1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup> upon Sheminith<sup>H8067</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. Help<sup>H3467</sup>, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; for the godly man<sup>H2623</sup> ceaseth<sup>H1584</sup>; for the faithful<sup>H539</sup> fail<sup>H6461</sup> from among the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>. 2 They speak<sup>H1696</sup> vanity<sup>H7723</sup> every one<sup>H376</sup> with his neighbour<sup>H7453</sup>: with flattering<sup>H2513</sup> lips<sup>H8193</sup> and with a double<sup>H3820</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup> do they speak<sup>H1696</sup>. 3 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall cut off<sup>H3772</sup> all flattering<sup>H2513</sup> lips<sup>H8193</sup>, and the tongue<sup>H3956</sup> that speaketh<sup>H1696</sup> proud<sup>H1419</sup> things:<sup>4</sup> 4 Who have said<sup>H559</sup>, With our tongue<sup>H3956</sup> will we prevail<sup>H1396</sup>; our lips<sup>H8193</sup> are our own: who is lord<sup>H113</sup> over us?<sup>5</sup> 5 For the oppression<sup>H7701</sup> of the poor<sup>H6041</sup>, for the sighing<sup>H603</sup> of the needy<sup>H34</sup>, now will I arise<sup>H6965</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; I will set<sup>H7896</sup> him in safety<sup>H3468</sup> from him that puffeth<sup>H6315</sup> at him.<sup>6</sup> 6 The words<sup>H565</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> are pure<sup>H2889</sup> words<sup>H565</sup>: as silver<sup>H3701</sup> tried<sup>H6884</sup> in a furnace<sup>H5948</sup> of earth<sup>H776</sup>, purified<sup>H2212</sup> seven times<sup>H7659</sup>. 7 Thou shalt keep<sup>H8104</sup> them, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, thou shalt preserve<sup>H5341</sup> them from this<sup>H2098</sup> generation<sup>H1755</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 8 The wicked<sup>H7563</sup> walk<sup>H1980</sup> on every side<sup>H5439</sup>, when the vilest<sup>H2149</sup> men<sup>H1121</sup> are exalted<sup>H7311</sup>.
