

# Psalms 102

1 A Prayer<sup>H8605</sup> of the afflicted<sup>H6041</sup>, when he is overwhelmed<sup>H5848</sup>, and poureth out<sup>H8210</sup> his complaint<sup>H7879</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. Hear<sup>H8085</sup> my prayer<sup>H8605</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and let my cry<sup>H7775</sup> come<sup>H935</sup> unto thee.<sup>1</sup> 2 Hide<sup>H5641</sup> not thy face<sup>H6440</sup> from me in the day<sup>H3117</sup> when I am in trouble<sup>H6862</sup>; incline<sup>H5186</sup> thine ear<sup>H241</sup> unto me: in the day<sup>H3117</sup> when I call<sup>H7121</sup> answer<sup>H6030</sup> me speedily<sup>H4118</sup>. 3 For my days<sup>H3117</sup> are consumed<sup>H3615</sup> like smoke<sup>H6227</sup>, and my bones<sup>H6106</sup> are burned<sup>H2787</sup> as an hearth<sup>H4168</sup>. 4 My heart<sup>H3820</sup> is smitten<sup>H5221</sup>, and withered<sup>H3001</sup> like grass<sup>H6212</sup>; so that I forget<sup>H7911</sup> to eat<sup>H398</sup> my bread<sup>H3899</sup>. 5 By reason of the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of my groaning<sup>H585</sup> my bones<sup>H6106</sup> cleave<sup>H1692</sup> to my skin<sup>H1320</sup>. 6 I am like<sup>H1819</sup> a pelican<sup>H6893</sup> of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>: I am like an owl<sup>H3563</sup> of the desert<sup>H2723</sup>. 7 I watch<sup>H8245</sup>, and am as a sparrow<sup>H6833</sup> alone<sup>H909</sup> upon the house top<sup>H1406</sup>. 8 Mine enemies<sup>H341</sup> reproach<sup>H2778</sup> me all the day<sup>H3117</sup>; and they that are mad<sup>H1984</sup> against me are sworn<sup>H7650</sup> against me. 9 For I have eaten<sup>H398</sup> ashes<sup>H665</sup> like bread<sup>H3899</sup>, and mingled<sup>H4537</sup> my drink<sup>H8249</sup> with weeping<sup>H1065</sup>, 10 Because<sup>H6440</sup> of thine indignation<sup>H2195</sup> and thy wrath<sup>H7110</sup>: for thou hast lifted me up<sup>H5375</sup>, and cast me down<sup>H7993</sup>. 11 My days<sup>H3117</sup> are like a shadow<sup>H6738</sup> that declineth<sup>H5186</sup>; and I am withered<sup>H3001</sup> like grass<sup>H6212</sup>.

12 But thou, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, shalt endure<sup>H3427</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>; and thy remembrance<sup>H2143</sup> unto all<sup>H1755</sup> generations<sup>H1755</sup>. 13 Thou shalt arise<sup>H6965</sup>, and have mercy<sup>H7355</sup> upon Zion<sup>H6726</sup>: for the time<sup>H6256</sup> to favour<sup>H2603</sup> her, yea, the set time<sup>H4150</sup>, is come<sup>H935</sup>. 14 For thy servants<sup>H5650</sup> take pleasure<sup>H7521</sup> in her stones<sup>H68</sup>, and favour<sup>H2603</sup> the dust<sup>H6083</sup> thereof. 15 So the heathen<sup>H1471</sup> shall fear<sup>H3372</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> thy glory<sup>H3519</sup>. 16 When the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall build up<sup>H1129</sup> Zion<sup>H6726</sup>, he shall appear<sup>H7200</sup> in his glory<sup>H3519</sup>. 17 He will regard<sup>H6437</sup> the prayer<sup>H8605</sup> of the destitute<sup>H6199</sup>, and not despise<sup>H959</sup> their prayer<sup>H8605</sup>. 18 This shall be written<sup>H3789</sup> for the generation<sup>H1755</sup> to come<sup>H314</sup>: and the people<sup>H5971</sup> which shall be created<sup>H1254</sup> shall praise<sup>H1984</sup> the LORD<sup>H3050</sup>. 19 For he hath looked down<sup>H8259</sup> from the height<sup>H4791</sup> of his sanctuary<sup>H6944</sup>; from heaven<sup>H8064</sup> did the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> behold<sup>H5027</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup>; 20 To hear<sup>H8085</sup> the groaning<sup>H603</sup> of the prisoner<sup>H615</sup>; to loose<sup>H6605</sup> those that are appointed<sup>H1121</sup> to death<sup>H8546</sup>, 21 To declare<sup>H5608</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in Zion<sup>H6726</sup>, and his praise<sup>H8416</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>; 22 When the people<sup>H5971</sup> are gathered<sup>H6908</sup> together<sup>H3162</sup>, and the kingdoms<sup>H4467</sup>, to serve<sup>H5647</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

23 He weakened<sup>H6031</sup> my strength<sup>H3581</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup>; he shortened<sup>H7114</sup> my days<sup>H3117</sup>. 24 I said<sup>H559</sup>, O my God<sup>H410</sup>, take me not away<sup>H5927</sup> in the midst<sup>H2677</sup> of my days<sup>H3117</sup>: thy years<sup>H8141</sup> are throughout all<sup>H1755</sup> generations<sup>H1755</sup>. 25 Of old<sup>H6440</sup> hast thou laid the foundation<sup>H3245</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>: and the heavens<sup>H8064</sup> are the work<sup>H4639</sup> of thy hands<sup>H3027</sup>. 26 They shall perish<sup>H6</sup>, but thou shalt endure<sup>H5975</sup>: yea, all of them shall wax old<sup>H1086</sup> like a garment<sup>H899</sup>; as a vesture<sup>H3830</sup> shalt thou change<sup>H2498</sup> them, and they shall be changed<sup>H2498</sup>. 27 But thou art the same, and thy years<sup>H8141</sup> shall have no end<sup>H8552</sup>. 28 The children<sup>H1121</sup> of thy servants<sup>H5650</sup> shall continue<sup>H7931</sup>, and their seed<sup>H2233</sup> shall be established<sup>H3559</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee.
