I will lift up^{H5375} mine eyes^{H5869} unto the hills^{H2022}, from whence^{H370} cometh^{H935} my help^{H5828}.¹ **2** My help^{H5828} cometh from the LORD^{H3068}, which made^{H6213} heaven^{H8064} and earth^{H776}. **3** He will not suffer^{H5414} thy foot^{H7272} to be moved^{H4132}: he that keepeth^{H8104} thee will not slumber^{H5123}. **4** Behold, he that keepeth^{H8104} Israel^{H3478} shall neither slumber^{H5123} nor sleep^{H3462}. **5** The LORD^{H3068} is thy keeper^{H8104}: the LORD^{H3068} is thy shade^{H6738} upon thy right^{H3225} hand^{H3027}. **6** The sun^{H8121} shall not smite^{H5221} thee by day^{H3119}, nor the moon^{H3394} by night^{H3915}. **7** The LORD^{H3068} shall preserve^{H8104} thee from all evil^{H7451}: he shall preserve^{H8104} thy soul^{H5315}. **8** The LORD^{H3068} shall preserve^{H8104} thy going out^{H3318} and thy coming in^{H935} from this time forth, and even for^{H5704} evermore^{H5769}.
