

# Psalm 141

1 A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, I cry<sup>H7121</sup> unto thee: make haste<sup>H2363</sup> unto me; give ear<sup>H238</sup> unto my voice<sup>H6963</sup>, when I cry<sup>H7121</sup> unto thee. 2 Let my prayer<sup>H8605</sup> be set forth<sup>H3559</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee as incense<sup>H7004</sup>, and the lifting up<sup>H4864</sup> of my hands<sup>H3709</sup> as the evening<sup>H6153</sup> sacrifice<sup>H4503</sup>. 3 Set<sup>H7896</sup> a watch<sup>H8108</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, before my mouth<sup>H6310</sup>; keep<sup>H5341</sup> the door<sup>H1817</sup> of my lips<sup>H8193</sup>. 4 Incline<sup>H5186</sup> not my heart<sup>H3820</sup> to any evil<sup>H7451</sup> thing<sup>H1697</sup>, to practise<sup>H5953</sup> wicked<sup>H7562</sup> works<sup>H5949</sup> with men<sup>H376</sup> that work<sup>H6466</sup> iniquity<sup>H205</sup>: and let me not eat<sup>H3898</sup> of their dainties<sup>H4516</sup>.

5 Let the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> smite<sup>H1986</sup> me; it shall be a kindness<sup>H2617</sup>: and let him reprove<sup>H3198</sup> me; it shall be an excellent<sup>H7218</sup> oil<sup>H8081</sup>, which shall not break<sup>H5106</sup> my head<sup>H7218</sup>: for yet my prayer<sup>H8605</sup> also shall be in their calamities<sup>H7451</sup>. 6 When their judges<sup>H8199</sup> are overthrown<sup>H8058</sup> in stony<sup>H5553</sup> places<sup>H3027</sup>, they shall hear<sup>H8085</sup> my words<sup>H561</sup>; for they are sweet<sup>H5276</sup>. 7 Our bones<sup>H6106</sup> are scattered<sup>H6340</sup> at the grave's<sup>H7585</sup> mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, as when one cutteth<sup>H6398</sup> and cleaveth<sup>H1234</sup> wood upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 8 But mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> are unto thee, O GOD<sup>H3069</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup>: in thee is my trust<sup>H2620</sup>; leave<sup>H6168</sup> not my soul<sup>H5315</sup> destitute<sup>H6168</sup>. 9 Keep<sup>H8104</sup> me from the snares<sup>H3027</sup> which they have laid<sup>H3369</sup> for me, and the gins<sup>H4170</sup> of the workers<sup>H6466</sup> of iniquity<sup>H205</sup>. 10 Let the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> fall<sup>H5307</sup> into their own nets<sup>H4364</sup>, whilst that I withal<sup>H3162</sup> escape<sup>H5674</sup>.
