**1** My son<sup>H1121</sup>, if thou wilt receive<sup>H3947</sup> my words<sup>H561</sup>, and hide<sup>H6845</sup> my commandments<sup>H4687</sup> with thee; **2** So that thou incline<sup>H7181</sup> thine ear<sup>H241</sup> unto wisdom<sup>H2451</sup>, and apply<sup>H5186</sup> thine heart<sup>H3820</sup> to understanding<sup>H8394</sup>; **3** Yea, if thou criest<sup>H7121</sup> after knowledge<sup>H998</sup>, and liftest up<sup>H5414</sup> thy voice<sup>H6963</sup> for understanding<sup>H8394</sup>;<sup>1</sup> **4** If thou seekest<sup>H1245</sup> her as silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and searchest<sup>H2664</sup> for her as for hid treasures<sup>H4301</sup>; **5** Then shalt thou understand<sup>H995</sup> the fear<sup>H3374</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and find<sup>H4672</sup> the knowledge<sup>H1847</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>. **6** For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> giveth<sup>H5414</sup> wisdom<sup>H2451</sup>: out of his mouth<sup>H6310</sup> cometh knowledge<sup>H1847</sup> and understanding<sup>H8394</sup>. **7** He layeth up<sup>H6845 H6845</sup> sound wisdom<sup>H8454</sup> for the righteous<sup>H3477</sup>: he is a buckler<sup>H4043</sup> to them that walk<sup>H1980</sup> uprightly<sup>H8537</sup>. **8** He keepeth<sup>H5341</sup> the paths<sup>H734</sup> of judgment<sup>H4941</sup>, and preserveth<sup>H8104</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> of his saints<sup>H2623</sup>. **9** Then shalt thou understand<sup>H995</sup>

**10** When wisdom<sup>H2451</sup> entereth<sup>H935</sup> into thine heart<sup>H3820</sup>, and knowledge<sup>H1847</sup> is pleasant<sup>H5276</sup> unto thy soul<sup>H5315</sup>; **11** Discretion<sup>H4209</sup> shall preserve<sup>H8104</sup> thee, understanding<sup>H8394</sup> shall keep<sup>H5341</sup> thee: **12** To deliver<sup>H5337</sup> thee from the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the evil<sup>H7451</sup> man, from the man<sup>H376</sup> that speaketh<sup>H1696</sup> froward things<sup>H8419</sup>; **13** Who leave<sup>H5800</sup> the paths<sup>H734</sup> of uprightness<sup>H3476</sup>, to walk<sup>H3212</sup> in the ways<sup>H1870</sup> of darkness<sup>H2822</sup>; **14** Who rejoice<sup>H8056</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>, and delight<sup>H1523</sup> in the frowardness<sup>H8419</sup> of the wicked<sup>H7451</sup>; **15** Whose ways<sup>H734</sup> are crooked<sup>H6141</sup>, and they froward<sup>H3868</sup> in their paths<sup>H4570</sup>: **16** To deliver<sup>H5337</sup> thee from the strange<sup>H2114</sup> woman<sup>H802</sup>, even from the stranger<sup>H5237</sup> which flattereth<sup>H2505</sup> with her words<sup>H561</sup>; **17** Which forsaketh<sup>H5800</sup> the guide<sup>H441</sup> of her youth<sup>H5271</sup>, and forgetteth<sup>H7911</sup> the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> of her God<sup>H430</sup>. **18** For her house<sup>H1004</sup> inclineth<sup>H7743</sup> unto death<sup>H4194</sup>, and her paths<sup>H4570</sup> unto the dead<sup>H7496</sup>. **19** None that go<sup>H935</sup> unto her return again<sup>H7725</sup>, neither take they hold<sup>H5381</sup> of the paths<sup>H734</sup> of life<sup>H2416</sup>. **20** That thou mayest walk<sup>H3212</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> of good<sup>H2896</sup> men, and keep<sup>H8104</sup> the paths<sup>H734</sup> of the righteous<sup>H6662</sup>. **21** For the upright<sup>H3477</sup> shall dwell<sup>H7931</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup>, and the perfect<sup>H8549</sup> shall remain<sup>H3498</sup> in it. **22** But the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> shall be cout off<sup>H3772</sup> from the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and the transgressors<sup>H898</sup> shall be rooted out<sup>H5255</sup> of it.<sup>2</sup>
