## Psalm 107

**1** O give thanks<sup>H3034</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, for he is good<sup>H2896</sup>: for his mercy<sup>H2617</sup> endureth for ever<sup>H5769</sup>. **2** Let the redeemed<sup>H1350</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> say<sup>H559</sup> so, whom he hath redeemed<sup>H1350</sup> from the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the enemy<sup>H6862</sup>; **3** And gathered<sup>H6908</sup> them out of the lands<sup>H776</sup>, from the east<sup>H4217</sup>, and from the west<sup>H4628</sup>, from the north<sup>H6828</sup>, and from the south<sup>H3220</sup>.<sup>1</sup> **4** They wandered<sup>H8582</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> in a solitary<sup>H3452</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>; they found<sup>H4672</sup> no city<sup>H5892</sup> to dwell<sup>H4186</sup> in. **5** Hungry<sup>H7457</sup> and thirsty<sup>H6771</sup>, their soul<sup>H5315</sup> fainted<sup>H5848</sup> in them. **6** Then they cried<sup>H6817</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in their trouble<sup>H6862</sup>, and he delivered<sup>H5337</sup> them out of their distresses<sup>H4691</sup>. **7** And he led them forth<sup>H1869</sup> by the right<sup>H3477</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>, that they might go<sup>H3212</sup> to a city<sup>H5892</sup> of habitation<sup>H4186</sup>. **8** Oh that men would praise<sup>H3034</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for his goodness<sup>H2617</sup>, and for his wonderful works<sup>H6381</sup> to the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>! **9** For he satisfieth<sup>H7646</sup> the longing<sup>H8264</sup> soul<sup>H5315</sup>, and filleth<sup>H4390</sup> the hungry<sup>H7457</sup> soul<sup>H5315</sup> with goodness<sup>H2896</sup>.

**10** Such as sit<sup>H3427</sup> in darkness<sup>H2822</sup> and in the shadow of death<sup>H6757</sup>, being bound<sup>H615</sup> in affliction<sup>H6040</sup> and iron<sup>H1270</sup>; **11** Because they rebelled<sup>H4784</sup> against the words<sup>H561</sup> of God<sup>H410</sup>, and contemned<sup>H5006</sup> the counsel<sup>H6098</sup> of the most High<sup>H5945</sup>: **12** Therefore he brought down<sup>H3665</sup> their heart<sup>H3820</sup> with labour<sup>H5999</sup>; they fell down<sup>H3782</sup>, and there was none to help<sup>H5826</sup>. **13** Then they cried<sup>H2199</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in their trouble<sup>H6862</sup>, and he saved<sup>H3467</sup> them out of their distresses<sup>H4691</sup>. **14** He brought them out<sup>H3318</sup> of darkness<sup>H2822</sup> and the shadow of death<sup>H6757</sup>, and brake<sup>H5423</sup> their bands<sup>H4147</sup> in sunder<sup>H5423</sup>. **15** Oh that men would praise<sup>H3034</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for his goodness<sup>H2617</sup>, and for his wonderful works<sup>H6381</sup> to the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>! **16** For he hath broken<sup>H7665</sup> the gates<sup>H1817</sup> of brass<sup>H5178</sup>, and cut<sup>H1438</sup> the bars<sup>H1280</sup> of iron<sup>H1270</sup> in sunder<sup>H1438</sup>.

**17** Fools<sup>H191</sup> because<sup>H1870</sup> of their transgression<sup>H6588</sup>, and because of their iniquities<sup>H5771</sup>, are afflicted<sup>H6031</sup>. **18** Their soul<sup>H5315</sup> abhorreth<sup>H8581</sup> all manner of meat<sup>H400</sup>; and they draw near<sup>H5060</sup> unto the gates<sup>H8179</sup> of death<sup>H4194</sup>. **19** Then they cry<sup>H2199</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in their trouble<sup>H6862</sup>, and he saveth<sup>H3467</sup> them out of their distresses<sup>H4691</sup>. **20** He sent<sup>H7971</sup> his word<sup>H1697</sup>, and healed<sup>H7495</sup> them, and delivered<sup>H4422</sup> them from their destructions<sup>H7825</sup>. **21** Oh that men would praise<sup>H3034</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for his goodness<sup>H2617</sup>, and for his wonderful works<sup>H6381</sup> to the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>! **22** And let them sacrifice<sup>H2076</sup> the sacrifices<sup>H2077</sup> of thanksgiving<sup>H8426</sup>, and declare<sup>H5608</sup> his works<sup>H4639</sup> with rejoicing<sup>H7440.2</sup>

