876</sup> also therein, which brought<sup>H935</sup> fish<sup>H1709,1709</sup>, and all manner of ware<sup>H4377</sup>, and sold<sup>H4376</sup> on the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> unto the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 17 Then I contended<sup>H7378</sup> with the nobles<sup>H2715</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, What evil<sup>H7451</sup> thing<sup>H1697</sup> is this that ye do<sup>H6213</sup>, and profane<sup>H2490</sup> the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>? 18 Did<sup>H6213</sup> not your fathers<sup>H1</sup> thus, and did<sup>H935</sup> not our God<sup>H430</sup> bring<sup>H935</sup> all this evil<sup>H7451</sup> upon us, and upon this city<sup>H5892</sup>? yet ye bring<sup>H935</sup> more<sup>H3254</sup> wrath<sup>H2740</sup> upon Israel<sup>H3478</sup> by profaning<sup>H2490</sup> the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup>. 19 And it came to pass, that when the gates<sup>H8179</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> began to be dark<sup>H6751</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup>, I commanded<sup>H559</sup> that the gates<sup>H817</sup> should be shut<sup>H5462</sup>, and charged<sup>H559</sup> that they should not be opened<sup>H6605</sup> till after<sup>H310</sup> the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup>: and some of my servants<sup>H5288</sup> set<sup>H5975</sup> I at the gates<sup>H8179</sup>, that there should no burden<sup>H4853</sup> be brought in<sup>H935</sup> on the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>. 20 So the merchants<sup>H7402</sup> and sellers<sup>H4376</sup> of all kind of ware<sup>H4465</sup> lodged<sup>H3885</sup> without<sup>H2351</sup> Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>.

once<sup>H6471</sup> or twice<sup>H8147</sup>. **21** Then I testified<sup>H5749</sup> against them, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Why lodge<sup>H3885</sup> ye about<sup>H5048</sup> the wall<sup>H2346</sup>? if ye do so again<sup>H8138</sup>, I will lay<sup>H7971</sup> hands<sup>H3027</sup> on you. From that time<sup>H6256</sup> forth came<sup>H935</sup> they no more on the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup>. <sup>14</sup> **22** And I commanded<sup>H559</sup> the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> that they should cleanse<sup>H2891</sup> themselves, and that they should come<sup>H935</sup> and keep<sup>H8104</sup> the gates<sup>H8179</sup>, to sanctify<sup>H6942</sup> the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>. Remember<sup>H2142</sup> me, O my God<sup>H430</sup>, concerning this also, and spare<sup>H2347</sup> me according to the greatness<sup>H7230</sup> of thy mercy<sup>H2617</sup>. <sup>15</sup>

**23** In those days<sup>H3117</sup> also saw<sup>H7200</sup> I Jews<sup>H3064</sup> that had married<sup>H3427</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup> of Ashdod<sup>H796</sup>, of Ammon<sup>H5984</sup>, and of Moab<sup>H4125</sup>. <sup>16</sup> **24** And their children<sup>H1121</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> half<sup>H2677</sup> in the speech of Ashdod<sup>H797</sup>, and could<sup>H5234</sup> not speak<sup>H1696</sup> in the Jews' language<sup>H3066</sup>, but according to the language<sup>H3956</sup> of each<sup>H5971</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup>. <sup>17</sup> **25** And I contended<sup>H7378</sup> with them, and cursed<sup>H7043</sup> them, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> certain<sup>H582</sup> of them, and plucked off their hair<sup>H4803</sup>, and made them swear<sup>H7650</sup> by God<sup>H430</sup>, saying, Ye shall not give<sup>H5414</sup> your daughters<sup>H1323</sup> unto their sons<sup>H1121</sup>, nor take<sup>H5375</sup> their daughters<sup>H1323</sup> unto your sons<sup>H1121</sup>, or for yourselves. <sup>19</sup> **26** Did not Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> sin<sup>H2398</sup> by these things? yet among many<sup>H7227</sup> nations<sup>H1471</sup> was there no king<sup>H4428</sup> like him, who was beloved<sup>H157</sup> of his God<sup>H430</sup>, and God<sup>H430</sup> made<sup>H5414</sup> him king<sup>H4428</sup> over all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: nevertheless even him<sup>H1571</sup> did outlandish<sup>H5237</sup> women<sup>H802</sup> cause to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. **27** Shall we then hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto you to do<sup>H6213</sup> all this great<sup>H1419</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>, to transgress<sup>H4603</sup> against our God<sup>H430</sup> in marrying<sup>H3427</sup> strange<sup>H5237</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup>? **28** And one of the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Joiada<sup>H3111</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Eliashib<sup>H475</sup> the high<sup>H1419</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup>, was son in law<sup>H2860</sup> to Sanballat<sup>H5571</sup> the Horonite<sup>H2772</sup>: therefore I chased<sup>H1272</sup> him from me. **29** Remember<sup>H2142</sup> them, O my God<sup>H430</sup>, because they have defiled<sup>H1352</sup> the priesthood<sup>H3550</sup>, and the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> of the priesthood<sup>H3550</sup>, and of the Levites<sup>H3881</sup>. <sup>20</sup> **30** Thus cleansed<sup>H2891</sup> I them from all strangers<sup>H5236</sup>, and appointed<sup>H5975</sup> the wards<sup>H4931</sup> of the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and the Levites<sup>H3881</sup>, every one<sup>H376</sup> in his business<sup>H4399</sup>; **31** And for the wood<sup>H6086</sup> offering<sup>H7133</sup>, at times<sup>H6256</sup> appointed<sup>H2163</sup>, and for the firstfruits<sup>H1061</sup>. Remember<sup>H2142</sup> me, O my God<sup>H430</sup>, for good<sup>H2896</sup>.
