

# Proverbs 8

1 Doth not wisdom<sup>H2451</sup> cry<sup>H7121</sup>? and understanding<sup>H8394</sup> put forth<sup>H5414</sup> her voice<sup>H6963</sup>? 2 She standeth<sup>H5324</sup> in the top<sup>H7218</sup> of high places<sup>H4791</sup>, by the way<sup>H1870</sup> in the places<sup>H1004</sup> of the paths<sup>H5410</sup>. 3 She crieth<sup>H7442</sup> at<sup>H3027</sup> the gates<sup>H8179</sup>, at the entry<sup>H6310</sup> of the city<sup>H7176</sup>, at the coming<sup>H3996</sup> in at the doors<sup>H6607</sup>. 4 Unto you, O men<sup>H376</sup>, I call<sup>H7121</sup>; and my voice<sup>H6963</sup> is to the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>. 5 O ye simple<sup>H6612</sup>, understand<sup>H995</sup> wisdom<sup>H6195</sup>: and, ye fools<sup>H3684</sup>, be ye of an understanding<sup>H995</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup>. 6 Hear<sup>H8085</sup>, for I will speak<sup>H1696</sup> of excellent things<sup>H5057</sup>; and the opening<sup>H4669</sup> of my lips<sup>H8193</sup> shall be right things<sup>H4339</sup>. 7 For my mouth<sup>H2441</sup> shall speak<sup>H1897</sup> truth<sup>H571</sup>; and wickedness<sup>H7562</sup> is an abomination<sup>H8441</sup> to my lips<sup>H8193</sup>. 8 All the words<sup>H561</sup> of my mouth<sup>H6310</sup> are in righteousness<sup>H6664</sup>; there is nothing froward<sup>H6617</sup> or perverse<sup>H6141</sup> in them. 9 They are all plain<sup>H5228</sup> to him that understandeth<sup>H995</sup>, and right<sup>H3477</sup> to them that find<sup>H4672</sup> knowledge<sup>H1847</sup>. 10 Receive<sup>H3947</sup> my instruction<sup>H4148</sup>, and not silver<sup>H3701</sup>; and knowledge<sup>H1847</sup> rather than choice<sup>H977</sup> gold<sup>H2742</sup>. 11 For wisdom<sup>H2451</sup> is better<sup>H2896</sup> than rubies<sup>H6443</sup>, and all the things that may be desired<sup>H2656</sup> are not to be compared<sup>H7737</sup> to it.

12 I wisdom<sup>H2451</sup> dwell<sup>H7931</sup> with prudence<sup>H6195</sup>, and find out<sup>H4672</sup> knowledge<sup>H1847</sup> of witty inventions<sup>H4209</sup>. 13 The fear<sup>H3374</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is to hate<sup>H8130</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>: pride<sup>H1344</sup>, and arrogancy<sup>H1347</sup>, and the evil<sup>H7451</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>, and the froward<sup>H8419</sup> mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, do I hate<sup>H8130</sup>. 14 Counsel<sup>H6098</sup> is mine, and sound wisdom<sup>H8454</sup>: I am understanding<sup>H998</sup>, I have strength<sup>H1369</sup>. 15 By me kings<sup>H4428</sup> reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and princes<sup>H7336</sup> decree<sup>H2710</sup> justice<sup>H6664</sup>. 16 By me princes<sup>H8269</sup> rule<sup>H8323</sup>, and nobles<sup>H5081</sup>, even all the judges<sup>H8199</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 17 I love<sup>H157</sup> them that love<sup>H157</sup> me; and those that seek me early<sup>H7836</sup> shall find<sup>H4672</sup> me. 18 Riches<sup>H6239</sup> and honour<sup>H3519</sup> are with me; yea, durable<sup>H6276</sup> riches<sup>H1952</sup> and righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>. 19 My fruit<sup>H6529</sup> is better<sup>H2896</sup> than gold<sup>H2742</sup>, yea, than fine gold<sup>H6337</sup>; and my revenue<sup>H8393</sup> than choice<sup>H977</sup> silver<sup>H3701</sup>. 20 I lead<sup>H1980</sup> in the way<sup>H734</sup> of righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>, in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of the paths<sup>H5410</sup> of judgment<sup>H4941</sup>. 21 That I may cause those that love<sup>H157</sup> me to inherit<sup>H5157</sup> substance<sup>H3426</sup>, and I will fill<sup>H4390</sup> their treasures<sup>H214</sup>.

22 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> possessed<sup>H7069</sup> me in the beginning<sup>H7225</sup> of his way<sup>H1870</sup>, before<sup>H6924</sup> his works<sup>H4659</sup> of old. 23 I was set up<sup>H5258</sup> from everlasting<sup>H5769</sup>, from the beginning<sup>H7218</sup>, or ever<sup>H6924</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup> was. 24 When there were no depths<sup>H8415</sup>, I was brought forth<sup>H2342</sup>, when there were no fountains<sup>H4599</sup> abounding<sup>H3513</sup> with water<sup>H4325</sup>. 25 Before the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> were settled<sup>H2883</sup>, before<sup>H6440</sup> the hills<sup>H1389</sup> was I brought forth<sup>H2342</sup>. 26 While as yet he had not made<sup>H6213</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup>, nor the fields<sup>H2351</sup>, nor the highest part<sup>H7218</sup> of the dust<sup>H6083</sup> of the world<sup>H8398</sup>. 27 When he prepared<sup>H3559</sup> the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>, I was there: when he set<sup>H2710</sup> a compass<sup>H2329</sup> upon the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the depth<sup>H8415</sup>. 28 When he established<sup>H553</sup> the clouds<sup>H7834</sup> above<sup>H4605</sup>: when he strengthened<sup>H5810</sup> the fountains<sup>H5869</sup> of the deep<sup>H8415</sup>. 29 When he gave<sup>H7760</sup> to the sea<sup>H3220</sup> his decree<sup>H2706</sup>, that the waters<sup>H4325</sup> should not pass<sup>H5674</sup> his commandment<sup>H6310</sup>: when he appointed<sup>H2710</sup> the foundations<sup>H4144</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 30 Then I was by him<sup>H681</sup>, as one brought up<sup>H525</sup> with him: and I was daily<sup>H3117</sup> his delight<sup>H8191</sup>, rejoicing<sup>H7832</sup> always<sup>H6256</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> him; 31 Rejoicing<sup>H7832</sup> in the habitable part<sup>H8398</sup> of his earth<sup>H776</sup>; and my delights<sup>H8191</sup> were with the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>.

32 Now therefore hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto me, O ye children<sup>H1121</sup>: for blessed<sup>H835</sup> are they that keep<sup>H8104</sup> my ways<sup>H1870</sup>. 33 Hear<sup>H8085</sup> instruction<sup>H4148</sup>, and be wise<sup>H2449</sup>, and refuse<sup>H6544</sup> it not. 34 Blessed<sup>H835</sup> is the man<sup>H120</sup> that heareth<sup>H8085</sup> me, watching<sup>H8245</sup> daily<sup>H3117</sup> at my gates<sup>H1817</sup>, waiting<sup>H8104</sup> at the posts<sup>H4201</sup> of my doors<sup>H6607</sup>. 35 For whoso findeth<sup>H4672</sup> me findeth<sup>H4672</sup> life<sup>H2416</sup>, and shall obtain<sup>H6329</sup> favour<sup>H7522</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 36 But he that sinneth<sup>H2398</sup> against me wrongeth<sup>H2554</sup> his own soul<sup>H5315</sup>: all they that hate<sup>H8130</sup> me love<sup>H157</sup> death<sup>H4194</sup>.