**23** They that go down<sup>H3381</sup> to the sea<sup>H3220</sup> in ships<sup>H591</sup>, that do<sup>H6213</sup> business<sup>H4399</sup> in great<sup>H7227</sup> waters<sup>H4325</sup>; **24** These see<sup>H7200</sup> the works<sup>H4639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and his wonders<sup>H6381</sup> in the deep<sup>H4688</sup>. **25** For he commandeth<sup>H559</sup>, and raiseth<sup>H5975</sup> the stormy<sup>H5591</sup> wind<sup>H7307</sup>, which lifteth up<sup>H7311</sup> the waves<sup>H1530</sup> thereof.<sup>3</sup> **26** They mount up<sup>H5927</sup> to the heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, they go down<sup>H3381</sup> again to the depths<sup>H8415</sup>: their soul<sup>H5315</sup> is melted<sup>H4127</sup> because of trouble<sup>H7451</sup>. **27** They reel to and fro<sup>H2287</sup>, and stagger<sup>H5128</sup> like a drunken man<sup>H7910</sup>, and are at their wits'<sup>H2451</sup> end<sup>H1104.4</sup> **28** Then they cry<sup>H6817</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in their trouble<sup>H6862</sup>, and he bringeth them out<sup>H3318</sup> of their distresses<sup>H4691</sup>. **29** He maketh<sup>H6965</sup> the storm<sup>H5591</sup> a calm<sup>H1827</sup>, so that the waves<sup>H1530</sup> thereof are still<sup>H2814</sup>. **30** Then are they glad<sup>H8055</sup> because they be quiet<sup>H8367</sup>; so he bringeth<sup>H5148</sup> them unto their desired<sup>H2656</sup> haven<sup>H4231</sup>. **31** Oh that men would praise<sup>H3034</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for his goodness<sup>H2617</sup>, and for his wonderful works<sup>H6381</sup> to the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>! **32** Let them exalt<sup>H7311</sup> him also in the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and praise<sup>H1984</sup> him in the assembly<sup>H4186</sup> of the elders<sup>H2205</sup>.

**33** He turneth<sup>H7760</sup> rivers<sup>H5104</sup> into a wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>, and the watersprings<sup>H4325 H4161</sup> into dry ground<sup>H6774</sup>; **34** A fruitful<sup>H6529</sup> land<sup>H776</sup> into barrenness<sup>H4420</sup>, for the wickedness<sup>H7451</sup> of them that dwell<sup>H3427</sup> therein.<sup>5</sup> **35** He turneth<sup>H7760</sup> the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> into a standing<sup>H98</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup>, and dry<sup>H6723</sup> ground<sup>H776</sup> into watersprings<sup>H4325 H4161</sup>. **36** And there he maketh the hungry<sup>H7457</sup> to dwell<sup>H3427</sup>, that they may prepare<sup>H3559</sup> a city<sup>H5892</sup> for habitation<sup>H4186</sup>; **37** And sow<sup>H2232</sup> the fields<sup>H7704</sup>, and plant<sup>H5193</sup> vineyards<sup>H3754</sup>, which may yield<sup>H6213</sup> fruits<sup>H6529</sup> of increase<sup>H8393</sup>. **38** He blesseth<sup>H1288</sup> them

also, so that they are multiplied<sup>H7235</sup> greatly<sup>H3966</sup>; and suffereth<sup>H4591</sup> not their cattle<sup>H929</sup> to decrease<sup>H4591</sup>. **39** Again, they are minished<sup>H4591</sup> and brought low<sup>H7817</sup> through oppression<sup>H6115</sup>, affliction<sup>H7451</sup>, and sorrow<sup>H3015</sup>. **40** He poureth<sup>H8210</sup> contempt<sup>H937</sup> upon princes<sup>H5081</sup>, and causeth them to wander<sup>H8582</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H8414</sup>, where there is no way<sup>H1870.6</sup> **41** Yet setteth he the poor<sup>H34</sup> on high<sup>H7682</sup> from affliction<sup>H6040</sup>, and maketh<sup>H7760</sup> him families<sup>H4940</sup> like a flock<sup>H6629.7</sup> **42** The righteous<sup>H3477</sup> shall see<sup>H7200</sup> it, and rejoice<sup>H8055</sup>: and all iniquity<sup>H5766</sup> shall stop<sup>H7092</sup> her mouth<sup>H6310</sup>. **43** Whoso is wise<sup>H2450</sup>, and will observe<sup>H8104</sup> these things, even they shall understand<sup>H995</sup> the lovingkindness<sup>H2617</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
