**1** By the rivers<sup>H5104</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, there we sat down<sup>H3427</sup>, yea, we wept<sup>H1058</sup>, when we remembered<sup>H2142</sup> Zion<sup>H6726</sup>. **2** We hanged<sup>H8518</sup> our harps<sup>H3658</sup> upon the willows<sup>H6155</sup> in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> thereof. **3** For there they that carried us away captive<sup>H7617</sup> required<sup>H7592</sup> of us a song<sup>H1697 H7892</sup>; and they that wasted<sup>H8437</sup> us required of us mirth<sup>H8057</sup>, saying, Sing<sup>H7891</sup> us one of the songs<sup>H7892</sup> of Zion<sup>H6726</sup>. **12** **4** How shall we sing<sup>H7891</sup> the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> song<sup>H7892</sup> in a strange<sup>H5236</sup> land<sup>H127?3</sup> **5** If I forget<sup>H7911</sup> thee, O Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, let my right hand<sup>H3225</sup> forget<sup>H7911</sup> her cunning. **6** If I do not remember<sup>H2142</sup> thee, let my tongue<sup>H3956</sup> cleave<sup>H1692</sup> to the roof of my mouth<sup>H2441</sup>; if I prefer<sup>H5927</sup> not Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> above my chief<sup>H7218</sup> joy<sup>H8057</sup>. **4**

**7** Remember<sup>H2142</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Edom<sup>H123</sup> in the day<sup>H3117</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>; who said<sup>H559</sup>, Rase<sup>H6168</sup> it, rase<sup>H6168</sup> it, even to the foundation<sup>H3247</sup> thereof.<sup>5</sup> **8** O daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, who art to be destroyed<sup>H7703</sup>, happy<sup>H835</sup> shall he be, that rewardeth<sup>H7999</sup> thee as thou hast served<sup>H1580 H1576</sup> us.<sup>67</sup> **9** Happy<sup>H835</sup> shall he be, that taketh<sup>H270</sup> and dasheth<sup>H5310</sup> thy little ones<sup>H5768</sup> against the stones<sup>H5553</sup>.<sup>8</sup>
