

# Psalm 139

1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, thou hast searched<sup>H2713</sup> me, and known<sup>H3045</sup> me. 2 Thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> my downsitting<sup>H3427</sup> and mine uprising<sup>H6965</sup>, thou understandest<sup>H995</sup> my thought<sup>H7454</sup> afar off<sup>H7350</sup>. 3 Thou compassest<sup>H2219</sup> my path<sup>H734</sup> and my lying down<sup>H7252</sup>, and art acquainted<sup>H5532</sup> with all my ways<sup>H1870</sup>. 4 For there is not a word<sup>H4405</sup> in my tongue<sup>H3956</sup>, but, lo, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> it altogether. 5 Thou hast beset<sup>H6696</sup> me behind<sup>H268</sup> and before<sup>H6924</sup>, and laid<sup>H7896</sup> thine hand<sup>H3709</sup> upon me. 6 Such knowledge<sup>H1847</sup> is too wonderful<sup>H6383 H6383</sup> for me; it is high<sup>H7682</sup>, I cannot<sup>H3201</sup> attain unto it.

7 Whither shall I go<sup>H3212</sup> from thy spirit<sup>H7307</sup>? or whither shall I flee<sup>H1272</sup> from thy presence<sup>H6440</sup>? 8 If I ascend up<sup>H5266</sup> into heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, thou art there: if I make my bed<sup>H3331</sup> in hell<sup>H7585</sup>, behold, thou art there. 9 If I take<sup>H5375</sup> the wings<sup>H3671</sup> of the morning<sup>H7837</sup>, and dwell<sup>H7931</sup> in the uttermost parts<sup>H319</sup> of the sea<sup>H3220</sup>; 10 Even there shall thy hand<sup>H3027</sup> lead<sup>H5148</sup> me, and thy right hand<sup>H3225</sup> shall hold<sup>H270</sup> me. 11 If I say<sup>H559</sup>, Surely the darkness<sup>H2822</sup> shall cover<sup>H7779</sup> me; even the night<sup>H3915</sup> shall be light<sup>H216</sup> about me<sup>H1157</sup>. 12 Yea, the darkness<sup>H2822</sup> hideth<sup>H2821</sup> not from thee; but the night<sup>H3915</sup> shineth<sup>H215</sup> as the day<sup>H3117</sup>: the darkness<sup>H2825</sup> and the light<sup>H219</sup> are both alike to thee. 23 13 For thou hast possessed<sup>H7069</sup> my reins<sup>H3629</sup>: thou hast covered<sup>H5526</sup> me in my mother's<sup>H517</sup> womb<sup>H990</sup>. 14 I will praise<sup>H3034</sup> thee; for I am fearfully<sup>H3372</sup> and wonderfully made<sup>H6395</sup>: marvellous<sup>H6381</sup> are thy works<sup>H4639</sup>; and that my soul<sup>H5315</sup> knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> right well<sup>H3966</sup>. 4 15 My substance<sup>H6108</sup> was not hid<sup>H3582</sup> from thee, when I was made<sup>H6213</sup> in secret<sup>H5643</sup>, and curiously wrought<sup>H7551</sup> in the lowest parts<sup>H8482</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 5 16 Thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> did see<sup>H7200</sup> my substance, yet being unperfect<sup>H1564</sup>; and in thy book<sup>H5612</sup> all my members were written<sup>H3789</sup>, which in continuance<sup>H3117</sup> were fashioned<sup>H3335</sup>, when as yet there was none<sup>H259</sup> of them. 67

17 How precious<sup>H3365</sup> also are thy thoughts<sup>H7454</sup> unto me, O God<sup>H410</sup>! how great<sup>H6105</sup> is the sum<sup>H7218</sup> of them! 18 If I should count<sup>H5608</sup> them, they are more in number<sup>H7235</sup> than the sand<sup>H2344</sup>: when I awake<sup>H6974</sup>, I am still<sup>H5750</sup> with thee. 19 Surely thou wilt slay<sup>H6991</sup> the wicked<sup>H7563</sup>, O God<sup>H433</sup>: depart<sup>H5493</sup> from me therefore, ye bloody<sup>H1818</sup> men<sup>H582</sup>. 20 For they speak<sup>H559</sup> against thee wickedly<sup>H4209</sup>, and thine enemies<sup>H6145</sup> take<sup>H5375</sup> thy name in vain<sup>H7723</sup>. 21 Do not I hate<sup>H8130</sup> them, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that hate<sup>H8130</sup> thee? and am not I grieved<sup>H6962</sup> with those that rise up<sup>H8618</sup> against thee? 22 I hate<sup>H8130</sup> them with perfect<sup>H8503</sup> hatred<sup>H8135</sup>: I count them mine enemies<sup>H341</sup>. 23 Search<sup>H2713</sup> me, O God<sup>H410</sup>, and know<sup>H3045</sup> my heart<sup>H3824</sup>: try<sup>H974</sup> me, and know<sup>H3045</sup> my thoughts<sup>H8312</sup>. 24 And see<sup>H7200</sup> if there be any wicked<sup>H6090</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup> in me, and lead<sup>H5148</sup> me in the way<sup>H1870</sup> everlasting<sup>H5769</sup>. 8
